Rosh Hashanah Exhortation The **Downfall** of a **Culture**

(Romans 1:18-32)

I. The *Rejection* of the <u>Truth</u> of God (1:18-20)

A. *Truth* that has been <u>suppressed</u> in unrighteousness (1:18)

- B. *Truth* that has been made <u>evident</u> to men (1:19)
- C. *Truth* that has been seen and understood through <u>His creation</u> (1:20)

¹⁸ For the <u>wrath</u> of God is *revealed* from heaven against all *ungodliness* and *unrighteousness* of men who <u>suppress</u> the <u>truth</u> in *unrighteousness*,

¹⁹ because that which is known about God is <u>evident</u> within them; for God made it <u>evident</u> to them.

²⁰ For since the creation of the world His *invisible* attributes, *His eternal power* and *divine nature*, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

II. The *Repudiation* of the <u>Knowledge</u> of God (1:21-23, 25)

- A. *Refusing* to honor and give thanks to God (1:21a)
- B. *Receiving* in their hearts vain and foolish <u>speculations</u> (1:21b)
- C. *Replacing* the <u>glory</u> of the *incorruptible* God with that of *corruptible* man and animals (1:22-23)
- D. *Rejecting* the **truth of God** for a <u>lie</u>, **worshipping** and **serving** the <u>creation</u> rather than its <u>Creator</u> (1:25)

²¹ For even though they knew God, they did <u>not</u> honor Him as God or give <u>thanks</u>, but they became *futile* in their speculations, and their foolish heart was *darkened*.

²² Professing to be *wise*, they became *fools*,
 ²³ and <u>exchanged</u> the glory of the *incorruptible* God for an *image* in the form of *corruptible* man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.

III. The *Resolve* (by God) to "abandon" men to Suffer the <u>Consequences</u> of their *own* <u>Iniquity</u> (1:24-31)

- A. *Abandoning* them to their own lusts, impurity, and the dishonoring of their <u>bodies</u> (1:24)
- B. *Abandoning* them (men and women) to degrading, unnatural passions (1:26-27)

C. *Abandoning* them to follow their own <u>depraved minds</u> and <u>unrighteousness</u> (1:28-31)

²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to <u>impurity</u>, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.

²⁵ For they <u>exchanged</u> the *truth* of God for a *lie*, and worshiped and served the *creature* rather than the *Creator*, who is blessed forever. Amen.

²⁶ For this reason God <u>gave them over</u> to *degrading* passions; for their women *exchanged* the *natural* function for that which is *unnatural*,

²⁷ and in the same way also the men abandoned the natural function of the woman and burned in their desire toward one another,
men with men committing indecent acts and receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error.

²⁸ And just as they did **not see fit** to *acknowledge* God any longer, God <u>gave them over</u> to a *depraved* mind, to do those things which are **not proper**,

²⁹ being filled with all <u>unrighteousness</u>, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; *they are* gossips,

³⁰ slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, *inventors* of evil, *disobedient* to parents,

³¹ without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful;

Personal Application "Blow the *Trumpets*" Our so-called "Woke" Culture— Desperately *needs* a "<u>Spiritual</u> Awakening"

A. We need a *Trumpet blast* warning us *not* to abandon the <u>Truth</u> and <u>Knowledge</u> of God *revealed* to mankind throughout the ages.

Thus says **the LORD**, **"Stand** by the **ways** and **see** and **ask** for the <u>ancient paths</u>, where the <u>good way</u> is, and *walk in it*;

> and you shall find **rest** for your **souls**." But they said, 'We will <u>not</u> walk *in it*.'

And I set watchmen over you, saying, "Listen to the sound of the <u>trumpet</u>!" But they said, 'We will <u>not</u> listen.'

> "Therefore **hear**, **O nations**, And know, **O congregation**, what is among them.

"Hear, O earth: behold, I am bringing *disaster* on this people, the fruit of their *plans, because* they have <u>not</u> listened to <u>My words</u>, and as for <u>My law</u>, they have <u>rejected</u> it also...

..."For **My people** have <u>forgotten Me</u>,... and they have <u>stumbled</u> from their ways, from the <u>ancient paths</u>,.." (Jeremiah 6:16-19, 18:15a)

B. We need a *Trumpet blast* warning us <u>not</u> to forsake God's *word* and *principles* of <u>Righteousness</u>.

My son, if you will receive <u>my sayings</u> and treasure <u>my commandments</u> within you,...

Then you will *discern* the *fear* of the LORD and *discover* the *knowledge* of God.

For the LORD gives *wisdom*; from His mouth (His <u>word</u>) come *knowledge* and *understanding*...

Then you will discern <u>righteousness</u> and <u>justice</u> and <u>equity</u> and every good <u>course</u>...(Proverbs 2:1, 5-6, 9)

C. We **need** a *Trumpet blast* warning us, and especially our <u>rulers</u>, to not "*suppress* the <u>truth</u> in <u>unrighteousness</u> (Rom. 1:18)."

A Warning to <u>leaders</u> → <u>Political leaders</u> → <u>Judicial leaders</u> → <u>Educational</u> leaders → Spiritual leaders

> "An **appalling** and **horrible** thing has happened in the **land**: the **prophets prophecy falsely**, and the **priests rule** on their **own authority**; and **My people love it so!**" (Jeremiah 5:30-31)

For <u>those</u> who *guide* this people are leading *them* <u>astray</u>; and <u>those</u> who are *guided* by them are brought to <u>confusion</u>. (Isaiah 9:16) When the <u>righteous</u> increase, the people *rejoice*, But when a <u>wicked man rules</u>, people *groan*. (Proverbs 29:2) Righteousness exalts a nation, but <u>sin</u> is a *disgrace* to *any* people (Proverbs 14:34)

The <u>wicked</u> are overthrown and are *no more* but the *house* of the <u>righteous</u> will *stand.* (Proverbs 12:7)

D. We need a *Trumpet blast* that "Awakens" us to <u>Repentance</u>

<u>Blow a trumpet</u> in Zion, consecrate a fast, proclaim a solemn assembly, <u>gather</u> the people, sanctify the congregation,...

Let the *priests*, the LORD's ministers, <u>weep</u> between the porch and the altar, and let them say, "<u>Spare</u> Your people, O LORD,..." (Joel 2:15-16a, 17a)

If **My people**, which are called by **My name**, shall *humble* themselves, and *pray*, and *seek My face*, and <u>turn</u> from their <u>wicked ways</u>; then I will *hear* from *heaven*, and will *forgive* their sin, and will *heal* their land. (II Chronicles 7:14)

When **God** saw their **deeds** (in **Nineveh**), that they <u>turned</u> from their *wicked way*, then **God** <u>relented</u> concerning the **calamity** which **He** had declared **He would bring** upon them. And **He did** <u>not</u> **do** *it*. (Jonah 3:10)

E. We **need** a *Trumpet blast* to *remind* **us** of the <u>Trumpet</u> that will **sound** at the <u>**Return**</u> of **the Lord**, and the **glorious future** <u>**Hope**</u> of the **Redeemed**.

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the <u>trumpet of God</u>, and the dead in Messiah will <u>rise</u> first.

Then we which are **alive** and **remain** will be *caught up together* with them in the **clouds** to **meet the Lord** in the **air**, and so shall we **ever** be **with the Lord**. (I Thessalonians 4:16-17)

¹⁰ And the <u>ransomed</u> of the LORD will return and come with <u>joyful</u> shouting to Zion, with <u>everlasting joy</u> upon their heads.

They will find <u>gladness</u> and <u>joy</u>, And **sorrow** and **sighing** will **flee away**. (Isaiah 35:10)
