# **7 JEWISH** REASONS... TO CELEBRATE **CHRISTMAS**

## 1. IT'S THE **BIRTH** OF THE **JEWISH MESSIAH**

And there was a man in **Jerusalem** whose name was **Simeon**; and this man was **righteous** and **devout**, looking for the **consolation of Israel**; and the **Holy Spirit** was upon him.

And it had been **revealed** to him by the **Holy Spirit** that he would **not see death** before he had <u>seen</u> the **Lord's Messiah**.

And he came in the **Spirit** into the temple; and when the parents brought in the **child Jesus**, to carry out for Him the **custom of the Law**, then he **took Him** into his arms, and **blessed God**, and said,

"Now, Lord, You are **releasing** Your **bond-servant** to depart **in peace**, according to **Your word**; for my eyes have seen **Your salvation**, which You have **prepared** in the presence of **all peoples**, A **LIGHT OF REVELATION** TO THE **GENTILES**, and **the glory** of Your people **Israel.**" (Luke 2:25-32)

#### 2. IT'S THE BIRTH OF ISRAEL'S KING

prophecy → For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest upon His shoulders;..

There will be **no end** to the increase of **His government** or of **peace**, on the <u>throne</u> of **David** and over **His <u>kingdom</u>**, to establish it and to uphold it with **justice** and **righteousness** from then on and <u>forevermore</u>. (Isaiah 9:6a, 7)

<u>fulfillment</u>→ The angel said to her (Mary), "And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus.

He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the <u>throne</u> of His father <u>David</u>; and **He** will <u>reign</u> over the house of Jacob <u>forever</u>, and His <u>kingdom</u> will have <u>no end</u>." (Luke 1:30a, 31-33)

#### 3. IT'S THE **BIRTH** OF <u>ISRAEL'S</u> **PROMISED** "<u>SEED OF BLESSING</u>"

prophecy → Now the LORD said to Abram,...
"...in you all the families of the earth shall <u>be blessed</u>."

"...<u>in your seed</u> all the **nations** of the earth shall <u>be blessed</u>,..." (Genesis 12:1, 3c: 22:18a)

<u>fulfillment</u>→ ...Peter...replied to the people, "Men of Israel,... "...the things which God announced **beforehand**... He has thus **fulfilled**.

Therefore **repent** and **return**, so that your **sins** may be wiped away, in order that **times of refreshing** may come from the **presence** of the Lord;...

It is <u>you (Israel)</u> who are the **sons** of the **prophets** and of the **covenant** which **God** made with your **fathers**, saying to **Abraham**,

'AND <u>IN YOUR SEED</u> ALL THE FAMILIES OF THE EARTH SHALL <u>BE BLESSED</u>.'

For <u>you first</u>, God raised up His Servant and sent Him to <u>bless you</u> by turning every one *of you* from your wicked ways." (Acts 3:12a, 18, 19, 25-26)

#### 4. IT'S THE **BIRTH** OF **ISRAEL'S SAVIOR**

But the **angel** said to them (the shepherds) "Do not be afraid; for behold I bring you news of **great joy** which will be for **all people**; for today in the **city of David** there has been **born for you** <u>a Savior</u>, who is **Messiah the Lord**. (Luke 2:10-11)

And he (**Simeon**) took **Him** (**Jesus**) into his arms, and **blessed God**, and said, "Now, **Lord**, you are releasing Your bond-servant to depart in peace,... for my eyes have seen **Your** <u>salvation</u>,... (Luke 2:28-30)

...and so <u>all Israel</u> will be <u>saved;</u> just as it is written,

"THE **DELIVERER** WILL COME TO ZION, HE WILL **REMOVE UNGODLINESS** FROM JACOB." (Romans 11:26, Isaiah 59:20)

#### 5. IT'S THE BIRTH OF ISRAEL'S LAMB

prophecy → He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; like <u>a lamb</u> that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before it shearers, so He did not open His mouth...

> By **oppression** and **judgment He** was taken away; and as for **His generation**, who considered that <u>He</u> was **cut off** out of the land of the living for the <u>transgression of my people</u>, to whom the stroke *was due?*...

> > As a result of the anguish of **His soul**, **He (God)** will see *it and* be *satisfied;*

By **His knowledge** the **Righteous One, My Servant**, will **justify** the **many**, as **He** will **bear their iniquites**. (Isaiah 53:7-8, 11)

<u>fulfillment</u>→ The next day he (John) saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the <u>Lamb of God</u> who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

> Clean out the **old leaven** so that you may be a **new lump**,... For <u>Messiah our Passover</u> also has been sacrificed. (I Corinthians 5:7)

#### 6. IT'S THE **BIRTH** OF **ISRAEL'S "GREAT PROPHET"**

prophecy → "The LORD your God will raise up for you <u>a prophet like me</u> from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him.... And I will put <u>My words in his mouth</u>, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. (Deuteronomy 18:15, 18b)

<u>fulfillment</u>→ When He (Jesus) had entered Jerusalem, all the city was stirred, saying, "Who is this?" And the crowds were saying, "This is the <u>prophet Jesus</u>, from Nazareth in Galilee." (Matthew 21:10-11) Therefore, when the people had saw **the sign** which **He** had performed, they said, "This is truly <u>the Prophet</u> who is to come into the world." (John 6:14)

## 7. IT'S THE MANIFESTATION OF <u>ISRAEL'S</u> <u>GREAT HIGH PRIEST</u>

prophecy→ The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind,
"You (Messiah) are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."
(Psalm 110:4)

fulfillment  $\rightarrow$  Since then we have a <u>great high priest</u> who has passed through the heavens, **Yeshua the Son of God**, let us hold fast our **confession**...

Although **He** was a **Son**, **He** learned **obedience** from the things which **He suffered.** And having been made **perfect**, **He** became to all those who **obey Him** the source of **eternal salvation**, being <u>designated</u> by God as a <u>high priest</u> according to the order of <u>Melchizedek</u>...

For it was fitting for us to have such a <u>high priest</u>, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and <u>exalted</u> above the heavens; who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices,... because this **He did** <u>once</u> for all when He offered up **Himself**. (Hebrews 4:14, 5:8-10, 7:26-27)
