## The **Beatitudes Messiah's Comforting Words**of **Blessing**

Jesus was going throughout all Galilee,
teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom,
and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.

The **news** about **Him spread** throughout all **Syria**; and they **brought to Him all** who were **ill**, those **suffering** with various **diseases** and **pains**, **demoniacs**, **epileptics**, **paralytics**; and **He** <u>healed</u> them.

**Large crowds** *followed* **Him** from **Galilee** and *the* **Decapolis** and **Jerusalem** and **Judea** and *from* beyond the **Jordan.** (Matthew 4:23-25)

The *Beatitudes*—<u>Blessed</u> (*happy*) Sayings (Matthew 5:1-12)

<sup>1</sup>When **Jesus** saw the **crowds**, **He went up** on the **mountain**; and after **He sat down**, **His** *disciples* came to **Him**.

<sup>2</sup>**He** opened **His mouth** and *began* to <u>teach</u> them, saying,

"3 Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>4</sup>Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

<sup>5</sup>Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.

<sup>6</sup>**Blessed** are those who **hunger** and **thirst** for <u>righteousness</u>, for **they** shall be **satisfied**.

<sup>7</sup>Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

<sup>8</sup>Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

<sup>9</sup>Blessed are the <u>peacemakers</u>, for they shall be called <u>sons of God</u>.

<sup>10</sup>**Blessed** are those who have been <u>persecuted</u> for the sake of *righteousness*, for **theirs** is the **kingdom of heaven**.

<sup>11</sup> Blessed are you when people insult you and <u>persecute</u> you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me.

<sup>12</sup>**Rejoice** and be **glad**, for your <u>reward in heaven</u> is **great**; for in the **same way** they **persecuted the** *prophets* who were before you."

## Messiah's Words of <u>Blessing</u>, Reflect the Teaching of the Tanach (O.T.)

→ "3 Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

The **Spirit** of the **Lord GoD** is *upon me*,
Because **the Lord** has *anointed me*To bring **good news** to the **afflicted**; **He** has **sent me** to *bind up* the <u>brokenhearted</u>, (Isaiah 61:1)

The **LORD** is **near** to the **brokenhearted**And **saves** those who are **crushed in spirit**. (Psalm 34:18)

For thus says the high and exalted One
Who lives forever, whose name is Holy,
"I dwell on a high and holy place,
and also with the contrite and lowly of spirit
In order to revive the spirit of the lowly

And to *revive* the *heart* of the **contrite**. (Isaiah 57:15)

He will swallow up death for all time, and the Lord GoD will wipe tears away from all faces, and He will remove the reproach of His people from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken. (Isaiah 25:8)

→ \*Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

And the *ransomed* of the LORD will return and come with *joyful* shouting to Zion, With everlasting *joy* upon their heads.
They will find *gladness* and *joy*, and <u>sorrow</u> and <u>sighing</u> will <u>flee away</u>. (Isaiah 35:10)

→ 5 Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.

But the <u>humble</u> will <u>inherit</u> the land and will delight themselves in <u>abundant prosperity</u>. (Psalm 37:11)

"In that day you will feel *no shame* because of all your deeds by which you have rebelled against Me;
For then I will remove from your midst Your proud, exulting ones, and you will never again be haughty on My holy mountain.

a <u>humble</u> and <u>lowly</u> people, and they will take *refuge* in the name of the LORD. (Zephaniah 3:11-12

## → Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

He who *pursues* <u>righteousness</u> and <u>loyalty</u> finds *life, righteousness* and *honor*. (Proverbs 21:21)

He who walks righteously and speaks with sincerity,
He who rejects unjust gain
and shakes his hands so that they hold no bribe;
He who stops his ears from hearing about bloodshed
and shuts his eyes from looking upon evil;

<u>he</u> will dwell on the *heights*,
his *refuge* will be the *impregnable rock*;
his <u>bread</u> will be <u>given him</u>,
his water will be *sure*. (Isaiah 33:15-16)

 $\rightarrow$ <sup>7</sup>Blessed are the <u>merciful</u>, for they shall receive <u>mercy</u>.

Therefore **the Lord** has **recompensed me** according to **my** <u>righteousness</u>, according to **my** <u>cleanness</u> in **His eyes**.

"With the <u>merciful</u> You will show Yourself <u>merciful</u>; with a *blameless* man You will show Yourself *blameless*;(II Samuel 22:25-26)

He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you

But to do justly,

To love mercy,
and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6:8)

 $\rightarrow$ <sup>8</sup>Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? and who may stand in His holy place?

He who has *clean hands* and a <u>pure heart</u>, Who has *not* lifted up his **soul** to **falsehood** and has *not* **sworn deceitfully**. (Psalm 24:3-4)

→ 9Blessed are the <u>peacemakers</u>, for they shall be called <u>sons</u> of God.

For a **child** will be born to us, **a son** will be **given to us**; and the **government** will rest on **His shoulders**;

and **His name** will be called **Wonderful Counselor**, **Mighty God**, **Eternal Father**, *Prince of Peace*.

There will be **no end** to the **increase** of *His* **government** or of <u>peace</u>, on the **throne of David** and over **his kingdom**,.. (Isaiah 9:6-7a)

How **lovely** on the mountains are the **feet** of him who brings **good news**, **Who** announces **peace** and brings **good news** of **happiness**,

Who announces <u>salvation</u>,

And says to **Zion**, "Your God *reigns*!" (Isaiah 52:7)

→ 10 Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

→ 11 Blessed are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me.

<sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great; for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

**Do not** *fret* because of **evildoers**, Be **not** *envious* toward **wrongdoers**.

For they will **wither** quickly like the **grass** and **fade** like the **green herb**...

But the <u>humble</u> will <u>inherit</u> the land and will delight themselves in *abundant* prosperity.

The wicked plots against the righteous and gnashes at him with his teeth.

The Lord laughs at him, for He sees his day is coming...

The LORD knows the *days* of the <u>blameless</u>, and their <u>inheritance</u> will *be forever*. (Psalm 37:1-2, 11-13, 18)

## Messiah's Exhortation

<sup>13</sup> "<u>You</u> are the <u>salt</u> of the <u>earth</u>; but if the <u>salt</u> has become *tasteless*, how can it be made <u>salty</u> again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men.

<sup>14</sup> "<u>You</u> are the <u>light</u> of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; <sup>15</sup> nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it <u>gives light</u> to all who are in the house.

that they may **see** your **good works**, and **glorify your Father** who is in **heaven**. (Matthew 5:13-16)
