## Daniel's Prayer Answered; the "Seventy Weeks" Prophecy (9:20-27)

#### a. God's Prophetic Messenger Reappears (9:20-23)

<sup>20</sup> Now while I was speaking and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God in behalf of the holy mountain of my God,

<sup>21</sup> while I was *still speaking* in prayer, then the man <u>Gabriel</u>, whom I had seen in the vision previously, came to me in *my* extreme weariness about the time of the evening offering.

<sup>22</sup> He gave *me* instruction and talked with me and said,
 "O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you <u>insight</u> with <u>understanding</u>.

<sup>23</sup> At the *beginning* of your supplications the *command* was issued, and I have come to tell *you*, for you are highly esteemed; so give heed to the <u>message</u> and gain <u>understanding</u> of the vision.

#### b. God's Program for Israel Revealed (9:24-27)

<sup>24</sup> "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city,

to *finish* the <u>transgression</u>, to make an <u>end of sin</u>, to make <u>atonement</u> for iniquity, to bring in <u>everlasting righteousness</u>, to <u>seal up vision</u> and <u>prophecy</u>, and to <u>anoint</u> the <u>most holy place</u>.

<sup>25</sup> So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a <u>decree</u> to restore and rebuild <u>Jerusalem</u>, until <u>Messiah the Prince</u>, there will be <u>seven weeks</u> and <u>sixty-two weeks</u>;

it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

<sup>26</sup> Then <u>after</u> the <u>sixty-two weeks</u>, the <u>Messiah</u> will be <u>cut off</u> and *have nothing*,

and the *people* of the <u>prince</u> who <u>is to come</u> will *destroy* the **city** and the **sanctuary**.

{decree  $\rightarrow$  7 sevens (49) + 62 sevens (434) == 483 years }

And its end *will come* with *a flood*; even to the end there will be *war; desolations* are determined.

<sup>27</sup> And he (the prince to come) will make a firm covenant with the many (Israel) for <u>one week</u>,

but in the <u>middle</u> of the week he will put <u>a stop</u> to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of <u>abominations</u> will come <u>one</u> who makes desolate, until a complete <u>destruction</u>, one that is <u>decreed</u>, is poured out on the <u>one</u> who makes desolate."

### Daniel's Seventy Weeks Prophecy— A Summary

{DANIEL 9:24}→ "Seventy sevens" (490 years) have been
determined for Israel and Jerusalem;"

"to *finish* the **transgression**" "to make an *end of sin*" "to make *atonement* for **iniquity**" "to bring in *everlasting righteousness*" "to *seal up* **vision and prophecy**" "to *anoint* the **most holy place**"

## {DANIEL 9:25-26}→ a starting point is given and <u>69 weeks</u> are explained

 A <u>decree</u> is to be issued concerning the restoration and rebuilding of Jerusalem (<u>7 weeks</u>) {49 years}

- From the issue of this decree until the coming of "<u>Messiah</u> the prince" will be 7 weeks and 62 weeks→<u>69 weeks/sevens</u> (483 years)
- <u>After</u> the 69<sup>th</sup> week the Messiah will be "<u>cut off</u>" (killed) and "have nothing"
- 4) The <u>people</u> (Romans) of a prince "who is to come (7:24-25)" will <u>destroy</u> the city and the sanctuary —war and desolations are determined


#### {DANIEL 9:27}—the 70<sup>th</sup> week of Daniel's prophecy

- 1) The **prince** "who is *to come*", will make a <u>**firm covenant**</u> with **Israel** for <u>**one week**</u>
- In the <u>middle</u> of the week (3 1/2 years) <u>he</u> will <u>break this covenant</u>, and put a <u>stop</u> to sacrifice and grain offerings—Also at this time, there will come <u>one</u> who carries out <u>abominations</u> and brings <u>desolation</u> (i.e. the "abomination of desolation")
- 3) After this, <u>another desolation</u>, one that is <u>complete</u> and <u>decreed</u>, will be **poured out** on the "abomination of desolation"

"Therefore when you see the <u>ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION</u> which was spoken of through **Daniel the prophet**, **standing** in the <u>holy place</u> (let the **reader** understand), then those who are in **Judea** must **flee** to the **mountains**...

For **then** there will be a <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has not occurred since the **beginning** of the world until now, nor ever will." (Matthew 24:15-16, 21)

### Explaining the "<u>delay</u>" or "<u>gap</u>" between the **69<sup>th</sup>** and **70<sup>th</sup>** weeks of **Daniel's prophecy**

Alhough there is disagreement, many Bible scholars believe that the **decree** to "**restore** and **rebuild Jerusalem**" (the **starting point** of the **70 weeks**) was issued in <u>445 B.C</u>. by the Persian king **Artaxerxes Longimanus**.

If we count sixty-nine weeks (483 years) from that point, we come to the time period of "Messiah the Prince," the life and ministry of Jesus the Messiah.

After **the Messiah** was **rejected** and "<u>**cut off**</u>", **He resurrected 3 days later**, having **accomplished** that which was required for the *spiritual* <u>**restoration**</u> of **Israel** (Dan. 9:24).

For <u>seventy weeks</u> have been decreed for your people... $\rightarrow$ 

- → To "finish the <u>transgression</u>"- to bring to a completion Israel's course of apostasy, sin, and wandering (Luke 2:29-32)
- $\rightarrow$  To "make an <u>end of sin</u>"- to "seal up," to *finish* sin (I Peter 3:18)
- → To "make <u>atonement</u> for iniquity"- to "cover" and bring about a *final* <u>propitiation</u> for iniquity, and for purification from sins (I John 2:1-2) (Titus 2:11-14)
- → To bring in "<u>everlasting righteousness</u>"- to pave the way for the *kingdom* of righteousness to come (Isaiah 9:6-7) (Matthew 4:17)

However, Israel's national rejection of her Messiah, having both rejected His ministry, and having delivered Him up to be crucified ("cut off"), has thus brought about a "<u>postponement</u>" in both her spiritual and national <u>restoration</u> (the kingdom). (Matthew 21:42-43) (Acts 1:6-8, 13:46)

The result of this **postponement** is a **"gap"** in **time** between the **sixty-ninth week** and the **seventieth week**.

Further revelation in the New Testament has revealed this "gap" to be a "mystery" age in which God is spreading the "good news" of Messiah's <u>redemptive</u> work, and the gift of <u>eternal life</u> to both Jews and Gentiles. (Acts 13:46-47)

"..if indeed you have heard of the **stewardship** of **God's grace** which was given to **me (Paul)** for you; that by <u>revelation</u> there was made known to me the <u>mystery</u>, as I wrote before in brief... which in other generations was *not* made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the *Spirit*, <sup>6</sup> to be specific, that the Gentiles are *fellow heirs* and *fellow members* of the body, and *fellow partakers* of the promise in Messiah Jesus through the <u>gospel</u>," (Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6)

When this **"mystery"** called the <u>church</u> is complete, the timetable of Israel's complete <u>restoration</u> will resume, and a final <u>7 year</u> time period (the **70<sup>th</sup> week**) will be fulfilled. (Romans 11:25-26)
