The Book of Daniel God's Prophet and Statesman

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3. A *Prophetic* Panorama Continued— Prophecies concerning <u>Israel</u> in the <u>End Times</u> (12:1-13)

12 "Now at *that time <u>Michael</u>*, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of **your people**, will arise.

And there will be a <u>time of distress</u> such as **never occurred** since there was a **nation** until **that time**; and at **that time** *your people*,

everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

² Many of those who <u>sleep</u> in the dust of the ground will <u>awake</u>, these to **everlasting** <u>life</u>, but the **others** to **disgrace** and **everlasting** <u>contempt</u>.

³ Those who have <u>insight</u> will shine brightly like the brightness of the expanse of heaven, and those who lead the *many* to <u>righteousness</u>, like the stars forever and ever.

⁴But as for **you**, **Daniel**, *conceal* these words and *seal up* the book until the <u>end of time</u>; many will go back and forth, and *knowledge* will increase."

⁵ Then I, **Daniel**, looked and behold, **two others** were standing, **one** on *this* bank of the river and the other on *that* bank of the river.

⁶ And **one said** to the <u>man</u> dressed in linen, who was *above* the waters of the river,

"How long will it be until the end of these wonders?"

⁷ I heard the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, as he raised his right hand and his left toward heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever that it would be for a <u>time</u>, times, and <u>half a time</u>;

and as soon as they **finish** *shattering* the **power** of the <u>holy people</u>, all these *events* will be <u>completed</u>.

⁸ As for **me**, I heard but could **not understand**; so I said, "**My lord**, what *will be* the *outcome* of these *events*?"

⁹ He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for these words are concealed and sealed up until the end time.

¹⁰ Many will be purged, purified and refined, but the wicked will act wickedly; and none of the wicked will understand, but those who have <u>insight</u> will understand.

 ¹¹ From the time that the regular sacrifice is abolished and the <u>abomination of desolation</u> is set up, there will be 1,290 days.
 ¹² How blessed is he who keeps waiting and attains to the 1,335 days!

¹³ But as for you, go your way to the end; then you will enter into rest and <u>rise again</u> for your allotted portion at the end of the age."

Prophetic Summary—Daniel Chapter 12 {Israel in the End-times}

A. *Israel* will face a time a terrible <u>Tribulation</u>

Now at **that time**...there will be a <u>time of distress</u> such as *never* occurred since there was a **nation** until that time;.. (12:1a)

"For **then** there will be a <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has **not occurred** since the **beginning** of the **world** until **now**, nor ever will." (Matthew 24:21)

B. A certain number in *Israel* will be <u>Saved</u>

;..and at **that time** *your* **people**, everyone who is found *written* in the **book**, will be <u>rescued</u>. (12:1b)

It will come about that he who is <u>left</u> in Zion and **remains** in **Jerusalem** will be called **holy** everyone who is <u>recorded</u> for life in **Jerusalem**. (Isaiah 4:3)

Isaiah cries out concerning Israel, "THOUGH THE NUMBER OF THE SONS OF ISRAEL BE LIKE THE SAND OF THE SEA, IT IS THE <u>REMNANT</u> THAT WILL BE <u>SAVED</u>; (Romans 9:27)

C. There will be a **bodily** <u>**Resurrection**</u>—many to everlasting *life*, others to everlasting *contempt*

Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground <u>will awake</u>, these to everlasting life, but the others to...everlasting <u>contempt.</u> (12:2)

D. In the **end time**, there will be those in *Israel* with "**insight**," who will "**shine brightly**," and lead many to <u>**Righteousness**</u>

Those who have <u>insight</u> will shine brightly...and... lead the *many* to <u>righteousness</u>,...(12:3)

"He (John) was the <u>lamp</u> that was *burning* and was *shining* and you were willing to **rejoice** for a while in **his** <u>light</u>." (John 5:35)

- E. The **Prophetic words** of **Daniel** would be "**sealed up**" or **kept intact** until the **end time.** At that time **many** will "go *back* and *forth*" (**search intently**), and <u>knowledge</u> will **increase**. (12:4, 9)
- F. *Israel's* time of "great tribulation" is to last for <u>3 1/2 years</u>.

And **one (angel)** said to <u>the man</u> dressed in linen,.. "<u>How long</u> will it be until the <u>end</u> of *these* wonders?"

I heard **the man dressed in linen**,,as he raised his **right hand** and his **left** toward **heaven**,

and **swore by Him** who **lives forever** that it would be for <u>time</u>, <u>times</u>, and a <u>half *a time* (31/2 years)</u>; (12:6-7a)

But the **two wings** of the great **eagle** were given to the <u>woman</u> (Israel), so that she could fly into the **wilderness** to her place, where she was **nourished** for a <u>time</u> and <u>times</u> and <u>half a time</u>, from the presence of the *serpent*. (Revelation 12:14)

G. During this time the **Power** of Israel will be "shattered"

...and as soon as they **finish** *shattering* the **power** of the <u>holy people</u>, all these *events* will be <u>completed</u>. (12:7b)

H. The *Starting point* of the "great tribulation" will be when the "regular sacrifice is abolished, and the abomination of desolation

is set up." (12:11, see also 9:27)

From the time that the **regular sacrifice** is **abolished** and the **abomination of desolation** is set up,

there will be <u>1, 290 days</u> (1, 260 days (31/2 years) plus <u>30</u> more days).

How <u>blessed</u> is he who keeps waiting and attains to the <u>1, 335 days</u>! (12:11-12) (**1, 260 days (31/2 years**) plus <u>75</u> more days).

"Therefore when you see the <u>ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION</u> which was spoken of through **Daniel the prophet**, **standing** in the **holy place** (let the reader understand), then those who are in **Judea** must *flee* to the **mountains...**

For <u>then</u> there will be a <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has not occurred since the **beginning** of the **world** until **now**, nor **ever will**. (Matthew 24:15-16, 21)
