# The Book of Daniel God's Prophet and Statesman

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### VII. **Daniel's** *Testimony* of **His** <u>Visions</u> <u>**Prophetic Revelation**</u> (7:1-12:13)

1. The *Vision* of the <u>4 Beasts</u> (7:1-8)

7 In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon

Daniel saw a <u>dream</u> and <u>visions</u> in his mind *as he lay* on his bed;
then he *wrote* the <u>dream down</u> and related the *following* summary of it.

<sup>2</sup> Daniel said, "I was looking in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the great sea.
 <sup>3</sup> And four great beasts were coming up from the sea, different from one another.

<sup>4</sup>The *first was like* a <u>lion</u> and had *the* **wings** of an **eagle**. I kept looking until its **wings** were *plucked*, and it was **lifted up** from the ground and made to **stand** on **two feet** like a *man*; a **human mind** also was given to it.

<sup>5</sup> And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a <u>bear</u>. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth between its teeth; and thus they said to it, 'Arise, devour much meat!'

<sup>6</sup> After this *I kept looking*, and behold, **another** one, **like** a <u>leopard</u>, which had on its back *four wings* of a **bird**; the **beast** also had *four heads*, and **dominion** was given to it.

<sup>7</sup> After this *I kept looking* in the night visions, and behold, a <u>fourth beast</u>, *dreadful* and *terrifying* and *extremely strong*; and it had large iron teeth.

It devoured and crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet; and it was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns.

While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first horns were <u>pulled out</u> by the roots before it; and behold, this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and a mouth uttering great boasts.

#### 2. The *Vision* of <u>God</u> (7:9-10)

<sup>9</sup> "I kept looking until thrones were set up, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; His vesture was like white snow and the hair of His head like pure wool. His throne was ablaze with flames, its wheels were a burning fire.

and coming out from before Him;
thousands upon thousands were attending Him,
and myriads upon myriads were standing before Him;
the court sat, and the books were opened.

#### 3. The *Vision* of the <u>4 Beasts Continued</u> (7:11-12)

<sup>11</sup> Then *I kept looking* because of the sound of the boastful words which the <u>horn</u> was speaking; *I kept looking* until the <u>beast</u> was <u>slain</u>, and its body was destroyed and given to the burning fire.

<sup>12</sup> As for the *rest* of the **beasts**, their **dominion** was **taken away**, but an extension of **life** was granted to them for an **appointed period of time**.

### 4. The *Vision* of the "Son of Man" (7:13-14)

13 "I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven
One like a Son of Man was coming, and He came up to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him.

14 "And to Him was given dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him.

His <u>dominion</u> is an <u>everlasting</u> dominion which will <u>not</u> pass away; and <u>His kingdom</u> is one which will <u>not</u> be <u>destroyed</u>.

## Summary Observations Daniel's Visions of the "Ancient of Days"

### Daniel's Visions of the "Ancient of Days' and the "Son of Man"

### **Observations** $\rightarrow$ **The Ancient of Days**:

→ He is the <u>Ancient of Days</u> -- "Attiq Yomim" — One who is "advanced in days," whose days are past reckoning—the Sovereign God, and *Eternal* King.

I kept looking until thrones were set up, and the Ancient of Days took His seat;...

...thousands upon thousands were attending Him, and myriads upon myriads were standing before Him; (7:9a, 10a)

→ **He** is **seated** among the "thrones" as the *Eternal* <u>Judge</u>.

I kept looking until thrones were set up, and the Ancient of Days took His seat;...

The **court** sat, and the **books** were **opened.** (7:9a, 10b)

 $\rightarrow$  He is <u>Holy</u> and <u>Pure</u> in appearance.

His vesture was white like snow and the hair of His head like pure wool. (7:9b)

→ His **throne** is **ablaze** with **flames**, and a "**river of fire**" was flowing—representing the **righteous judgment** of **God**.

His <u>throne</u> was ablaze with <u>flames</u>, its wheels were a <u>burning fire</u>.

A river of <u>fire</u> was flowing
and coming out from *before* Him; (7:9c-10a)

### **Observations** $\rightarrow$ **The Son of Man**:

→ He comes with the <u>clouds of heaven</u>, and is "*like* a **Son of Man.**"

I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the <u>clouds</u> of heaven One like a <u>Son of Man</u> was <u>coming</u>,...(7:13)

→ He is <u>presented</u> before the Ancient of Days.
...and He came up to the Ancient of Days
and was <u>presented</u> before Him. (7:13c)

→ **He** is given <u>dominion</u>, <u>glory</u> and a <u>kingdom</u>, and *all* peoples and nations will serve Him.

And to **Him** was given a **dominion**, **glory** and a **kingdom**, that **all** the **peoples**, **nations and men**\_of every language might **serve Him**. (7:14a)

→ His dominion and kingdom are <u>everlasting</u>, and will not pass away or be destroyed. (7:14b)

His <u>dominion</u> is an <u>everlasting dominion</u>...(7:14b)

### *Key* Question → So Who is this "Son of Man"?

According to the great medieval Jewish scholar **Rashi**, the **Son of Man is <u>King Messiah</u>** (Artscroll Tanach pg. 1796)

### According to **New Testament Scripture**, **Jesus** is the "**Son of Man**"

1. **Jesus, God's eternal Son,** was **born** of a <u>woman</u>, and having "put on" humanity, **He** was indeed a "son of man." (Galatians 4:4, Philippians 2:5-8, Matthew 1:16)

Jesus designated Himself as *the* "Son of Man" over 80 times in the New Testament. He declared Himself to be the "Son of Man," for He is the One of whom Daniel wrote in his *vision* of the Son of Man. (Daniel 7:13-14)

And **He (Jesus)** said to him, "**Truly, truly**, I say to you, you will see the **heavens** opened and the **angels of God ascending** and **descending** on the **Son of Man**."(John 1:51)

2. In **Daniel's vision**, the **Son of Man** came with the "clouds of heaven (7:13)." **Jesus** not only **ascended** to heaven in a <u>cloud</u> (Acts 1:9), but **He** promised to <u>return</u> "on the <u>clouds</u> of the sky…"

And then the **sign** of the **Son of Man** will appear in the **sky**, and then all the tribes of the earth will **mourn**, and they will see the **Son of Man** *coming* on the <u>clouds</u> of the sky with **power** and **great glory**. (Matthew 24:30)

Behold, **He is coming** with the <u>clouds</u>, and every eye will **see Him**, even those who **pierced Him**; and all the **tribes** of the **earth** will **mourn** over **Him**. So it is to be. Amen. (Revelation 1:7)

3. In **Daniel's vision**, the **Son of Man** was **presented** before the **Ancient of Days**, and to **Him** would be given **dominion**, **glory**, and a **kingdom**. At that time, **all** the

**peoples** and **nations** would pay **homage**, and **serve Him**. (7:13c-14a)

Both before His death, and after His resurrection, Jesus revealed that He would ascend to His Father in heaven. The scriptures declare that Jesus (the Son of Man) would receive *dominion*, *glory*, and a *kingdom*, and that all peoples and nations would **praise** and **serve Him**.

Jesus said to her (Mary), "...go to My brethren and say to them, 'I ascend to My Father and your Father, and my God and your God." (John 20:17)

Being found in appearance as a man, He (Jesus) humbled Himself by becoming **obedient** to the point of **death**, even **death on a cross**.

Therefore also God has highly exalted Him, and bestowed on **Him the name** which is above every name, so that at the name of **Jesus EVERY KNEE** WILL **BOW**. of those who are in heaven and on the earth and under the earth,... (Philippians 2:8-10)

And I saw between the **throne** (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing, as if slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth...

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice,

"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing."

<sup>13</sup> And **every created thing** which is in **heaven** and on the **earth** and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying,

"To **Him** who **sits** on the **throne**, and to the **Lamb**, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever." (Revelation 5:6, 11-13)

Then the **seventh angel** sounded;

and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Messiah; and **He** will **reign forever** and **ever.**" (Revelation 11:15)
