## Embracing a **Shavuot** *Vision* **Renewing** our *Focus* as **Laborers** in **God's** <u>Harvest</u>

A. By *Praying* for an **outpouring** of **God's Spirit** and **Power**, as we gather a **Harvest** "for **Life Eternal**". (John 4:36)

Then **he** said to me,... "This is the **word of the LORD** to **Zerubbabe**l saying, "**Not** by **might** nor by **power, by My Spirit**," says the **LORD of hosts.** (Zachariah 4:6)

Gathering them together, **He (Jesus)** commanded **them (His disciples) not** to leave **Jerusalem**, but to **wait** for what the **Father** had **promised**, "Which," He said, "you heard of from **Me**;...

...you will receive <u>power</u> when the <u>Holy Spirit</u> has come upon you; and you shall be **My witnesses** both in **Jerusalem**, and in all **Judea** and **Samaria**, and even to the **remotest part** of the **earth**." (Acts 1:4, 8)

B. By "Planting" faithfully the "Seed" of the Word of God (i.e. the Gospel) through Preaching and Teaching

"Now the **parable** is this: the **seed** is the **word of God**." (Matthew 8:11)

How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed?

How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard?

And how will they hear without a preacher?

How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "How BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEEWS OF GOOD THINGS". (Romans 10:14-15)

What then is **Apollos**? And what is **Paul**? **Servants through whom you believed**, even as the **Lord** gave **opportunity** to each one.

I <u>planted</u>, Apollos <u>watered</u>, but God was causing the <u>growth</u>. (I Corinthians 3:5-6)

...for you have been **born again**not of **seed** which is **perishable** but **imperishable**, that is,
through the **living** and **enduring word of God**. (I Peter 1:23)

C. By *Participating* in the <u>ministry</u> of producing and growing spiritually the <u>Laborers</u> (i.e. *disciples*), who will *continue* the work of the Harvest.

Then **He (Jesus**) said to **His disciples**, "The **harvest** truly *is* **plentiful**, but the **laborers** are **few**.

Therefore *pray* the **Lord of the harvest** to **send out <u>laborers</u>** into **His harvest**." (Matthew 9:37-38)

## Producing and growing spiritually mature Laborers/Disciples ->

- → By providing learning experiences in the word of God (II Timothy 316-17)
- → By promoting fellowship experiences among believers (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- → By promoting <u>evangelism</u> and <u>outreach</u> among the <u>lost</u> (Romans 10:14-15)
- → By preparing believers for the work of service

And **He gave some** (gifted **people**) as **apostles**, and some as **prophets**, and some as **evangelists**, and some as **pastors** and **teachers**,

For the **equipping** of the saints for the **work of service**, to the **building up** of the **body of Messiah**; (Ephesians 4:11-12)

D. By *Patiently* and **faithfully** <u>Laboring</u>, even when times are **difficult**, and the **harvest** is "scarce"

Let us not **lose heart** in doing **good**, for in **due time** we **will reap** if we do not grow **weary**. (Galatians 6:9)

Therefore be *patient*, brethren, until the **coming of the Lord**.

The **farmer** waits for the **precious produce** of the soil, being **patient** about it, until it gets the **early** and **late rains**.

You too be *patient*, strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is near.

(James 5:7-8)
