How to *Change* our *Culture* for the **Better**... <u>God</u> has **Something to Say**

1. We should **obey God's command** regarding **bearing <u>false witness</u>** against our **neighbor.** (Exodus 20:16)

"You shall **not** bear a <u>false report</u>; do not join your hand with a **wicked man** to be a **malicious witness**." (Exodus 23:1)

There are six things which the LORD hates,
Yes, seven which are an abomination to Him:
Haughty eyes, a lying tongue,
And hands that shed innocent blood,
A heart that devises wicked plans,
Feet that run rapidly to evil,
A false witness who utters lies,
And one who spreads strife among brothers. (Proverbs 6:16-19)

2. We should **condemn** and **avoid** the *sin* of <u>slander</u>.

You shall <u>not</u> go about as a <u>slanderer</u> among your people, and you are not to act **against** the **life** of your **neighbor**; I am **the Lorp**.(Leviticus 19:16)

Let all **bitterness** and **wrath** and **anger** and **clamor** and **slander** be put away from you, along with all **malice**. (Ephesians 4:31)

3. We should **pursue** the **truth** of a matter, and **resist** those who would "**suppress** the **truth** in **unrighteousness.**" (Romans 1:18)

O Lord, **who** may abide in **Your tent? Who** may dwell on **Your holy hill? He** who walks with *integrity*, and works *righteousness*,
And **speaks** <u>truth</u> in his **heart**. **He** does **not** *slander* with his **tongue**,..(Psalm 5:1-3a)

He who speaks <u>truth</u> tells what is <u>right</u>, But a **false witness**, *deceit*. (Proverbs 12:17)

And they sent their **disciples** to **Him (Jesus)**, along with the Herodians, saying, "**Teacher**, we know that **You are** <u>truthful</u> and **teach** the **way of God** in <u>truth</u>, and **defer** to **no one**; for **You** are **not partial** to any. (Matthew 22:16)

4. We must *vote* in leaders with <u>integrity</u>, and appoint <u>judges</u> who will rule <u>justly</u>.

Furthermore, you shall select out of all the people **able men** who **fear God**, **men of <u>truth</u>**, those who **hate <u>dishonest gain</u>**; and you shall place *these* over them as **leaders** of thousands, of hundreds, of fifties and of tens. (Exodus 18:21)

'You shall do <u>no injustice</u> in judgment; you shall <u>not</u> be *partial* to the **poor** nor *defer* to the **great**, but you are to judge your neighbor fairly.' (Leviticus 19:15)

You shall **not distort justice**; you shall **not** be **partial**, and you shall **not** take **a bribe**, for a **bribe blinds** the eyes of the **wise** and **perverts** the **words** of the **righteous**.

<u>Justice</u>, and **only justice**, you shall **pursue**, that you may **live** and possess the land which the **LORD your God** is giving you. (Deuteronomy 16:19-20)

Those who forsake the law praise the wicked,

But those who keep the law strive with them.

Evil men do not understand justice,

But those who seek the Lord understand all things. (Proverbs 28:4-5)

- 5. We should *reject* <u>Prejudice</u> and <u>Bigotry</u> in all its **forms**—

 Bigotry→intolerance toward those who hold different opinions from oneself.
 - a. Racial Bigotry
 - b. Religious Bigotry
 - c. Political Bigotry

But the LORD said to Samuel,

"Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature,
because I have rejected him; for God sees not as man sees,
for man looks at the outward appearance,
but the LORD looks at the heart." (I Samuel 16:7)

"Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, For in the image of God He made man." (Genesis 9:6)

And **he (Peter)** said to **them**, "You yourselves know how **unlawful** it is for a man who is **a Jew** to **associate** with a **foreigner** or to visit him; and **yet God** has shown me that I should **not** call **any man unholy** or **unclean**. (Acts 10:28)

With it (our tongues) we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God; (James 3:9)

→ Though we may **disagree** *strongly* with the **beliefs** and **views** of many in our culture, we are to **respect** the <u>value</u> of **every <u>person</u>**, **born** and **unborn**, for we were **all made** in the "likeness of God."

6. We should *avoid* "caving" to the anger and demands of the mob.

"You shall **not** bear a **false report**; do **not** join your hand with a **wicked man** to be a **malicious witness**. You shall **not follow** the **masses** in doing **evil**, nor shall you **testify** in a **dispute** so as to **turn aside** after a **multitude** in order to **pervert justice**;.." (Exodus 23:1-2)

So **Pilate**, wishing to **satisfy the mob**, set **Bar-Abba** free for them; but he had **Yeshua whipped** and then **handed him over** to be **executed** on the **stake**. (Mark 15:15)

7. We should **not** "*rush* **to judgment**", for **all men** will one day be **accountable** for their **words** and **deeds** before a **holy God.**

A false witness will <u>not</u> go <u>unpunished</u>, And he who **tells lies** will **not escape**. (Proverbs 19:5)

But I tell you that <u>every careless word</u> that <u>people speak</u>, they shall give an <u>accounting</u> for it in the day of judgment. (Matthew 12:36)

8. We should **strive** to **control** the **divisive** and **destructive power** of our **tongues**.

With *his* mouth the godless man destroys his neighbor, But through knowledge the righteous will be delivered. (Proverbs 11:9)

The **heart** of the **righteous ponders** *how* to **answer**, But the **mouth** of the **wicked pours out evil things**. (Proverbs 15:28)

So also the **tongue** is a **small part** of the body, and *yet* it **boasts** of **great things**. See how great a **forest** is **set aflame** by such a **small fire**!

And the <u>tongue</u> is a <u>fire</u>, the *very* world of iniquity; the <u>tongue</u> is set among our <u>members</u> as that which *defiles* the <u>entire body</u>, and sets on <u>fire</u> the <u>course</u> of *our* <u>life</u>, and is set on <u>fire</u> by <u>hell</u>. (James 3:5-6)

9. When we <u>communicate</u>, we should "speak the <u>truth</u> in <u>love</u>," and strive for *knowledge* and *understanding* in all matters, so that our differences and disagreements among us may be <u>resolved</u> peacefully and respectfully.

...but **speaking the <u>truth</u> in <u>love</u>**, we are to **grow up** in all *aspects* into **Him** who is the head, **even Messiah**,...

Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

(Ephesians 4:15, 29)

The <u>tongue</u> of the wise makes <u>knowledge</u> acceptable, But the mouth of fools spouts folly. (Proverbs 15:2)

The **heart** of the **wise** *instructs* **his** <u>mouth</u> And adds <u>persuasiveness</u> to his **lips**. (Proverbs 16:23)

10. We should **recognize** the **need**, and have **respect** for **governing authorities**, which have been **established** to **maintain law** and **order** for the **protection** and **welfare** of **human society**.

Every person is to be in *subjection* to the <u>governing authorities</u>.

For there is <u>no</u> authority except from God,
and those which exist are established by God.

Therefore whoever *resists* authority has opposed the ordinance of God;...

For **rulers** are **not** a cause of **fear** for **good behavior**, but for **evil**. Do you want to have **no fear** of **authority? Do** what is **good** and you will have **praise** from the same;..(Romans 13:1-3)

11. We should have as our *priority* to <u>obey</u> the "royal law" established by God to love our neighbor as ourselves.

You shall <u>not</u> take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the sons of your people, but you shall <u>love</u> your neighbor as yourself; I am the LORD. (Leviticus 19:8)

If, however, you are fulfilling the **royal law** according to the **Scripture**, "YOU SHALL **LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF**,"you are **doing well**. (James 2:8)

12. We should promote <u>humility</u> and **shun** *self-righteousness*. We should **humbly acknowledge** our *need* for the **grace**, **wisdom**, and **guidance of God**, and be <u>thankful</u> for **His provision** for our nation; a nation where we can aspire to **life**, **liberty**, and the **pursuit of happiness**.

If I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain,...
and My people who are called by My name humble themselves
and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways,
then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin
and will heal their land. (II Chronicles 7:13a, 14)
Know that the LORD Himself is God;
It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves;
We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise.

Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting

And His faithfulness to all generations. (Psalm 100:3-5)
