a. The Judgments against Israel (N. Kingdom) (9:8-10:4)

## B. The *Judgment* against <u>Assyria</u> (10:5-34)

1) The **"Rod"** of **God's Anger**—<u>Assyria</u> (10:5-11)

<sup>5</sup> Woe to Assyria, the <u>rod</u> of My anger and the <u>staff</u> in whose hands is My *indignation*,

<sup>6</sup>I send it against a *godless nation* and commission it against the *people* of *My fury* to capture booty and to seize plunder, and to *trample* them down like mud in the streets.

<sup>7</sup>Yet it does <u>not</u> so intend, <u>nor</u> does it plan so in its heart, but rather it is its **purpose** to *destroy* and to *cut off* many nations.

<sup>8</sup> For it says, "Are not my princes all kings? <sup>9</sup> "Is not Calno like Carchemish, Or Hamath like Arpad, Or Samaria like Damascus?

<sup>10</sup> "As **my hand** has reached to the **kingdoms** of the *idols*, whose **graven** *images* were **greater** than those of <u>Jerusalem</u> and Samaria,

<sup>11</sup> Shall I not **do to <u>Jerusalem</u>** and *her images* just as I have done to **Samaria** and *her idols*?"

2) The *Pronouncement* of Assyria's <u>Punishment</u> (10:12-19)

<sup>12</sup> So it will be that when **the Lord** has **completed** all **His work** on **Mount Zion** and on **Jerusalem**, **He** will say,

"I will <u>punish</u> the *fruit* of the *arrogant* heart of the <u>king of Assyria</u> and the pomp of his *haughtiness*." <sup>13</sup> For he has said, "By the power of <u>my hand</u> and by <u>my wisdom</u> I did *this*, for I have *understanding*; and <u>I removed</u> the boundaries of the peoples and plundered their treasures, and like a *mighty man* I brought down *their* inhabitants,

<sup>14</sup> And <u>my hand</u> reached to the riches of the peoples like a *nest*, and as one gathers *abandoned eggs*, <u>I gathered</u> all the *earth*; and there was *not one* that flapped its wing or opened *its* beak or chirped."

<sup>15</sup> Is the axe to *boast itself* over the one who chops with it? Is the saw to *exalt itself* over the one who wields it?

That would be like a **club** wielding **those** who **lift it**, Or like a **rod** lifting him who is **not wood**.

<sup>16</sup> Therefore the Lord, the GOD of hosts, will send a <u>wasting disease</u> among his stout warriors; and under his glory <u>a fire</u> will be kindled like a burning flame.

<sup>17</sup> And the light of Israel will become a <u>fire</u> and his Holy One a <u>flame</u>, and it will *burn* and *devour* his thorns and his briars in a *single day*.

<sup>18</sup> And <u>He</u> will *destroy* the glory of his forest and of his fruitful garden, both soul and body, and it will be as when a sick man <u>wastes away</u>.

<sup>19</sup> And the **rest** of the **trees** of his **forest** will be <u>so small</u> in *number* that a **child** could **write them down**.

3) The *Preservation* of Israel's <u>Remnant</u> (10:20-23)

<sup>20</sup> Now it will come about in *that day* that the <u>remnant</u> of Israel, and those of the house of Jacob who have escaped, will never again *rely* on the one who struck them, but will truly *rely* on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel.

<sup>21</sup> A <u>remnant</u> will *return*, the <u>remnant</u> of Jacob, to the mighty God.

<sup>22</sup> For though your people, O Israel, may be like the sand of the sea, Only a <u>remnant</u> within them will *return*; a destruction is determined, overflowing with *righteousness*.

<sup>23</sup> For a complete *destruction*, one that is *decreed,* the Lord GOD of hosts will execute in the midst of the whole land.

4) The *Prediction* of Assyria's <u>Destruction</u> (10:24-34)

<sup>24</sup> Therefore thus says the Lord GoD of hosts,

"O My people who dwell in Zion, do not fear the <u>Assyrian</u> who strikes you with the rod and lifts up his staff against you, the way Egypt *did*.

<sup>25</sup> For in a very little while **My indignation** *against you* will **be spent** and **My anger** *will be directed* to their <u>destruction</u>."

<sup>26</sup> The LORD of hosts will arouse a scourge against him like the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb; and <u>His staff</u> will be over the sea and He will lift it up the <u>way</u> He did in Egypt.

<sup>27</sup> So it will be in *that day*, that his *burden* will be <u>removed</u> from your shoulders and his *yoke* from your neck, and the yoke will be broken because of *fatness*...

He (Assyria) shakes his fist at the mountain of the daughter of Zion, the hill of Jerusalem.<sup>33</sup> Behold, the Lord, the GoD of hosts, will *lop off* the boughs with a terrible crash;

Those also who are **tall in stature** will be *cut down* and those who are **lofty** will be *abased*. <sup>34</sup> <u>He</u> will <u>cut down</u> the **thickets** of the **forest** with an **iron** *axe*, and **Lebanon** will <u>fall</u> by the **Mighty One**.

### <u>Tonight's Key Theme</u> The *Sovereign* Power of God

A. Who *sovereignly* used Assyria as His <u>instrument</u> to *chastise* Israel for their godlessness and sinfulness

> "Woe to Assyria, the <u>rod</u> of My anger and the <u>staff</u> in whose hands is My *indignation*,.." (10:5)

B. Who *sovereignly* declared <u>punishment</u> *against* <u>Assyria</u> for its **arrogance** and *over-reach* concerning Jerusalem

So it will be that when **the Lord** has **completed all His work** on **Mount Zion** and on **Jerusalem**, **He** will say,

"I will <u>punish</u> the *fruit* of the *arrogant* heart of the king of <u>Assyria</u> and the *pomp* of his *haughtiness*." (10:12)

# C. Who *sovereignly* promises the survival, and return of a <u>remnant</u> in Israel to their God

Now it will come about in *that day*... A <u>remnant</u> will *return*, the <u>remnant</u> of Jacob, to the mighty God. (10:20a, 21)

## Personal Application As Believers, <u>we too</u> are "tools" *used* by a Sovereign God to accomplish His Purposes

1. Being used by God as a Witness of His Gospel Message to the World

...and **you** shall be <u>My witnesses</u> both in *Jerusalem*, and in all *Judea* and *Samaria*, and even to the **remotest part** of the **earth**."(Acts 1:8)

<u>How</u>, then, can they *call* on the **one** they have **not** *believed in*? And <u>how</u> can they *believe* in the **one** of whom they have *not heard*? And <u>how</u> can they *hear* without <u>someone</u> *preaching to them*? (Romans 10:14)

2. Being used by God as "Instruments of Righteousness"

,...and **do not** go on presenting the *members* of **your body** to *sin* as *instruments* of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to <u>God</u>... and your *members* as *instruments* of <u>righteousness</u> to <u>God</u>. (Romans 6:13)

3. Being used by God as a "Light" in a dark world

Do all things without **grumbling** or **disputing**; so that you will prove yourselves to be **blameless** and **innocent**, **children of God above reproach** in the midst of a **crooked** and **perverse generation**, among whom <u>you</u> **appear** as <u>lights</u> in the **world**, holding fast the **word of life**,..(Philippians 2:14-16a)

4. Being used by God in "making <u>Disciples</u> of all nations" (Matt. 28:19)

I *planted*, Apollos *watered*, but God was causing the <u>growth</u>... For we are <u>God's fellow workers</u>; you are God's *field*, God's *building*. (I Corinthians 3:6, 9)

5. Being used by God to manifest His Glory

Let **your light** shine before **men** in such a way that they may **see** your **good works**, and **glorify your Father** who is in **heaven**. (Matthew 5:16)

6. Being *used* by God as a functioning member of the "<u>body</u> of Messiah," His <u>church</u>—the *means* by which we grow and <u>mature</u> into His likeness, and become the *living* witness of His Life and Salvation message in the world

Now you are Messiah's body, and individually members of it. (I Cor. 12:27)

And **He (Messiah)** gave (spiritual gifts)...for the *equipping* of the saints for the work of *service*, to the <u>building up</u> of the <u>body</u> of Messiah until we all attain to the *unity* of the faith, and of the *knowledge* of the **Son of God**, to a <u>mature man</u>, to the **measure** of the **stature** which belongs to the *fullness* of Messiah. (Ephesians 4:11a, 12-13)
