 - 11 Then a <u>shoot</u> will spring from the *stem* of *Jesse*, and a **branch** from **his** *roots* will **bear** *fruit*.
 - b. His Endowment with the Spirit of the LORD (11:2)

² The Spirit of the LORD will rest on Him,

the **spirit** of **wisdom** and **understanding**,

the spirit of counsel and strength,

the **spirit** of **knowledge** and the **fear** of **the Lord**.

- c. His *Rule* of <u>Righteousness</u> (11:3-5)
 - ³ And **He** will **delight** in the **fear** of **the LORD**, and **He** will **not judge** by what **His eyes see**, nor make **a decision** by what **His ears hear**,
 - ⁴ But with <u>righteousness</u> He will <u>judge</u> the poor, and <u>decide</u> with <u>fairness</u> for the <u>afflicted</u> of the <u>earth</u>;

and **He** will **strike** the earth with the <u>rod</u> of <u>His mouth</u>, and with the <u>breath</u> of **His lips** He will **slay** the wicked.

⁵ Also *righteousness* will be the **belt** about **His loins**, and *faithfulness* the **belt** about **His waist**.

d. His Restoration of Harmony and Peace (11:6-9)

⁶ And the **wolf** will *dwell* with the **lamb**, and the **leopard** will *lie down* with the **young goat**, and the **calf** and the **young lion** and the **fatling** together; and a **little boy** will *lead them*.

⁷ Also the **cow** and the **bear** will **graze**, their **young** will **lie down** together, and the **lion** will **eat straw** like the **ox**.

⁸ The **nursing child** will **play** by the **hole** of the **cobra**, and the **weaned child** will put his **hand** on the **viper's den**.

⁹ They will <u>not</u> hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain, for the earth will be *full* of the <u>knowledge</u> of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

e. **His Regathering** of the **Remnant of Israel** (11:10-12)

Then in *that day* the **nations** will *resort* to the **root of Jesse**, **Who** will **stand** as a <u>signal</u> for the **peoples**; and **His resting place** will be *glorious*.

¹¹ Then it will happen on *that day* that the Lord will again **recover** the *second* time with **His hand** the <u>remnant</u> of **His people**, who will **remain**,

From Assyria, Egypt, Pathros, Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.

¹² And He will lift up a <u>standard</u> for the *nations* and assemble the **banished** ones of *IsraeI*, and will gather the dispersed of *Judah* from the *four* corners of the earth.

f. His **Reconciliation** of **Judah** and **Israel** (11:13-16)

- 1) *removing* the **hostility** and **jealousy** between **them** (11:13)
- 2) reuniting them against their enemies (11:14-15a)
- 3) *restructuring* a "highway" for the return of the remnant from Assyria (11:15b-16)

13 Then the *jealousy* of <u>Ephraim</u> will depart, and those who *harass* <u>Judah</u> will be **cut off**; <u>Ephraim</u> will <u>not</u> be *jealous* of <u>Judah</u>, and <u>Judah</u> will not *harass* <u>Ephraim</u>.

14 They will swoop down on the slopes of the Philistines on the west; together they will plunder the sons of the east;

They will **possess Edom** and **Moab**, and the **sons of Ammon** will be **subject to them**. ¹⁵ And **the Lord** will **utterly destroy** the **tongue** of the **Sea of Egypt**

and **He (God)** will **wave His hand** over the *River* with **His scorching wind**; and **He** will **strike it** into **seven streams** and make *men* **walk over** *dry-shod*.

for the <u>remnant</u> of **His people** who will be **left**, just as there was for **Israel** in **the day** that they **came up out** of the **land of Egypt**.

Message Summary Isaiah's *Portrait* of the Messiah

A. Chapter 10 of Isaiah closes by proclaiming that the Lord would *judge*Assyria and "cut down" the thick "forest" of her army as it threatened
Jerusalem (10:34). Isaiah then continues in chapter 11 by declaring:

"Then a **shoot** (twig) will **spring** from the **stem** (stump) of **Jesse**, and a **branch** from **his roots** will **bear fruit**. (11:1)."

Many **Jewish sages** interpreted **Isaiah 11:1-5** as speaking of the **Messiah**, but did **not** stick to a **literal interpretation** of the **text**. According to this verse (11:1), the "**stump**" belonged to <u>Jesse</u>, **David's father**. **Isaiah** declared that a time would come when the **glorious House of David** would be **reduced** to **nothing** but the "**stump**" of a **felled tree**. The **Davidic dynasty**, during **this** time will have **lost** all its **power** and **glory**. And it's at **this time** "a <u>shoot</u> will **spring** from the <u>stem</u> (**stump**) of **Jesse**.

So **Messiah**, descending from the **royal line** of <u>David</u> (9:7) (Matthew 1:1, 6), would **appear** at a time when the **House of David** would be greatly **reduced** to essentially what it was during the **days of Jesse**. **Messiah** would come from **poverty**, and **lowly origins** at the time of **His birth**—from a "**stump**" *low* to the **ground**. But this "**branch**" from *his roots* would <u>bear fruit.</u> (11:1b) (Fruchtenbaum)

B. The *Messiah* would be **endowed** with the **fullness** of the **Spirit of the LORD**. In **His life** and **ministry**, **He** would **manifest** the **sevenfold attributes** of the **Spirit**.

"The <u>Spirit</u> of the LORD will *rest* on Him, the <u>spirit</u> of *wisdom* and *understanding*, the <u>spirit</u> of *counsel* and *strength*, the <u>spirit</u> of *knowledge* and the *fear* of the LORD." (11:2)

NEW TESTAMENT FULFILLMENT→

→ After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the <u>Spirit of God</u> descending as a dove and lighting on Him,

and behold, a **voice** out of the **heavens** said, "This is **My beloved Son**, in whom **I am well-pleased**." (Matthew 3:16-17)

- → "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure." (John 3:34)
- C. The *Messiah* will "*delight* in the <u>fear</u> of the LORD," (11:3a)
 - →And He who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him." (John 8:29)
- D. The *Messiah* will make *judgments* according to "<u>righteousness</u>...and *decide* with **fairness** for the *afflicted* of the **earth**." (11:3b-4a)
 - →And **He (Messiah)** sat down opposite the **treasury**, and *began* observing how the **people** were putting **money** into the **treasury**; and many **rich people** were putting in *large sums*.

A **poor widow** came and put in *two small copper coins*, which amount to a *cent*. Calling **His disciples** to **Him**, He said to them,

"Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury; for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to live on." (Mark 12:41-44)

→ "Do <u>not</u> judge according to *appearance*, but judge with <u>righteous</u> judgment."(John 7:24)

- E. The *Messiah* will one day bring <u>judgment</u>, "and **He** will *strike* the **earth** with the <u>rod</u> of **His mouth**, and with the <u>breath</u> of **His lips**He will *slay* the wicked.(11:4b)
 - → And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war...

From **His mouth** comes a **sharp sword**, so that with it **He** may **strike down** the **nations**, and **He** will **rule them** with a **rod of iron**; and **He treads** the **wine press** of the **fierce wrath** of **God**, **the Almighty**. (Revelation 19:11, 15)
