G. **Isaiah's** *Hymn* of **Praise** (12:1-6)

12 Then you will say on *that day*, "I will give <u>thanks</u> to You, O LORD;

For although You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, And You comfort me.

² "Behold, **God is my <u>salvation</u>**,

I will **trust** and **not be afraid**;

For the **LORD GOD** is my **strength** and **song**,

and **He** has become my <u>salvation</u>."

³ Therefore you will *joyously* draw water from the springs of <u>salvation</u>.

⁴ And in *that day* you will say, "Give <u>thanks</u> to the LORD, call on His name. Make known His *deeds* among the **peoples**;

Make them remember that His name is exalted."

⁵ <u>Praise</u> the Lord in song, for He has done excellent things; Let this be known throughout the earth.

⁶ Cry aloud and shout for *joy*, O inhabitant of Zion, For great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.

Personal Application Let us "Joyously draw Water from the Springs of Salvation" (12:3)

1. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of our own <u>salvation/deliverance</u> from sin and death

Therefore do not be **ashamed** of the **testimony** of **our Lord** or of **me** *His* **prisoner**, but join with *me* in *suffering* for the **gospel** according to the *power* of God,

who has <u>saved us</u> and *called us* with a *holy calling*, <u>not</u> according to <u>our works</u>, but according to <u>His own purpose</u> and <u>grace</u> which was granted us *in* <u>Messiah Jesus</u> from <u>all eternity</u>,

but now has been **revealed** by the **appearing** of our <u>Savior</u> <u>Messiah Jesus</u>, who **abolished** <u>death</u> and brought <u>life</u> and <u>immortality</u> to <u>light</u> through the **gospel**,..(II Timothy 1:8-10)

Therefore there is now <u>no condemnation</u> for those who are <u>in</u> **Messiah Jesus**. For the *law* of the **Spirit of <u>life</u> in Messiah Jesus** has set you *free* from the *law* of <u>sin</u> and of <u>death</u>. (Romans 8:1-2)

2. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of our <u>salvation</u> provided through the **love** and **grace of God**

"For God so loved the world,

that **He <u>gave</u> His only begotten Son**, that whoever **believes in Him** shall **not perish**, but have **eternal life**.

For **God** did not **send the Son** into the world to *judge* **the world**, but that the world might be <u>saved</u> *through Him*. (John 3:16-17)

For by **grace** you have been **saved** through **faith**; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the **gift of God**; (Ephesians 2:8)

3. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of our <u>redemption</u> and <u>forgiveness</u> of sins

In **Him (Messiah)** we have <u>redemption</u> through **His blood**, the <u>forgiveness</u> of our <u>trespasses</u>, according to the *riches* of *His grace* (Ephesians 1:7)

...knowing that you were **not** <u>redeemed</u> with perishable things like <u>silver</u> or <u>gold</u> from your <u>futile</u> way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with <u>precious blood</u>, as of a <u>lamb</u> <u>unblemished</u> and <u>spotless</u>, the <u>blood</u> of <u>Messiah</u>. (I Peter 1:18-19)

4. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of our being declared <u>righteous</u> before a holy God

But now apart from the Law the <u>righteousness</u> of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the **Prophets**,

even the <u>righteousness</u> of God through faith in Jesus the Messiah for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; for <u>all</u> have <u>sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God,.(Romans 3:21-23)

Therefore, having been <u>justified</u> (declared *righteous*) by **faith**, we have *peace* with **God** *through* our **Lord Jesus the Messiah**, (Romans 5:1)

5. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of our <u>reconciliation</u> with God

For it was the *Father's* good pleasure for all the *fullness* to dwell *in Him*, and *through Him* to <u>reconcile</u> all things to Himself, having made <u>peace</u> through the *blood* of His cross; *through Him*, *I say*, whether things on *earth* or things in *heaven*.

And although <u>you</u> were formerly <u>alienated</u> and <u>hostile</u> in mind, engaged in evil deeds, yet He has now <u>reconciled you</u> in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach— (Colossians 1:19-22)

6. Drawing joyously the "water" of a continual propitiation

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin.

And **if anyone sins**, we have an **Advocate** with the **Father**, **Jesus the Messiah** the **righteous**;

and **He Himself** is the **propitiation** for **our sins**;

and **not** for **ours only**, but also for **those** of the **whole world**. (I John 2:1-2)

7. Drawing *joyously* the "water" of a <u>living hope</u>

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus the Messiah, who according to His *great mercy* has caused us to be *born again* to a <u>living hope</u> through the *resurrection* of Jesus the Messiah from the dead, (I Peter 1:3)

8. Drawing joyously the "water" of an eternal atonement

Every **priest** stands **daily ministering** and **offering** time after time the same **sacrifices**, which can **never take away sins**;

but **He (Messiah),** having **offered <u>one</u> sacrifice** for **sins** for <u>all time</u>, **SAT DOWN** AT THE **RIGHT HAND OF GOD**, waiting from that time onward UNTIL **HIS ENEMIES** BE MADE A **FOOTSTOOL** FOR **HIS FEET.**

For by <u>one offering</u> He has *perfected* for <u>all time</u> those who are <u>sanctified</u>. (Hebrews 10:11-14)

Closing Text

Jesus answered and said to **her** (Samaritan woman),

"Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again; but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life."
