I. **Pronouncing** the **Coming** *Wrath* upon *all* <u>Nations</u> (34:1-17)

1. The *Dire* Appeal to the <u>Nations</u> (34:1)

34 Draw near, O <u>nations</u>, to *hear*, and *listen*, O <u>peoples</u>! Let the <u>earth</u> and all it contains *hear*, and the <u>world</u> and **all** that **springs from it.**

2. The *Destruction* of their <u>Armies</u> (34:2-3)

² For the LORD's indignation is against all the nations, and *His* wrath against all their <u>armies</u>;
He has utterly <u>destroyed</u> them,
He has given them over to <u>slaughter</u>.

³ So their **slain** will be *thrown out,* and their **corpses** will give off their *stench*, and the **mountains** will be **drenched** with their *blood.*

3. The *Diminishing* of the <u>Heavens</u> (34:4)

⁴ And **all** the <u>host of heaven</u> will *wear away*, And the <u>sky</u> will be *rolled up* like a scroll; All their <u>hosts</u> will also *wither away* as a **leaf withers** from the **vine**, or as *one withers* from the **fig tree**.

- 4. The *Doom* of <u>Edom</u> (34:5-10)
 - a. a *people* "<u>devoted</u> to destruction" (34:5)
 - b. a *land* "soaked" in <u>blood</u> (34:6-8)
 - c. a *land* of "unquenchable" <u>burning</u> (34:9-10)

⁵ For My sword is satiated in heaven, behold it shall descend for <u>judgment</u> upon <u>Edom</u> and upon the people whom I have <u>devoted</u> to destruction.

⁶ The **sword** of **the LORD** is filled with **blood**, it is sated with **fat**, with the **blood** of **lambs** and **goats**, with the **fat** of the **kidneys** of **rams**.

For the LORD has a *sacrifice* in Bozrah and a *great slaughter* in the land of <u>Edom</u>.

⁷ Wild oxen will also fall with them and young bulls with strong ones; thus their land will be soaked with blood, and their dust become greasy with fat.

> ⁸ For **the LORD** has a <u>day of vengeance</u>, a year of *recompense* for the *cause* of Zion.

⁹ Its streams will be turned into *pitch*, and its loose earth into *brimstone*, and its land will become *burning pitch*.

¹⁰ It will not be <u>quenched</u> night or day; its *smoke* will go up *forever*.

From generation to generation it will be <u>desolate</u>; *None* will pass through it *forever* and *ever*.

5. The *Desolation* of the <u>Land</u> (34:11-15)

¹¹ But **pelican** and **hedgehog** will possess it, and **owl** and **raven** will dwell in it;

and **He** will stretch over it the *line* of <u>desolation</u> and the *plumb line* of <u>emptiness</u>.

¹² Its **nobles**—there is **no one** there **whom** they may proclaim **king** and all its **princes** will be **nothing**. ¹³ Thorns will come up in its *fortified* towers, nettles and thistles in its *fortified* cities;
It will also be a haunt of jackals and an abode of ostriches.

¹⁴ The desert creatures will meet with the wolves, the hairy goat also will cry to its kind;

Yes, the **night monster** will settle there and will find **herself** a **resting place**.

¹⁵ The **tree snake** will make its **nest** and lay **eggs** there, and it will hatch and gather *them* under its **protection**.

Yes, the hawks will be gathered there, every one with its kind.

6. The *Directive* to seek <u>Prophetic Confirmation</u> (34:16-17)

¹⁶ Seek from the book of the LORD, and read:

Not one of these will be missing; none will lack its mate.

For His mouth has commanded, and His Spirit has gathered them.

¹⁷ He has cast the lot for them, and His hand has divided it to them by line. they shall possess it forever; from generation to generation they will dwell in it.

Personal Application Terrible <u>Judgments</u> are coming, and they are devastating, but <u>these</u> things I know—

 \rightarrow 1. *I know* from scripture that God is just, and His judgments are just and righteous.

Abraham came near (to the Lord) and said, "Will You indeed sweep away the *righteous* with the *wicked*?...

Far be it from **You!** Shall not the <u>Judge</u> of **all the earth** deal <u>justly</u>?" (Genesis 18:23a, 25b)

And **He** will *judge* the **world** in <u>righteousness</u>; **He** will execute *judgment* for the **peoples** with <u>equity</u>. (Psalm 9:8)

And I saw **heaven** *opened*, and behold, a **white horse**, and **He** who sat on it *is* called **Faithful** and **True**, and in <u>righteousness</u> He <u>judges</u> and wages <u>war</u>. (Revelation 19:11)

 \rightarrow 2. *I know* that **God** has shown great <u>tolerance</u> and <u>perseverance</u> towards a sinful,

rebellious, and **decadent humanity**. However, there will be a time when **man's iniquity** and **evil** reach <u>full measure</u>, and a *righteous* and *holy* God must bring <u>judgment</u> against sin.

Then **the LORD** saw that the **wickedness of man** was *great* on the **earth**, and that **every intent** of the **thoughts** of **his heart** was **only** <u>evil</u> **continually**.., and **He** was *grieved* in **His heart**.

The LORD said, "I will <u>blot out man</u> whom I have created from the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the sky; for I am *sorry* that I have *made* them." (Genesis 6:5-7)

Or do you think **lightly (O man)** of the *riches* of **His** *kindness* and *tolerance* and *patience*, not knowing that the *kindness* of **God** leads you to **repentance**?

But because of **your stubbornness** and **unrepentant heart** you are **storing up** <u>wrath</u> for yourself in the <u>day of wrath</u> and **revelation** of the **righteous** <u>judgment</u> of God, who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO <u>HIS DEEDS</u>: (Romans 2:4-6)

Therefore having *overlooked* the **times of ignorance**, **God** is **now declaring** to **men** that **all** *people* everywhere should *repent*,

because **He** has **fixed a day** in which **He** will **judge** the **world** in **righteousness** *through* **a Man** whom **He** has **appointed**, having furnished **proof** to **all men** by **raising Him** from the **dead**." (Acts 17:30-31)

→3. *I know* that I do <u>not *fully* understand</u> the judgments of God. For God is *infinite* in wisdom, knowledge, and understanding, and that His judgments are "unsearchable," and His <u>ways</u> are "unfathomable" (Romans 11:33).

Therefore do <u>not</u> go on **passing judgment** before **the time**, but wait until **the Lord** comes who will both bring **to** <u>light</u> the things *hidden* in the **darkness** and **disclose** the *motives* of *men's* hearts; and then each man's **praise** will come **to** him from **God**. (I Corinthians 4:5)

> For **the LORD knows** the **way** of the **righteous**, But the **way** of the **wicked** will **perish**. (Psalm 1:6)

→4. *I know*, just as we read tonight, that God will <u>avenge</u> His people, and bring judgments against *those* who have persecuted and harmed them.

For **the LORD** has a **day of** <u>vengeance</u>, a year of *recompense* for the **cause of** *Zion*. (Isaiah 34:8)

Say to those with **anxious heart**, "Take **courage, fear not.** Behold, **your God** will **come** *with* <u>vengeance</u>; the *recompense* of **God** will **come**, but **He** will <u>save you</u>." (Isaiah 35:4)
