"The **Evangelical** Prophet" VI. Isaiah's Divine *Prophecies* of <u>Consolation</u> for Israel (40:1-48:22)

A. The *Pronouncement* of Judah's time of <u>Comfort</u> (40:1-11)

B. The *Proclamation* of the <u>Greatness</u> of God (40:12-31)

1. The **Immensity** of **God** (40:12)

¹² Who has measured the <u>waters</u> in the hollow of His hand, And marked off the <u>heavens</u> by the span,

And **calculated** the <u>dust</u> of the earth by the **measure**, And **weighed** the <u>mountains</u> in a **balance** And the <u>hills</u> in a **pair of scales**?

2. The **Omniscience** of **God** (40:13-14)

¹³ Who has <u>directed</u> the Spirit of the LORD, or as His counselor has informed Him?

¹⁴ With whom did He consult and who gave Him understanding?

And *who* taught Him in the path of justice and taught Him <u>knowledge</u> and informed Him of the way of <u>understanding</u>?

3. The **Inferiority** of **Man** (40:15-17)

¹⁵ Behold, the **nations** are like a <u>drop</u> from a bucket, and are regarded as a **speck of** <u>dust</u> on the scales; Behold, **He** *lifts up* the islands like <u>fine dust</u>.

> ¹⁶ Even **Lebanon** is <u>not enough</u> to *burn,* Nor its <u>beasts</u> enough for a *burnt offering*.

¹⁷ *All* the **nations** are as *nothing* before **Him**, they are regarded **by Him** as *less than nothing* and *meaningless*.

4. The **<u>Futility</u>** of *Idolatry* (40:18-20)

¹⁸ To whom then will you <u>liken</u> God? or what likeness will you <u>compare</u> with Him? ¹⁹ As for the <u>idol</u>, a craftsman casts it, a goldsmith plates it with gold, and a silversmith fashions chains of silver.

²⁰ He who is too impoverished for such an offering selects a <u>tree</u> that does not rot;

He seeks out for himself a skillful craftsman to prepare an <u>idol</u> that will not *totter*.

5. The **Preeminence** of **God** (40:21-24)

²¹ Do you not know? Have you not heard?Has it not been declared to you from the *beginning*?Have you not understood from the *foundations* of the earth?

²² It is <u>He</u> who sits above the *circle* of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers,

Who stretches out the *heavens* like a curtain and spreads them out like a *tent* to dwell in.

²³ He *it is* who reduces rulers to *nothing*,Who makes the judges of the earth *meaningless*.

²⁴ Scarcely have they been planted, Scarcely have they been sown,

Scarcely has their stock taken root in the earth, But <u>He</u> merely <u>blows</u> on them, and they wither, and the storm carries them away like stubble.

6. The **Omnipotence** of **God** (40:25-26)

²⁵ "To **whom** then will you **liken Me** that I would be *his* equal?" says the Holy One.

²⁶ Lift up your eyes on high and see who has <u>created</u> these stars,

The **One** who **leads forth** their host by **number**, **He calls them** all by **name**;

Because of the greatness of *His* <u>might</u> and the strength of *His* <u>power</u>, <u>Not</u> one of them is *missing*.

 7. The <u>Perception</u> of God and <u>Provision</u> of <u>His strength</u> (40:27-31)
 ²⁷ Why do you say, O Jacob, and assert, O Israel, "My way is <u>hidden</u> from the LORD, and the <u>justice</u> due me escapes the notice of my God"?

²⁸ Do you not know? Have you not heard?

The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth Does <u>not</u> become *weary* or *tired.* His <u>understanding</u> is *inscrutable*.

> ²⁹ He gives <u>strength</u> to the weary, and to him who lacks might He increases <u>power</u>.

³⁰ Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly,

> ³¹ Yet *those* who <u>wait</u> for <u>the LORD</u> will *gain* new *strength*;

they will *mount up with* wings like **eagles**, they will *run* and **not get** *tired*, they will *walk* and **not become** *weary*.

Message Summary—Challenge The *fool* has said in his heart, "There is no God." (Psalm 14:1) That being said, we have just a few <u>questions</u> for the *Wise* and *Powerful* in this world:

- Who do you know that is so <u>immense</u> that they can measure the waters (all waters) in the <u>hollow</u> of His hand, and measure the heavens by the <u>span</u> of His hand (40:12a)?
 Who do you know that can calculate by <u>measure</u> the *dust* of the earth, or weigh the *mountains*, and the *hills* by scales (40:12b)?
- 2. Who among you has <u>directed</u> the Spirit of the LORD as to what He should do, or has been His "guidance <u>counselor</u>." With whom did God <u>consult</u> to gain a better understanding of a matter (40:13-14a)? Who taught God, the righteous <u>Judge</u> of all the earth (Gen. 18:25, Ps. 98:9), the way of justice (40:14b)? Who among those created by God can <u>teach</u> the One who created *them* knowledge, and the way of understanding (40:14c-d)?
- 3. Who among men, or what has man developed or "created" that can <u>compare</u> with the <u>greatness</u> of the eternal God? What or who have men lifted up, or "idolized," that can be likened to the *Person* and *Power* of our <u>Incomparable God</u> and <u>Creator</u> (40:18-26)?

Whose <u>greatness</u> has been declared for us to understand and know from the beginning, from the foundations of the earth (40:21)

Who sits above the circle of the earth (40:22a)

Who <u>stretches out</u> the heavens like a curtain, <u>spreading</u> them like a tent to dwell in (40:22b)

Who <u>reduces rulers</u> to nothing, and makes the <u>judges</u> of the earth meaningless (40:23)

Who has <u>created</u> the stars—*leading* their host by number, *calling them* all by name (40:26)

Personal Application *That* being said, a few **questions** for <u>Believers</u> too

1. *Do you* think your way is "hidden" from God, and *do you* think that He will *not* bring about the <u>justice</u> that is due to you (40:27)?

He shall *bring forth* your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday (Psalm 37:6).

- 2. *Do you* not know that the "Everlasting God" does *not* become <u>weary</u> or <u>tired</u> regarding *our* pain and weaknesses (40:28a)?
- 3. *Do you* realize that because He is the infinite God, *His* <u>understanding</u> of matters will be <u>beyond</u> *our* ability to understand (40:28b)?

His <u>understanding</u> is inscrutable (40:28b).

4. Do you not know that God gives <u>strength</u> to the *weary*? That *those* who "<u>wait</u> for the LORD," and <u>trust Him</u> will "gain new <u>strength</u> (40:29a, 31a)?"

For this reason I (Paul) **bow my knees** before the **Father**, from whom every **family** in **heaven** and on **earth** derives **its name**, that **He** would **grant you**, according to the **riches** of *His glory*, to be <u>strengthened</u> with <u>power</u> *through* <u>His Spirit</u> in the <u>inner man</u>,.. (Ephesians 3:14-16)
