Whom I have taken by the right hand,
to <u>subdue</u> nations before him
and to <u>loose</u> the loins of kings;
to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut:

² "I will go before you and make the rough places *smooth*; I will shatter the doors of bronze and cut through their iron bars.

³ "I will give you the <u>treasures</u> of darkness and <u>hidden wealth</u> of secret places, so that you may know that **it is I**, the **LORD**, **the God of Israel**, who *calls you* by **your name**.

⁴ "For the **sake** of **Jacob My servant**, and **Israel My chosen one**, I have also called you by **your name**;

I have given you **a title** of **honor** though you have **not known Me**.

⁷The **One forming** *light* and <u>creating</u> *darkness*, causing *well-being* and <u>creating</u> *calamity*;

I am the LORD who does all these.

8 "Drip down, O heavens, from above, and let the clouds pour down righteousness; Let the earth open up and salvation bear fruit, and righteousness spring up with it.

I, the LORD, have created it.

⁹ "Woe to the one who <u>quarrels</u> with his Maker an earthenware vessel among the vessels of earth! Will the <u>clay</u> say to the <u>potter</u>, 'What are you doing?' Or the <u>thing</u> you are making say, 'He has no hands'?

¹⁰ "Woe to him who says to a **father**, '<u>What</u> are **you begetting**?'

Or to a **woman**, 'To <u>what</u> are you **giving birth**?''

¹¹ Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker:

"Ask Me about the **things to come** concerning *My sons*, and you shall **commit to Me** the *work* of My hands.

¹² "It is I who <u>made</u> the earth, and <u>created</u> man upon it. I stretched out the heavens with *My hands* and I ordained all their host.

¹³ "I have **aroused him** (Cyrus) in **righteousness** and **I will make** all his ways **smooth**;

He will build My <u>city</u> and will let <u>My exiles</u> go free, without any payment or reward," says the LORD of hosts.

Message Summary

The Sovereignty of God—5 Key Observations

- A. God will *Sovereignly* "anoint" and empower <u>King Cyrus</u> to accomplish **His Purposes**.
 - 1. *Empowering* him to <u>subdue</u> nations and kings (45:1-2)
 - 2. *Endowing* him with <u>treasures</u> and <u>wealth</u> (45:3)
 - 3. Exalting him to accomplish His purposes in freeing Israel (45:4, 13)

13 "I have *aroused* him (Cyrus) in righteousness and I will make all his ways smooth;

<u>He</u> will **build My** *city* and will **let My** *exiles* **go** free, *without* any payment or reward," says the **LORD of hosts** (45:13)

B. **God** is both *Sovereign* and <u>Unique</u>.

⁵ "I am **the LORD**, and there is **no other**; besides **Me** there is **no God**...

⁶ That **men may know** from the **rising** to the **setting** of the sun that there is **no one besides Me**.

I am the LORD, and there is **no other**, (45:5-6)

- C. God is our *Sovereign* Creator who <u>creates</u> all things according to *His* Purposes.
 - 1. "Forming light and creating darkness, "(45:7a)
 - 2. "Causing well-being and creating calamity;" (45:7b)
 - 3. Letting the "clouds pour down righteousness;"
 Letting the "earth open up," and "salvation bear fruit," and "righteousness spring up with it." (45:8)
- D. God is our *Sovereign* Creator, and those who <u>quarrel</u> with their *Maker* are likened to→
 - \rightarrow the *clay* that questions the skill of its maker—the potter (45:9)
 - \rightarrow the *child* that **questions** the <u>father</u> who *begat* him (45:10a)
 - → the *child* that **questions** the **mother** who **gave** *birth* to **him** (45:10b)
- E. God is the *Sovereign* Creator and Sustainer of <u>Israel</u>—
 - 1. *Proclaiming* to be Israel's <u>Maker</u>, and the work His "hands" (45:11)
 - 2. **Proclaiming** to be the **Creator of man**, and **all things** on **earth** and in

the *heavens* (45:12)

3. *Proclaiming* that it is **He** who has "aroused" Cyrus to bring <u>restoration</u> to the exiles of Israel (45:13)
