4. The *Exceeding* Power of God (46:1-13)

a. His Subjugation of the Babylonian gods (46:1-2)

¹<u>Bel</u> has *bowed down*, <u>Nebo</u> *stoops over*; their **images** are *consigned* to the **beasts** and the **cattle**. The things that you **carry** are **burdensome**, a **load** for the **weary** *beast*.

²They **stooped over**, they have **bowed down** together; they could **not rescue** the **burden**, but have themselves **gone into** captivity.

b. His Sustaining of <u>Israel</u> in every age (46:3-4)

³ "Listen to Me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, You who have been borne by Me from birth and have been carried from the womb;

⁴ Even to *your* **old age** I will be the **same**, and even to *your* **graying years** I will **bear you!**I have done *it*, and I will **carry you**; and I will **bear you** and I will **deliver you**.

c. His Superiority over Heathen Idols (46:5-7)

⁵ "To whom would you **liken Me** and make **Me equal** and **compare Me**, that we would be **alike?**

⁶ "Those who lavish **gold** from the purse and weigh **silver** on the scale hire a **goldsmith**, and he makes it *into* **a god**; they **bow down**, indeed they **worship it.**

⁷ "They lift it upon the **shoulder** and **carry it**; they set it in its **place** and it **stands** there. It does **not move** from its place.

Though one may cry to it, it *cannot* answer; It *cannot* deliver him from his distress.

d. His Strong Plea for Israel to "Remember" (46:8-11)

⁸ "Remember this, and be assured; Recall it to mind, you transgressors.

⁹ "Remember the former things long past, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me,

¹⁰ Declaring the **end** from the **beginning**, and from **ancient times** things which have **not been done**,

Saying, 'My purpose will be established, and I will accomplish all My good pleasure';

11 Calling a **bird of prey** from the **east**, the **man** of **My purpose** from a **far country**.

Truly I have **spoken**; **truly** I will bring it **to pass**.

I have **planned it**, **surely** I will **do it**.

e. His Sovereign Promise of Salvation

(46:12-13)

- 1) **Denouncing** the "stubborn-minded" (46:12)
- 2) *Disclosing* His coming righteousness (46:13a)
- 3) **Declaring salvation** in **Zion** (46:13b)

12 "Listen to Me, you stubborn-minded, who are far from righteousness.

¹³ "I bring near My <u>righteousness</u>, it is not far off; and My <u>salvation</u> will not delay.

And I will grant salvation in Zion, and My glory for Israel.

Personal Application Tonight we read that God exhorted Israel to:

"Remember this, and be assured;...

"Remember the former things long past, for I am God, and there is no other, I am God, and there is no one like Me," (46:8a, 9)

As **Believers**, we also need to **Remember**—

- 1) We need to *Remember* the Sovereign Power of God \rightarrow
 - → The *Power* that Conceived Israel—

Now the LORD said to Abram,..
..."I will make you a great nation,..(Genesis12:1a, 2a)

→ The *Power* that <u>Redeemed</u> Israel (from Egypt)—

Say, therefore, to the **sons of Israel**, 'I am **the LORD**, and I will **bring you out** from under the **burdens** of the Egyptians, and I will **deliver you** from their **bondage**.

I will also <u>redeem you</u> with an **outstretched arm** and with **great** *judgments*. (Exodus 6:6)

→ The *Power* that **Preserves Israel**

"Listen to Me, **O house of Jacob**, and all the **remnant** of the **house of Israel**, you who have been **borne** by **Me** from **birth** and have been **carried** from the **womb**;

Even to *your* **old age** I will be the **same**, and even to *your* **graying years** I will **bear you**!

I have done *it*, and **I will carry you**; and **I will bear you** and **I will deliver you**. (Isaiah 46:3-4)

Behold, **He** who **keeps Israel** will **neither slumber** nor **sleep.** (Psalm 121:4)

2) We need to *Remember* the Sacred Precepts of God→

This book of the <u>law</u> shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful <u>to do</u> according to *all* that is written in it; for then you will make your way *prosperous*, and then you will have *success*. (Joshua 1:8)

The <u>law</u> of the LORD is *perfect*, restoring the soul;
The <u>testimony</u> of the LORD is *sure*, making wise the simple.
The <u>precepts</u> of the LORD are *right*, rejoicing the heart;

The **commandment** of **the Lord** is **pure**, **enlightening the eyes**.

The **fear** of **the Lord** is **clean**, enduring **forever**;
The **judgments** of **the Lord** are **true**; they are **righteous altogether**.

(Psalm 19:7-9)

I will never forget **Your precepts**, For **by them You** have given me **life**. (Psalm 119:93)

Thus says **the LORD**,

"**Stand** by the ways and see and **ask** for the **ancient paths**,

Where the **good way** is, and **walk** in it;

and you will find **rest** for **your souls**.

But they **(Israel) said**, 'We will **not walk in it.**' (Jeremiah 6:16)

- 3) We need to *Remember* the **Steadfast <u>Promises</u> of God**→
 - A. The *Promises* given to **Israel**:
 - → The *Promise* of **God's Everlasting <u>Love</u>** (Jer. 31:3) (Deut. 7:7-8) (Rom. 11:28)
 - → The *Promise* of Israel's Final <u>Salvation</u> (Jer. 23:3-6) (Isa. 45:17) (Rom. 11:26-27)
 - → The *Promise* of Israel's Final <u>Restoration</u> (Amos 9:14-15) (Jer. 32:37-41) (Zeph. 3:20)
 - B. The *Promises* given to <u>Believers</u>:
 - → The *Promise* of an **Everlasting Love**

For I am **convinced** that neither **death**, nor **life**, nor **angels**, nor **principalities**, nor things **present**, nor things **to come**, nor **powers**, nor **height**, nor **depth**, nor any other **created thing**, will be able to **separate us** from the **love of God**, which is **in Messiah Jesus our Lord**. (Romans 8:38-39)

→ The *Promise* of a **Final "Physical" Salvation** (Rom. 8:23)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus the Messiah, who...has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus the Messiah from the dead,. who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. (I Peter 1:3-5)

→ The *Promise* of a Future Glory

For those whom **He** *foreknew*, **He** also *predestined to become* **conformed** to the **image** of **His Son**,...

and these whom **He** *predestined*, **He** also *called*; and these whom **He** *called*, **He** also *justified*; and these whom **He** *justified*, **He** also *glorified*. (Romans 8:29-30)
