### G. The *Preeminence* of the <u>God of Israel</u> (45:1-48:22)

# 5. The *Expulsion* of the <u>Babylonian Empire</u> (47:1-15)

a. The *Downfall* of her <u>Exalted Position</u> (47:1-5)

<sup>1</sup>"Come down and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of <u>Babylon</u>; Sit on the ground without a throne, O daughter of the <u>Chaldeans!</u> For you shall no longer be called tender and delicate.

> <sup>2</sup> "Take the millstones and grind meal. Remove your veil, strip off the skirt, uncover the leg, cross the rivers.

<sup>3</sup> "Your *nakedness* will be uncovered, your *shame* also will be exposed;
I will take vengeance and will <u>not</u> spare a man."

<sup>4</sup> Our Redeemer, the LORD of hosts is His name, the Holy One of Israel.

<sup>5</sup> "Sit silently, and go into **darkness**, **O** *daughter* of the <u>Chaldeans</u>, for you will *no longer* be called the <u>gueen</u> of kingdoms.

b. The *Declaration* of her <u>Arrogance</u> (47:6-8)

<sup>6</sup> "I was angry with *My people*, I profaned *My heritage* and gave them into your hand.

You did <u>not</u> show mercy to them, on the *aged* you made your yoke <u>very heavy</u>. <sup>7</sup> "Yet **you said**, 'I will be a <u>queen</u> forever.' These things you did <u>not</u> consider nor remember the <u>outcome</u> of them.

<sup>8</sup> "Now, then, hear this, you <u>sensual</u> one, who dwells securely, who says in your heart, 'I am, and there is *no one* besides <u>me</u>.

I will not sit as a widow, nor know loss of children.'

### c. The *Devastating* Results of her <u>Wickedness</u> (47:9-11)

<sup>9</sup>"But these **two things** will come on you **suddenly** in <u>one day</u>: loss of *children* and *widowhood*.

> They will come on you in **full measure** in spite of your **many** <u>sorceries</u>, in spite of the **great power** of your **spells**.

 <sup>10</sup> "You felt *secure* in your wickedness and said, 'No one sees me,'
 your *wisdom* and your *knowledge*, they have deluded you; for you have said in your heart,
 'I am, and there is *no one* besides me.'

<sup>11</sup> "But evil will come on you which you will <u>not</u> know how to charm away; and <u>disaster</u> will fall on you for which you cannot atone; and destruction about which you do not know will come on you suddenly

#### d. The *Deficiency* of her <u>Religion</u> (47:12-15)

<sup>12</sup> "Stand *fast* now in **your <u>spells</u>** and in your **many <u>sorceries</u>** with which you have **labored** from your **youth**; perhaps you will be able to **profit**, perhaps you may cause **trembling**.

<sup>13</sup> "You are *wearied* with your many counsels; let now the <u>astrologers</u>, those who prophesy by the *stars*, those who <u>predict</u> by the *new moons*, stand up and *save* you from what will come upon you.

<sup>14</sup> "Behold, they have become like stubble, <u>fire</u> burns them; they *cannot* deliver themselves from the power of the <u>flame</u>; there will be no coal to warm by *nor* a fire to sit before!

<sup>15</sup> "So have those become to you with whom you have labored, who have trafficked with you from your youth; each has wandered in his own way; there is none to save you.

## Personal Application So What led to the Downfall of Babylon, "the <u>Queen</u> of the Kingdoms?"

### 1. Her Excessive Abuse of God's People (Israel)

<sup>6</sup> "I was **angry** with **My people**, I **profaned My heritage** and **gave them** into **your hand**.

You **did** <u>not</u> show <u>mercy</u> to **them**, on the **aged** you made **your yoke** <u>very heavy</u>.

<sup>7</sup> "Yet you said, 'I will be a <u>queen</u> *forever*." These things you did **not consider** nor **remember** the *outcome* of **them**. (47:6-7)

#### 2. Her Extreme Arrogance and Self Exaltation

<sup>8</sup> "Now, then, hear this, you (Babylon) sensual one, who dwells securely, who says in your heart, 'I am, and there is *no one* besides <u>me</u>.

I will not sit as a widow, nor know loss of children ... '

 <sup>10</sup> "You felt secure in your <u>wickedness</u> and said, 'No one sees me,'
 your wisdom and your knowledge, they have deluded you; for you have said in your heart, 'I am, and there is no one besides me.'

<sup>11</sup> "But evil will come on you which you will <u>not</u> know how to charm away; and <u>disaster</u> will fall on you for which you cannot atone; and destruction about which you do not know will come on you suddenly. (47:10-11)

#### 3. Her *Embrace* of <u>Sorceries</u> and <u>Occultism</u> – False Religion

<sup>9</sup>"But these **two things** will come on you **(Babylon)** suddenly in <u>one day</u>: *loss* of **children** and **widowhood**.

> They will come on you in **full measure** in spite of your many **sorceries**, in spite of the **great power** of your **spells**.

<sup>10</sup> "You felt secure in your <u>wickedness</u> and said, 'No one sees me,' your wisdom and your knowledge, they have deluded you;...

<sup>13</sup> "You are *wearied* with your many counsels; let now the <u>astrologers</u>, those who prophesy by the *stars*, those who <u>predict</u> by the *new moons*, stand up and save you from what will come upon you.

<sup>14</sup> "Behold, they have become like stubble, <u>fire</u> burns them; they *cannot* deliver themselves from the power of the <u>flame</u>; (47:9-10, 13-14)

## Another New Testament Connection Isaiah's depiction of the Destruction of Babylon is <u>similar</u> to the Destruction of Babylon described in the book of Revelation Chapter <u>18</u>

18 After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was *illumined* with his glory.

And he cried out with a **mighty voice**, saying, "*Fallen, fallen* is <u>Babylon</u> the great! She has become a dwelling place of *demons* and a **prison** of every *unclean spirit*, and a **prison** of every **unclean** and **hateful bird...** 

...the **kings** of the **earth** have committed *acts of* **immorality** with her, and the *merchants* of the **earth** have become **rich** by the **wealth** of **her** <u>sensuality</u>."

I heard another voice from heaven, saying, "Come out of her, *my* people, so that you will not participate in her sins and receive of her plagues; for her sins have piled up as high as heaven, and God has *remembered* her iniquities...

To the **degree** that she <u>glorified herself</u> and <u>lived sensuously</u>, to the same **degree** give her torment and mourning; for she says in her heart, 'I SIT *as* A <u>QUEEN</u> AND I AM NOT A <u>WIDOW</u>, and will *never* see mourning.'

For this reason in <u>one day</u> her **plagues** will come, **pestilence** and **mourning** and **famine**, and she will be *burned up* with <u>fire</u>; for the Lord God who judges her is strong.

"And the **kings** of the **earth**, who committed *acts of* **immorality** and lived *sensuously* with **her**, will **weep** and **lament** over her when they see the smoke of **her** *burning*, standing at a distance because of the **fear** of her **torment**, saying,

**'Woe, woe**, the **great city**, **Babylon**, the **strong** <u>city</u>! For in <u>one hour</u> your *judgment* has come...' (Revelation 18:1-2, 3a, 4-5, 7-10)
