# VI. Isaiah's Divine *Prophecies* of <u>Consolation</u> for Israel (40:1-48:22)

#### G. The *Preeminence* of the God of Israel (45:1-48:22)

- 1. The *Elevation* of King Cyrus (45:1-4)
- 2. The *Excellence* of the **Sovereign God** (45:5-13)
- 3. The *End-time* Conversion of the Gentiles (45:14-25)

## 6. The *Enduring* Faithfulness of Israel's God (48:1-16)

a. *Whose* followers (**Israel**) claim **belief** in **Him**, but *walk* in **unrighteousness** (48:1-2)

48 "Hear this, O house of Jacob, who are named Israel and who came forth from the loins of Judah, who swear by the name of the LORD and invoke the God of Israel, but not in truth nor in righteousness.

<sup>2</sup> "For they **call themselves** after the **holy city** and **lean** on the **God of Israel**; the **LORD of hosts** is **His name**.

- b. *Who* has <u>faithfully</u> brought to <u>pass</u> things prophesied from "<u>long ago</u>" (48:3-5)
  - 1) As a **testimony** to an **obstinate** and **hardened Israel** (48:3-4)
  - 2) As a **hopeful deterrent** to a people prone to **idolatry** (48:5)

<sup>3</sup> "I declared the former things long ago and they went forth from My mouth, and I proclaimed them. Suddenly I acted, and they came to pass. <sup>4</sup> "Because I know that you are *obstinate,* and your **neck** is an **iron sinew** and your **forehead bronze**,

<sup>5</sup> therefore I declared them to you long ago, before they took place I proclaimed them to you,

so that you would <u>not say</u>, 'My <u>idol</u> has done them, and my *graven image* and my *molten image* have commanded them.'

- c. Who now predicts "new things" that were previously hidden (48:6-8)
  - 1) So that **Israel** *cannot* claim to have previously <u>known</u> them (48:6-7)
  - 2) So that Israel would not deal "treacherously" (48:8)

6 "You have heard; look at all this. And you, will you not declare it?

I proclaim to you <u>new things</u> from this time, even <u>hidden</u> things which you have **not known**.

7 "They are created now and not long ago; and before today you have not heard them, so that you will not say, 'Behold, I knew them.'

8 "You have not heard, you have not known.
Even from long ago your ear has not been open,
because I knew that you would deal very treacherously;
and you have been called a rebel from birth.

- d. Who has <u>delayed</u> His wrath for His <u>name's</u> sake (48:9-11)
  - 1) **Restraining it** that **Israel** may **not** be "cut off" (48:9)
  - 2) **Refining Israel** through a "**furnace** of **affliction**" (48:10)
  - 3) **Responding** in the way that will maintain **His glory** (48:11)

9 "For the sake of My name I delay My wrath, and for My praise I restrain it for you, in order not to cut you off.

<sup>10</sup> "Behold, I have *refined you*, but not as silver; I have *tested you* in the <u>furnace</u> of affliction.

11 "For My own sake, for My own sake, I will act; for how can *My name* be profaned? And My glory I will *not* give to another. e. *Who* in <u>faithfulness</u> has accomplished **His** *sovereign* and *eternal* <u>purposes</u> (48:12-16)

<sup>12</sup> "Listen to Me, O Jacob, even Israel whom I called; I am He, I am the *first*, I am also the *last*.

<sup>13</sup> "Surely *My hand* founded the earth, and *My right hand* spread out the heavens; when I call to them, they *stand* together.

14 "Assemble, all of you, and listen!
Who among them has declared these things?

The LORD loves him; he will carry out <u>His</u> good pleasure on Babylon, and *His arm* will be against the Chaldeans.

<sup>15</sup> "I, even I, have spoken; indeed I have called him, I have brought him, and <u>He</u> will make his ways successful.

from the first I have <u>not</u> spoken in secret, from the time it took place, I was there.

And now the Lord GoD has sent Me, and His Spirit."

# Personal Application Reflecting on the Faithfulness of God

The Lord's lovingkindnesses indeed *never* cease, For His compassions *never* fail.

They are *new* every morning;

Great is Your <u>faithfulness</u>. (Lamentations 3:22-23)

Know therefore that the **LORD your God, He is God**, the <u>faithful God</u>, who **keeps His** *covenant* and **His** *lovingkindness* to a **thousandth generation** with those who *love* **Him** and *keep* **His commandments**; (Deuteronomy 7:9)

**Not <u>one</u>** of the **good promises** which **the LORD** had made to the house of **Israel failed**; **all <u>came to pass</u>**. (Joshua 21:45)

Your <u>faithfulness</u> continues throughout all generations; You established the earth, and it stands. (Psalm 119:90) O LORD, how many are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all; the earth is full of Your possessions.

There is **the sea**, **great** and **broad**, in which are **swarms** without **number**, **animals** both **small** and **great**...

They all <u>wait for You</u> to *give them* their food in due season. (Psalm 104:24-25, 27)

O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will give thanks to Your name; for You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect faithfulness. (Isaiah 25:1)

God is <u>faithful</u>, through whom you were *called* into <u>fellowship</u> with **His Son**, **Jesus Messiah** our <u>Lord</u>. (I Corinthians 1:9)

No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is <u>faithful</u>, who will <u>not</u> allow you

to **be tempted beyond** what you **are able**,

but **with the temptation** will **provide** the **way of escape** also, so that you will be **able** to **endure it.** (I Corinthians 10:13)

But the **Lord is** <u>faithful</u>, and **He** will **strengthen** and **protect you** from the **evil one**. (II Thessalonians 3:3)

By faith even Sarah herself *received* ability to conceive, even *beyond* the proper time of life, since she considered Him <u>faithful</u> who had promised. (Hebrews 11:11)

Therefore, those also who <u>suffer</u> according to the **will of God** shall <u>entrust</u> their souls to a <u>faithful Creator</u> in doing what is <u>right</u>. (I Peter 4:19)
