1. Their *Separation* from <u>God</u> (59:1-2)

59 Behold, the **LORD'S hand** is **not so short** that it **cannot** *save*; nor is **His ear** so **dull** that it **cannot** *hear*.

² But your *iniquities* have made a <u>separation</u> between you and your God, and your sins have <u>hidden</u> *His* face from you so that He does not hear.

2. Their *Sinfulness* **Described** (59:3-8)

³ For your hands are <u>defiled</u> with blood and your fingers with <u>iniquity</u>; your lips have spoken <u>falsehood</u>, your tongue mutters <u>wickedness</u>.

⁴<u>No one</u> sues *righteously* and <u>no one</u> pleads *honestly*.

They **trust** in **confusion** and **speak** <u>lies</u>; they **conceive** <u>mischief</u> and bring forth <u>iniquity</u>.

⁵ They hatch adders' eggs and weave the spider's web; he who eats of their eggs <u>dies</u>, and *from* that which is crushed a snake breaks forth.

⁶ Their **webs** will *not* become **clothing**, **nor** will they *cover* themselves with their works; their works are works of <u>iniquity</u>, and an **act of** <u>violence</u> is in their hands.

⁷ Their feet run to evil, and they hasten to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of <u>iniquity</u>,

devastation and *destruction* are in their highways.

⁸ They do not know the way of peace, and there is no <u>justice</u> in their tracks; they have made their paths crooked, whoever treads on them does *not* know peace.

3. Their *Suffering* from <u>Sin</u> Depicted (59:9-15)

⁹ Therefore <u>justice</u> is <u>far</u> from us, and <u>righteousness</u> does <u>not</u> overtake us; we hope for light, but behold, *darkness*, for brightness, but we walk in *gloom*.

> ¹⁰ We grope along the wall like <u>blind men</u>, we grope like those who have *no eyes*; we stumble at *midday* as in the twilight, among those who are vigorous *we are* like <u>dead men</u>.

¹¹ All of us *growl* like bears, and *moan sadly* like doves; we hope for <u>justice</u>, but there is *none*, for <u>salvation</u>, *but* it is *far from us*.

¹² For our <u>transgressions</u> are multiplied before You, and our <u>sins</u> testify against us; for our transgressions are with us, and we know our iniquities:

 ¹³ <u>transgressing</u> and <u>denying</u> the LORD, and turning <u>away</u> from our God, speaking oppression and <u>revolt</u>,
 Conceiving *in* and uttering from the heart <u>lying words</u>.

¹⁴ <u>Justice</u> is *turned back*, and <u>righteousness</u> stands *far away*; for <u>truth</u> has *stumbled* in the street, and <u>uprightness</u> *cannot enter*.

¹⁵ Yes, truth is lacking; and he who turns aside from evil makes himself a prey

Now **the LORD saw**, and it was *displeasing* in **His sight** that there was **<u>no justice</u>**.

4. Their *Salvation* from <u>God</u> Declared (59:16-21)

¹⁶ And **He (God) saw** that there was *no man*, and was **astonished** that there was *no one* to <u>intercede</u>;

then **His own** <u>arm</u> brought <u>salvation</u> to Him, and **His righteousness** *upheld Him*.

¹⁷ He put on righteousness like a *breastplate*, and a *helmet* of salvation on His head; and **He put on** *garments* of **vengeance** for clothing and **wrapped Himself** with *zeal* as a mantle.

¹⁸ According to *their* deeds, so He will *repay*, wrath to His adversaries, *recompense* to His enemies; to the coastlands He will make *recompense*.

¹⁹ So they will fear the name of the LORD from the west and His glory from the rising of the sun, for He will come like a rushing stream which the wind of the LORD drives.

²⁰ "A <u>Redeemer</u> will come to Zion, and to <u>those</u> who turn from transgression in Jacob," declares the LORD.

²¹ "As for Me, this is My <u>covenant</u> with them," says the LORD: "My <u>Spirit</u> which is upon you,

and <u>My words</u> which I have put in your mouth shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring,

nor from the **mouth** of your **offspring's offspring**," says **the LORD**, "from *now* and *forever.*"

Personal Application The *Characteristics* of a Nation <u>Separated</u> from God

"Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear.

But **your** *iniquities* have made a <u>separation</u> between **you** and **your God**, and **your sins** have <u>hidden</u> *His* face from you so that **He** does not *hear*." (59:1-2)

A. A Nation Characterized by Sinfulness from "Head to Feet"

"hands" defiled with <u>blood</u> (59:3a)	
"fingers" defiled with <u>iniquity</u> (59:3b)	
→ "lips" that speak <u>falsehood</u> (59:3c)	
	"tongues" that mutter <u>wickedness</u> (59:3d)
\rightarrow	"feet" that run to evil, and "hasten" to shed
	innocent <u>blood</u> (59:7a)
\rightarrow	"thoughts" that are thoughts of <u>iniquity</u> (59:7b)

B. A Nation *Characterized* by Judicial <u>Corruption</u>

- 1. No one goes to law for the purpose of justice (59:4a)
- 2. No one pleads in <u>truthfulness</u> (59:4b)
- 3. *Creating* "chaos" with empty words and lies (59:4c)
- 4. *Conceiving* evil that brings forth iniquity (59:4d-6)

C. A Nation Contrary to the "Paths" of Peace

- 1. With "highways" marked by <u>devastation</u> and <u>destruction</u> (59:7)
- 2. With "roads" characterized by <u>injustice</u> (59:8a)
- 3. With "paths" that they have willingly <u>made</u> "crooked" (59:8b)
- 4. <u>Trodden</u> upon by those who know not <u>peace</u> (59:8c)

D. A Nation Characterized by Spiritual Darkness and Blindness

- 1. *Hoping* for light, but beholding only <u>darkness</u> (59:9b)
- 2. *Hoping* for "brightness," but walking in thick <u>darkness</u> (59:9c)
- 3. *"Groping"* along the wall like <u>blind men</u> (59:10c)
- 4. "*Stumbling*" at "midday" as if it was <u>twilight</u> (59:10b)
- 5. *Walking* among the living like those who are <u>lifeless</u> (59:10c)

E. A Nation in Crisis without <u>Righteousness</u> and <u>Justice</u>

...justice is far from us, and righteousness does not overtake us;...

All of us *growl* like **bears**, and *moan sadly* like **doves**; we **hope** for **justice**, but there is *none*, for **salvation**, *but* it is *far from us*...

<u>Justice</u> is *turned back*, and <u>righteousness</u> stands *far away*;.. (59:9a, 11, 14a)

F. A Nation Characterized by its Abandonment of God

For our transgressions are multiplied before You, and our sins testify against us; for our transgressions are with us,...

...<u>transgressing</u> and <u>denving</u> the LORD, and turning <u>away</u> from our God, **Speaking oppression** and <u>revolt</u>, **conceiving** *in* and **uttering** from the heart <u>lying words</u>. (59:12,13)

G. A Nation in Crisis, devoid of any Pursuit of Truth

.., for truth has stumbled in the street, and uprightness cannot enter.

Yes, <u>truth</u> is *lacking*; and he who *turns aside* from evil makes himself <u>a prey</u> (59:14b-15)
