1. A *Restorative* Ministry of <u>Hope</u> and <u>Healing</u> (61:1-3)

61 The Spirit of the Lord GoD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring <u>good news</u> to the afflicted;

He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted,

To proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners;

² To **proclaim** the *favorable year* of **the LORD** and the **day of** *vengeance* of **our God**; to <u>comfort</u> all who **mourn**,

³ To grant those who mourn in Zion, giving them a garland instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning,

The mantle of praise instead of a spirit of fainting.

So they will be called oaks of <u>righteousness</u>, the *planting* of the LORD, that He may be *glorified*

2. A *Renewal* of the Nation of <u>Israel</u> (61:4-11).

⁴ Then **they** will <u>rebuild</u> the ancient ruins, they will <u>raise up</u> the former devastations; and they will <u>repair</u> the ruined cities, the *desolations* of many generations.

⁵ Strangers will stand and *pasture* your flocks, and foreigners will be your *farmers* and your *vinedressers*.

⁶ But you will be called the priests of the LORD;

you will be spoken of as *ministers* of our God.

You will eat the <u>wealth</u> of nations, and in their <u>riches</u> you will boast.

⁷ Instead of **your** *shame you will have a* <u>double</u> *portion*, and *instead* of *humiliation* they will shout for joy over their portion.

Therefore they will possess a **double** *portion* in their *land*, *everlasting joy* will be theirs.

⁸ For I, the LORD, love <u>justice</u>, I hate **robbery** in the *burnt offering*;

and **I will faithfully** give them their *recompense* and make an <u>everlasting covenant</u> with them.

⁹ Then their offspring will be *known* among the nations, and their descendants in the midst of the peoples.

All who see them will *recognize* them because they are the <u>offspring</u> whom the LORD has blessed.

¹⁰ I will *rejoice* greatly in the LORD, my soul will *exult* in my God;

For **He** has **clothed me** with **garments of** <u>salvation</u>, **He** has **wrapped me** with a **robe of** <u>righteousness</u>,

As a **bridegroom** *decks* himself with a **garland**, and as a **bride** adorns herself with her **jewels**.

¹¹ For as the **earth** brings forth its **sprouts**, and as a **garden** causes the **things** *sown* in it to **spring up**,

So the Lord GOD will cause <u>righteousness</u> and praise to spring up before all the nations.

<u>Personal Application</u> <u>Messiah's Ministry of Restoration</u> <u>Received by Believers at His First Coming,</u> <u>Received by Israel at His Second Coming</u>

1. As believers, *we* have received the "good news" brought by the "anointed" Servant of God— Jesus the Messiah (61:1a).

Now I (Paul) make known to you, brethren, the gospel (good news) which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, by which also you are <u>saved</u>,..

For I *delivered* to you as of first importance what I also **received**, that **Messiah** *died* for <u>our sins</u> according to the **Scriptures**, and that **He was** *buried*, and that **He** was raised on the **third day** according to the **Scriptures**, (I Corinthians 15:1-4)

In Him (Messiah) we have <u>redemption</u> through His blood, the <u>forgiveness</u> of our trespasses, according to the *riches* of His <u>grace</u>...(Ephesians 1:7)

2. As **believers**, our **hearts** have been **restored**, and <u>healed</u> through the **ministry** of **God's Servant**, **Jesus** the **Messiah** (61:1b).

Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing</u> every kind of disease and every kind of sickness. (Matthew 9:35)

<u>Peace</u> I leave with you; My <u>peace</u> I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you.
Do not let your <u>heart</u> be *troubled*, nor let it *be fearful*. (John 14:27)

and **He Himself <u>bore</u> our sins** in **His body** on the **cross**, so that we might **die to sin** and **live to righteousness**; for by **His wounds you** were <u>healed</u>. (I Peter 2:24)

3. As **believers**, *we* have been <u>freed</u> from the *bondage* of "<u>sin</u> and <u>death</u>" through the **ministry** of **God's** "anointed," Jesus the Messiah. (61:1c),

They (the **Jews**) answered **Him** (**Jesus**), "We are **Abraham's descendants** and have *never* yet been <u>enslaved</u> to anyone; how is it that **You say**, '**You** will become <u>free</u>'?"

Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, **I say** to **you**, everyone who **commits sin** is the <u>slave of sin</u>. (John 8:33-34)

Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Messiah Jesus.

For the *law* of the **Spirit of** <u>life</u> in **Messiah Jesus** has <u>set you free</u> from the *law* of <u>sin</u> and of <u>death</u>. (Romans 8:1-2)

4. As **believers**, *we* have been **greatly** <u>comforted</u>, and have been given a "mantle of praise"— a heart of joy, through the ministry of Jesus the Messiah (61:3).

Blessed are those who <u>mourn</u>, for they shall be <u>comforted</u>. (Matthew 5:4

Now may our Lord Jesus the Messiah Himself and God our Father, who has *loved us* and given us <u>eternal comfort</u> and good hope by grace, <u>comfort</u> and strengthen your *hearts* in every good work and word. (II Thessalonians 2:16-17) These things I (Jesus) have spoken to you so that <u>My joy</u> may be *in you*, and *that* your joy may be *made full*. (John 15:11)

and though you have **not seen Him (Messiah)**, you **love Him**, and though you do not **see Him now**, but <u>believe</u> in Him, you <u>greatly rejoice</u> with <u>joy</u> inexpressible and full of glory, (I Peter 1:8)

5. As believers, *we too* are called <u>priests</u> of God (61:6)

But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal <u>PRIESTHOOD</u>, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR *God's* OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of *darkness* into His marvelous *light*, (I Peter 2:9)

6. As **believers**, *we* also have **received** a "**portion**," an <u>eternal inheritance</u> from **God** (61:7).

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus the Messiah, who according to His great *mercy* has caused us to be *born again* to a living *hope* through the *resurrection* of Jesus the Messiah from the dead,

to *obtain* an <u>inheritance</u> which is imperishable and undefiled and will <u>not</u> fade away, *reserved* in heaven for you, (I Peter 1:3-4)

7. As believers, we have been made partakers of an everlasting <u>covenant</u> (61:8).

Now the **God of peace**, who *brought up* from the **dead** the **great Shepherd** of the **sheep** *through* the **blood** of the <u>eternal covenant</u>, *even* Jesus our Lord, equip you in every **good thing** to **do His will**, working *in us* that which is **pleasing** in **His sight**, through Jesus the Messiah, to whom *be* the *glory* forever and ever. Amen. (Hebrews 13:20)

8. As **believers**, *we* have indeed been *clothed* with "garments of <u>salvation</u>," and a "**robe of** <u>righteousness</u> (61:10)."

For I am **not ashamed** of the **gospel**, for it is the **power of God** for <u>salvation</u> to everyone who <u>believes</u>, to the **Jew first** and also to the **Greek**.

For **in it** *the* <u>**righteousness</u> of God** is **revealed** from *faith* to *faith*; as it is **written**, "BUT THE **RIGHTEOUS** *man* SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."(Romans 1:16-17)</u>
