(63:7-64:12)

1. A *Proclamation* of <u>Praise</u> and <u>Thanksgiving</u> (63:7-9)

⁷I shall make mention of the *lovingkindnesses* of the LORD, the <u>praises</u> of the LORD, according to all that the LORD has *granted* us, and the **great** *goodness* toward the **house of Israel**,

which **He** has **granted them** according to **His compassion** and according to the abundance of **His lovingkindnesses**.

For He said, "Surely, they are My people, sons who will not deal falsely." so He became their <u>Savior</u>.

⁹ In all their **affliction** <u>He</u> was **afflicted**, and the **angel of His** *presence* **saved them**;

in **His love** and in **His mercy He <u>redeemed</u> them**, and **He lifted them** and **carried them** all the **days of old**.

2. A *Powerful* Redeemer Remembered (63:10-14)

¹⁰ But they <u>rebelled</u> and <u>grieved</u> His Holy Spirit; therefore He turned Himself to become their <u>enemy</u>, He fought <u>against them</u>.

¹¹ Then **His people <u>remembered</u>** the **days of old**, of **Moses**.

Where is He who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of His flock?

Where is He who put His Holy Spirit in the midst of them,

¹² Who caused His glorious arm to go at the right hand of Moses, Who divided the waters before them to make for Himself an everlasting name, ¹³ Who led them through the depths?

Like the **horse** in the **wilderness**, they did **not stumble**;

14 as the **cattle** which **go down** into the **valley**,
the **Spirit of the LORD** gave them **rest**.

So You led Your people, to make for Yourself a glorious name.

3. A *Plea* for **God** to *again* embrace Israel (63:15-19)

15 Look down from heaven and see from Your holy and glorious habitation; where are Your zeal and Your mighty deeds?

The **stirrings** of **Your** *heart* and **Your** *compassion* are <u>restrained</u> toward me.

¹⁶ For **You** are **our Father**, though **Abraham** does **not** know us and **Israel** does **not** recognize us.

You, O LORD, are our Father, our Redeemer from of old is Your name.

¹⁷ Why, O LORD, do You *cause us* to stray from Your ways and *harden* our heart from fearing You?

Return for the sake of **Your servants**, the **tribes** of **Your** *heritage*.

¹⁸ Your holy people possessed Your sanctuary for a little while, our adversaries have trodden *it* down.

¹⁹ We have become *like* those over whom You have <u>never</u> ruled, like those who were <u>not</u> called by Your name.

 - a. *Who* became **Israel's "enemy"** when they <u>rebelled</u> and <u>grieved</u> His **Spirit** (63:10)
 - b. Who brought Israel and her shepherds up out of the sea (63:11a)
 - c. Who put His Holy Spirit in the midst of Israel (63:11b)
 - d. Who caused His glorious arm to go at the right hand of Moses (63:12a)
 - e. Who divided the waters (Red Sea) before them—making for Himself an everlasting name (63:12b)
 - f. Who led Israel through the <u>depths</u> (63:13a)
 - g. Who, like a horse on an open plain, caused Israel not to stumble (63:13b)
 - h. *Who*, like cattle in the *valley*, gave Israel rest (63:13b-14a)
 - i. Who, by leading Israel, made for Himself a glorious name (63:14b)
- 3. A *Plea* for **God** to *again* embrace Israel (63:15-19)
 - a. *Pleading* to God to "look down" from heaven (63:15a)
 - b. *Questioning* the absence of God's zeal and mighty deeds (63:15b)
 - c. *Claiming* that **God's** <u>heart</u> and <u>compassion</u> have been "restrained" towards <u>him</u> (63:15c)
 - d. *Declaring* the Lord to be their Father and Redeemer of old (63:16)

- e. *Questioning* as to *why* God has not <u>intervened</u> on their behalf (63:17a-b)
 - 1) *having* allowed them to <u>stray</u> from His ways (63:17a)
 - 2) *having* allowed their hearts to <u>harden</u>, and no longer *fear* Him (63:17b)
- f. *Appealing* to **God** to <u>return</u> for the **sake** of the **tribes of His** <u>inheritance</u> (63:17c)
- g. *Bemoaning* that **God's sanctuary** has been <u>trodden</u> down by their enemies (63:18)
- h. *Declaring* their *present* condition to be like those who had <u>never</u> been <u>ruled</u> by God, or called <u>His</u> people (63:19)

Personal Application Isaiah's Declaration of a Repentant Israel, describes the Path of a Repentant Heart

- A. A *Path* that **Proclaims** <u>Praise</u> and <u>Thanksgiving</u> to God (63:7-9)
- B. A *Path* that <u>Remembers</u> "days of old," as well as times more recent, when God powerfully <u>Redeemed</u> and <u>Saved</u> His people (63:10-14)
- C. A *Path* that <u>Pleads</u> with God to "look down," and <u>intervene</u> mightily once again on behalf of the people who are *called* by His name (63:15-19)
