### H. The *Definitive* <u>Events</u> preceding Israel's Future Kingdom (66:1-24)

a. A *Rebuke* of Israel's Religious <u>Hypocrisy</u> (66:1-4)

66 Thus says the LORD, "Heaven is My throne and the earth is My footstool.

Where then is a house you could build for Me? And where is a place that I may rest?

<sup>2</sup> "For **My hand** *made* all these things, thus all these things **came into being**," declares **the LORD**.

"But to **this one** I will look, **to him** who is **<u>humble</u>** and <u>contrite</u> of spirit, and who *trembles* at <u>My word</u>.

<sup>3</sup> "*But* he who kills an *ox* is *like* one who slays a *man;* He who sacrifices a *lamb* is *like* the one who breaks a *dog's neck*;

He who offers a *grain offering* is like one who offers *swine's blood*; He who *burns incense* is like the one who *blesses an idol*.

> As they have **chosen their** <u>own ways</u>, and their **soul** <u>delights</u> in their <u>abominations</u>,

<sup>4</sup> So I will choose their *punishments* and will bring on them what they dread.

Because I called, but <u>no one</u> answered; I spoke, but they did <u>not</u> listen.

And they did evil in My sight and chose that in which I did not delight."

#### b. A <u>Recompense</u> Determined (66:5-6)

<sup>5</sup> Hear the word of the LORD, you who tremble at His word:

"Your *brothers* who <u>hate you</u>, who *exclude you* for My name's sake, Have said, 'Let **the LORD** be **glorified**, that we may **see your joy**.' But they will be **put to <u>shame</u>**.

<sup>6</sup> "A voice of *uproar* from the city, a voice from the *temple*, the voice of *the Lord* who is **rendering** recompense to **His enemies**.

#### c. A Remarkable *Rebirth* of <u>Israel</u> Declared (66:7-9)

<sup>7</sup> "Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she gave <u>birth</u> to a boy.

<sup>8</sup> "Who has *heard* such a thing? Who has *seen* such things? Can a <u>land</u> be <u>born</u> in *one day*?

Can a <u>nation</u> be *brought forth* all *at once*? As soon as <u>Zion</u> travailed, she also *brought forth* her <u>sons</u>.

<sup>9</sup> "Shall I bring to the point of <u>birth</u> and not give <u>delivery</u>?" says the LORD. "Or shall I who gives delivery shut the womb?" says your God.

#### d. A *Revitalized* Jerusalem Described (66:10-14)

<sup>10</sup> "Be joyful with <u>Jerusalem</u> and rejoice for her, all you who love her; be exceedingly glad with her, all you who mourn over her,

<sup>11</sup> That you may *nurse* and **be satisfied** with her comforting **breasts**, that you **may suck** and be **delighted** with her **bountiful bosom**."

<sup>12</sup> For thus says the LORD, "Behold, I extend <u>peace</u> to her like a river, and the *glory* of the nations like an *overflowing* stream; and you will be *nursed*, you will be *carried* on the hip and *fondled* on the knees.

<sup>13</sup> "As <u>one</u> whom his **mother** *comforts*, so I will comfort you; and you will be *comforted* in <u>Jerusalem</u>."

<sup>14</sup> Then you will see this, and your heart will be glad, and your bones will <u>flourish</u> like the new grass; and the *hand* of **the LORD** will be made **known** to **His servants**, but **He** will be *indignant* toward **His enemies**.

e. A *Retribution* by <u>Fire</u> Pronounced (66:15-17)

<sup>15</sup> For behold, **the LORD** will **come in <u>fire</u>** and **His chariots** like the *whirlwind*, to render **His anger** with **fury**, and **His rebuke** with **flames of** <u>fire</u>.

<sup>16</sup> For the LORD will execute <u>judgment</u> by <u>fire</u> and by His sword on all flesh, and those slain by the LORD will be *many*.

<sup>17</sup> "Those who sanctify and purify themselves to go to the gardens, following <u>one</u> in the center, who eat swine's flesh, detestable things and mice, will come to an end altogether," declares the LORD.

f. A *Revival* among the <u>Nations</u> (66:18-19)

<sup>18</sup> "For I know their works and their thoughts; the time is coming to gather all nations and tongues. And they shall come and see My glory.

<sup>19</sup> I will set a <u>sign</u> among them and will send survivors from them to the nations: Tarshish, Put, Lud, Meshech, Tubal and Javan to the distant coastlands that have *neither* heard My fame nor seen My glory. And they will <u>declare</u> My glory among the nations.

g. A *Regathering* of the "Diaspora" to Jerusalem (66:20-21)

<sup>20</sup> Then they shall <u>bring</u> all your <u>brethren</u> from all the <u>nations</u> as a grain offering to the LORD, on horses, in chariots, in litters, on mules and on camels, to My holy mountain <u>Jerusalem</u>," says the LORD,

> "just as the **sons of Israel** bring their **grain offering** in a **clean vessel** to the **house** of **the LORD**.

<sup>21</sup> I will also take some of them for *priests* and for *Levites*," says the LORD.

h. A *Recognition* of the <u>Glory</u> and <u>Power</u> of God (66:22-24)

<sup>22</sup> "For just as the new heavens and the new earth which I make will endure before Me," declares the LORD,
"so your offspring and your name will endure.

<sup>23</sup> "And it shall be from new moon to new moon and from sabbath to sabbath,all mankind will come to bow down before Me," says the LORD.

<sup>24</sup> "Then they will go forth and look on the corpses of the men who have transgressed against Me.

For their **worm** will **not die** and their fire will **not be quenched**; and they will be an **abhorrence** to **all mankind**."

## Extended Study Question

Tonight we read this amazing text:

"Who has *heard* such a thing? Who has *seen* such things? Can a <u>land</u> be <u>born</u> in *one day*?

Can a <u>nation</u> be *brought forth* all *at once*? As soon as <u>Zion</u> travailed, she also *brought forth* her <u>sons</u>. (66:8)

*What* nation does this refer to, and *when* does this happen? **Two main interpretations**:

1) It refers to Israel's "rebirth" as a nation in 1948 (quote)

2) It refers to Israel's redemption and "rebirth" at the <u>2<sup>nd</sup> coming</u> of <u>Messiah</u>:

And in *that day* I will set about to <u>destroy</u> all the nations that come *against* Jerusalem.

"I will **pour out** on the **house of David** and on the **inhabitants of Jerusalem**, the <u>Spirit</u> of *grace* and of *supplication*,

so that they will **look on** <u>Me</u> whom they have <u>pierced</u>; and they will **mourn** for <u>Him</u>, as one **mourns** for an **only son**, and they will **weep bitterly** over <u>Him</u> like the *bitter weeping* over a firstborn.

In that day there will be great mourning in Jerusalem,...

"In *that day* a **fountain** will be opened for the **house of David** and for the **inhabitants of Jerusalem**, for <u>sin</u> and for <u>impurity</u>..." (Zechariah 12:9-11, 13:1)

and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written,

"THE <u>DELIVERER</u> WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL <u>REMOVE</u> UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB." "THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I <u>TAKE AWAY</u> THEIR <u>SINS</u>." (Romans 11:26-27)
