a. The Sign of Maher-shalal-hash-baz (8:1-4)

8 Then the LORD said to me, "Take for yourself a large tablet

and write on it in ordinary letters: Swift is the booty, speedy is the prey.

² And I will take to Myself faithful witnesses for testimony, Uriah the priest and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah."

³ So I approached the *prophetess*, and she **conceived** and gave birth to **a son**.

Then the LORD said to me, "Name him Maher-shalal-hash-baz;

⁴ for before the boy knows how to cry out 'My father' or 'My mother,' the *wealth* of Damascus and the *spoil* of Samaria will be carried away before the king of <u>Assyria</u>."

b. The Coming Invasion of Assyria (8:5-8)

⁵ Again **the LORD** spoke to me further, saying,

⁶ "Inasmuch as *these people* have rejected the *gently* flowing waters of *Shiloah*

And rejoice in Rezin and the son of Remaliah;

⁷ "Now therefore, behold, **the Lord** is about to bring on them the **strong** and **abundant** waters of the **Euphrates**,

Even the **king of Assyria** and all **his glory**; And it will **rise up over** all its channels and go **over** all its banks.

> ⁸ "Then it will sweep on into <u>Judah</u>, it will overflow and pass through, It will reach even to the *neck*;

And the spread of its wings will fill the breadth of your land, O Immanuel.

c. The *Warning* to the Nations (8:9-10)

⁹ "Be *broken*, **O** peoples, and be *shattered*; And *give ear*, all **remote** <u>places</u> of the earth.

Gird yourselves, yet be *shattered;* Gird yourselves, yet be *shattered.*

¹⁰ "Devise a plan, but it will be *thwarted;* State a proposal, but it will *not stand*, For <u>God is with us</u>."

d. The *Warning* to **Judah** (8:11-15)

¹¹ For thus the LORD spoke to me with mighty *power* and *instructed* me <u>not</u> to walk in the way of *this* people, saying,

¹² "You are <u>not</u> to say, '*It is* a conspiracy!'

In regard to all that *this* people call a conspiracy, And you are <u>not</u> to fear what *they* fear or be in dread of *it*.

¹³ "It is the LORD of hosts whom you should regard as holy. And He shall be your fear, And He shall be your dread.

> ¹⁴ "Then He shall become a sanctuary; But to both the houses of Israel,

a <u>stone</u> to *strike* and a <u>rock</u> to *stumble over,* And a *snare* and a *trap* for the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

> ¹⁵ "Many will stumble over them, Then they will fall and be broken; They will even be snared and caught."

e. The *Witness* of Isaiah and his Family (8:16-18)

¹⁶ Bind up the *testimony*, seal *the law* among *my* disciples.

¹⁷ And I will *wait* for the LORD who is *hiding* His face from the house of Jacob; I will even *look eagerly* for Him.

¹⁸ Behold, I and the <u>children</u> whom the LORD has given me are for <u>signs</u> and <u>wonders</u> in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells on Mount Zion.

f. The *Despair* of Judah (8:19-22)

¹⁹ When *they* say to you, "*Consult* the mediums and the spiritists who whisper and mutter," should not a people *consult* their <u>God</u>?

Should they consult the dead on behalf of the living?

²⁰ To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to <u>this word</u>, it is because they have *no dawn*.

²¹ They will pass through the land *hard-pressed* and *famished,* and it will turn out that when they are *hungry*,

they will be *enraged* and *curse* their king and their God as they face upward.

²² Then they will look to the *earth*, and behold, *distress*, and *darkness*, the gloom of *anguish*; and *they will be* driven away into *darkness*.

Immanuel: The *Stone* of <u>Stumbling</u> and the *Rock* of <u>Offense</u>

¹⁴ "Then <u>He</u> shall become a sanctuary; But to both the houses of Israel,

a <u>stone</u> to *strike* and a <u>rock</u> to *stumble over*, And a *snare* and a *trap* for the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

> ¹⁵ "Many will stumble over them, Then they will fall and be broken;
> They will even be snared and caught." (8:14-15)

{New Testament *Fulfillment*}

Jesus said to them (His disciples), "Did you never read in the Scriptures,

'THE **STONE** WHICH THE **BUILDERS** <u>REJECTED</u>, THIS BECAME THE **CHIEF** <u>CORNER</u> <u>Stone</u>; THIS CAME ABOUT FROM **THE LORD**, AND IT IS **MARVELOUS** IN OUR EYES'?...

And *he* who falls on this <u>stone</u> will be <u>broken</u> to pieces; but on *whomever* it falls, it will <u>scatter</u> him like dust." (Matthew 21:42, 44)

And **Simeon blessed them** (**Jesus' parents**) and said to **Mary His mother**, "Behold, **this** *Child* is appointed for the <u>fall</u> and <u>rise</u> of **many in Israel**, and for a <u>sign</u> to be *opposed*—(Luke 2:34)

...but Israel, pursuing a *law* of righteousness, did not arrive at *that* law. Why? Because *they did* not *pursue it* by *faith*, but as though *it were* by *works*. They **stumbled over** the <u>stumbling stone</u>, just as it is written,

"BEHOLD, I LAY IN **ZION** A <u>STONE</u> OF STUMBLING AND A <u>ROCK</u> OF OFFENSE, AND HE WHO <u>BELIEVES</u> IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED." (Romans 9:31-33)

...but we preach Messiah crucified,

to Jews a <u>stumbling block</u> and to Gentiles foolishness,

but to those who are **the** *called*, both **Jews and Greeks**, **Messiah** the *power* of God and the *wisdom* of God. (I Corinthians 1:23-24)

...you also, as *living* stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy *priesthood*, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God <u>through</u> Jesus the Messiah.

For *this* is contained in **Scripture**: "BEHOLD, I LAY IN **ZION** A **CHOICE** <u>STONE</u>, A PRECIOUS <u>CORNER</u> <u>stone</u>, AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."

> This **precious value**, then, is for **you who <u>believe</u>**; but for those who <u>disbelieve</u>,

"THE **STONE** WHICH THE **BUILDERS** *REJECTED*, THIS BECAME THE **VERY** <u>CORNER</u> *stone*," and,

"A <u>stone</u> of stumbling and a <u>rock</u> of offense";

for they <u>stumble</u> because they are <u>disobedient</u> to the word, and to this *doom* they were also *appointed*. (I Peter 2:5-8)
