1) A “Great **Light**” *Revealed* (9:1-2)

9 But there will be **no more gloom** for her who was in **anguish**;
in earlier times **He** treated the land of **Zebulun**
and the land of **Naphtali** with **contempt**,

but **later on He** shall make *it* **glorious**,
by the **way of the sea**, on the other side of **Jordan**,
Galilee of the **Gentiles**.

²The **people** who walk in **darkness**
Will see a **great light**;
Those who live in a **dark land**,
The **light** will shine on them.

2) A Joyous, Future **Victory Declared** (9:3-5)

³You shall multiply the **nation**,
You shall increase their **gladness**;

They will be **glad** in **Your presence**
As with the **gladness** of **harvest**,
As men **rejoice** when they **divide the spoil**.

⁴For **You** shall **break the yoke** of their **burden**
and the **staff** on their **shoulders**,
The **rod** of their **oppressor**, as at the battle of **Midian**.

⁵For every **boot** of the **booted warrior** in the **battle tumult**,
And **cloak** rolled in **blood**, will be for **burning**, **fuel** for the **fire**.

3) A **Divine, Eternal King Promised** (9:6-7)

⁶For a **child** will be **born to us**, a **son** will be **given to us**;
And the **government** will **rest** on **His shoulders**;

And **His name** will be called **Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Eternal Father, Prince of Peace**.

⁷There will be **no end** to the **increase** of **His government** or of **peace**,
on the **throne of David** and over **his kingdom**,

To **establish it** and to **uphold it** with **justice** and **righteousness**
from then on and **forevermore**.

The **zeal** of the **LORD of hosts** will **accomplish this**.

Isaiah 9:6-7 The *Gift* of the Messiah

→ “For a **child** will be **born to us**,”

“Behold, a **virgin** will be **with child** and **bear a son**,
and she will call **His name Immanuel** (7:14).”

.....
,..behold, an **angel of the Lord** appeared to **him** in a **dream**, saying,
“**Joseph, son of David**, do not be afraid to take **Mary** as **your wife**;
for the **Child** who has been **conceived in her** is of the **Holy Spirit**...”

Now all this took place to **fulfill** what was **spoken by the Lord**
through the **prophet**:

“BEHOLD, THE **VIRGIN** SHALL BE **WITH CHILD** AND SHALL **BEAR A SON**,
AND THEY SHALL CALL **HIS NAME IMMANUEL**,”

which translated means, “**GOD WITH US**.” (Matthew 1:20, 22-23)

→ “a **son** will be **given to us**;”

“**She (Mary)** will bear a **Son**;
and you shall call **His name Jesus**,
for **He** will **save His people** from their **sins**.” (Matthew 1:21)

“For **God** so **loved** the world,
that **He** **gave** His only begotten **Son**,
that whoever **believes** in Him shall **not perish**,
but have **eternal life**.

For **God** did not **send the Son** into the world to **judge** the world,
but that the **world** might be **saved through Him**.” (John 3:16-17)

→ “And the **government** will rest on **His shoulders**;”

And **Jesus** came up and spoke to them (**His disciples**), saying,
“**All authority** has been **given to Me** in **heaven** and on **earth**.

Go therefore and **make disciples** of all the **nations**.., (Matthew 28:18-19a)

Then the **seventh angel** sounded;
and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

“The **kingdom** of the **world** has become ***the kingdom*** of our Lord
and of **His Messiah**; and **He** will **reign forever and ever**.”
(Revelation 11:15)

→ “And **His name** will be called

→ **Wonderful Counselor**,

Then a **shoot** will spring from the **stem of Jesse**,
And a **branch** from **his roots** will **bear fruit**.
The **Spirit of the LORD** will **rest on Him**,..

The **spirit of counsel** and **strength**,.. (Isaiah 11:1-2)

Then, after three days **they** (His parents)
found **Him (the Child Jesus)** in the **temple**,
sitting in the **midst** of the **teachers**,
both **listening to them** and **asking them questions**.

And **all who heard Him** were **amazed** at **His understanding**
and **His answers**. (Luke 2:46-47)

→ **Mighty God**,

In the **beginning** was the **Word**, and the **Word** was **with God**,
and the **Word was God**...

And the **Word became flesh**,
and ***dwelt among us***, and we saw **His glory**,
glory as of the ***only begotten*** from the **Father**,
full of ***grace*** and ***truth***. (John 1:1, 14)

For in **Him (Messiah)** all the **fullness of Deity** dwells in **bodily form**,
(Colossians 2:9)

→ **Eternal Father**,

“But as for you, **Bethlehem Ephrathah**,..
From you **One** will go forth **for Me** to be **ruler** in **Israel**.
His goings forth are from **long ago**,
From the **days of eternity**.” (Micah 5:2)

“Now, **Father**, **glorify Me** together with **Yourself**, with the **glory**
which **I had with You before** the **world was**.

I have manifested **Your name** to the **men**
whom **You gave Me** out of the **world**;
they were **Yours** and **You gave them** to **Me**,
and they have **kept Your word**.” (John 17:5-6)

→ **Prince of Peace**.”

For it was the **Father’s good pleasure** for all the **fullness** to **dwell in Him**,
and **through Him** to **reconcile all things to Himself**,
having made **peace** through the **blood** of **His cross**; **through Him**,
I say, whether things on **earth** or things in **heaven**. (Colossians 1:19-20)

Therefore, having been **justified by *faith***, we have **peace with God**
through our **Lord Jesus the Messiah**, (Romans 5:1)

→ “There will be **no end** to the **increase** of **His government** or of
peace, on the **throne of David** and over **his kingdom**, to
establish it and to **uphold it** with **justice** and **righteousness**
from then on and **forevermore**.”

And behold, **you (Mary)** will **conceive** in your womb and **bear a son**,
and you shall **name Him Jesus**.

He will be **great** and will be called **the Son** of the **Most High**;
and the **Lord God** will **give Him** the **throne** of **His father David**;

and **He will reign** over the **house of Jacob forever**,
and **His kingdom** will have **no end**.” (Luke 1:31-33)
