# Jewish Proverbs for *Living* in a **Pandemic**

#### A. Live *Faithfully*

My son, do not forget my teaching,
But let your heart keep my commandments;
For length of days and years of life
And peace they will add to you...

Trust in the LORD with all your heart
And do not lean on your own understanding.
In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He will make your paths straight. (Proverbs 3:1-2, 5-6)

#### B. Live *Wisely*

1. With the <u>Wealth</u> that comes from the *Wisdom* and *Knowledge* of God

How blessed is the man who finds wisdom
And the man who gains understanding.
For her profit is better than the profit of silver
And her gain better than fine gold.
She is more precious than jewels;
And nothing you desire compares with her...

She is a **tree of life** to those who take **hold** of her, And **happy** are all who **hold** her fast. (Proverbs 3:13-15, 18)

The mind of the **prudent** acquires **knowledge**, And the ear of the **wise** seeks **knowledge**. (Proverbs 18:15)

Do not *weary yourself* to gain (worldly) **wealth**, **Cease** from your **consideration** *of it*.

When you set your eyes on it, **it is gone**.
For **wealth** certainly makes itself **wings**Like an **eagle** that flies *toward* the heavens. (Proverbs 23:4-5)

2. With the **Security** that comes from **Wisdom** 

My son,..keep sound wisdom and discretion, So they will be life to your soul And adornment to your neck. Then you will walk in your way securely
And your foot will not stumble.
When you lie down, you will not be afraid;
When you lie down, your sleep will be sweet. (Proverbs 3: 21-23)

*Hear*, my son, and accept my sayings
And the years of your life will be many.

I have **directed you** in the **way of <u>wisdom</u>**;
I have **led you** in <u>upright paths</u>.
When you **walk**, your steps will **not be impeded**;
And if you **run**, you will **not stumble**. (Proverbs 4:10-12)

#### 3. With the *Wisdom* that **Restrains** a **destructive Tongue**

When there are <u>many words</u>, transgression is unavoidable, But he who <u>restrains</u> his lips is <u>wise</u>. (Proverbs 10:19)

A **fool** does not delight in *understanding*, But **only** in **revealing** his **own mind**. (Proverbs 18:2)

He who gives an answer <u>before</u> he *hears*, It is *folly* and *shame* to him. (Proverbs 18:13)

#### 4. With words of *Wisdom* that bring <u>Healing</u> and <u>Comfort</u>

There is one who **speaks** *rashly* like the **thrusts** of a **sword**, But the tongue of the <u>wise</u> brings <u>healing</u>. (Proverbs 12:18)

Anxiety in a man's heart weighs it down, But a good word makes it *glad*. (Proverbs 12:25)

#### C. Live Graciously

Do not let kindness and truth leave you;
Bind them around your neck,
Write them on the tablet of your heart.
So you will find favor and good repute
In the sight of God and man. (Proverbs 3:3-4)

He who **despises** his neighbor *sins*,
But **happy** is he who is **gracious** to the **poor**. (Proverbs 14:21)

#### D. Live *Righteously*

The **name** of the **LORD** is a **strong tower**,
The **righteous** runs into it and is **safe**. (Proverbs 18:10)

#### E. Live *Cautiously*

## F. Live Generously

The <u>generous</u> man will be <u>prosperous</u>, And **he** who waters will himself be watered.

He who **withholds grain**, the people will *curse him*,
But <u>blessing</u> will be on the head of him who *sells it*. (Proverbs 11:25-26)

One who is <u>gracious</u> to a **poor man** *lends* to <u>the LORD</u>, And **He** will *repay him* for his **good deed**. (Proverbs 19:17)

## G. Live *Diligently*

<u>Poor</u> is he who works with a *negligent* hand, But the hand of the <u>diligent</u> makes rich. (Proverbs 10:4)
