1. The *Accelerating* Crowds (3:7-12)

⁷ Jesus withdrew to the sea with His disciples; and a great multitude from Galilee followed; and also from Judea,

- ⁸ and from *Jerusalem*, and from *Idumea*, and beyond the *Jordan*, and the vicinity of *Tyre* and *Sidon*, a <u>great number</u> of people heard of all that He was doing and came to Him.
- ⁹ And He told His disciples that a <u>boat</u> should stand ready for Him because of the crowd, so that they would not crowd Him;
- ¹⁰ for **He** had **healed many**, with the **result** that **all** those who had **afflictions** pressed around **Him** in order to **touch Him**.
 - Whenever the unclean spirits saw Him, they would fall down before Him and shout, "You are the Son of God!"
 - ¹² And **He** earnestly **warned them not** to tell **who He was**.
 - 2. The *Appointment* of the <u>Twelve</u> (3:13-21)
 - ¹³ And **He went up** on the **mountain** and **summoned** those whom **He Himself wanted**, and they **came to Him**.
 - ¹⁴ And **He** *appointed* <u>twelve</u>, so that they would be **with Him** and that **He** *could* **send them out** to *preach*,

¹⁵ and to have **authority** to **cast out** the **demons**.

¹⁶ And He *appointed* the *twelve*:

Simon (to whom He gave the name Peter),

¹⁷ and **James**, the son of **Zebedee**,

and John the brother of James

(to them He gave the name Boanerges, which means, "Sons of Thunder");

¹⁸ and **Andrew**,

and **Philip**,

and Bartholomew,

and Matthew,

and Thomas,

and James the son of Alphaeus,

and Thaddaeus,

and Simon the Zealot;

¹⁹ and **Judas Iscariot**, who **betrayed Him**.

²⁰ And He came home, and the crowd gathered again, to such an extent that they could <u>not</u> even eat a meal.

²¹ When **His own people** heard *of this*, they went out to **take custody** of **Him**; for they were saying, "**He** has **lost His senses**."

Personal Application Like the "Twelve," we too have been a Called by the Lord

;...but we (Paul) preach Messiah crucified, to the Jews a *stumbling block* and to the Gentiles *foolishness*,

but to those who are <u>the called</u>, both **Jews** and **Greeks**, **Messiah** the *power* of God and the *wisdom* of God...

For consider *your* <u>calling</u>, brethren, that there were **not** many *wise* according to the **flesh**,

not many mighty, not many noble;

but **God** has <u>chosen</u> the *foolish* things of the world to **shame** the *wise*, and **God** has <u>chosen</u> the *weak* things of the world to **shame** the things which are *strong*,..

But by **His doing** you are *in* **Messiah Jesus**, who became to **us** *wisdom* from **God**, and *righteousness* and *sanctification*, and *redemption*, so that, just as it is **written**, "LET HIM WHO **BOASTS**, **BOAST IN** <u>THE LORD</u>."

(I Corinthians 1:23-24, 26-27, 30-31)

For those whom **He foreknew**, **He** also **predestined**to become **conformed** to the **image** of **His Son**,
so that **He (Jesus)** would be the **firstborn** among **many brethren**;

and these whom **He** predestined, **He** also <u>called</u>; and these whom <u>He</u> called, **He** also justified; and these whom **He** justified, **He** also glorified. (Romans 8:29-30)

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But you are A <u>CHOSEN</u> RACE, A <u>royal PRIESTHOOD</u>, A <u>HOLY NATION</u>, A <u>PEOPLE FOR God's OWN POSSESSION</u>, so that you may <u>proclaim</u> the <u>excellencies</u> of <u>Him</u> who has <u>called you</u> <u>out of darkness</u> into <u>His marvelous light</u>;

for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you have RECEIVED MERCY.

(I Peter 21:9-10)

(11 6161 21:3 10)

Therefore do <u>not</u> be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with me in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God,

who has <u>saved us</u> and <u>called us</u> with a **holy calling**,

<u>not</u> according to **our works**, but according to **His own** <u>purpose</u> and <u>grace</u>

which was <u>granted us</u> in <u>Messiah Jesus</u> from <u>all eternity</u>,..

(II Timothy 1:8-9)

After you have **suffered** for a **little while**, the **God** of **all grace**, who **called you** to **His eternal glory** in **Messiah**, will **Himself perfect**, **confirm**, **strengthen** and **establish** you.

To **Him** be **dominion** forever and ever. Amen. (I Peter 5:10-11)

God is *faithful*, through whom you were <u>called</u> into fellowship with His Son, Jesus the Messiah our Lord.

(I Corinthians 1:9)

Grace and **peace** be multiplied to you in the **knowledge** of **God** and of **Jesus our Lord**;

seeing that **His divine** *power* has granted **to us** *everything* pertaining to *life* and *godliness*, through the **true** *knowledge* of **Him** who <u>called us</u> by **His own** *glory* and *excellence*.

(II Peter 1:2-3)

Brethren, I **do not** regard myself as having **laid hold** of *it* yet; but one thing *I do*: **forgetting** what *lies* **behind** and reaching **forward** to what *lies* **ahead**,

I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward <u>call</u> of God in Messiah Jesus. (Philippians 3:13-14)
