A. His *Stern* Warning against Evil and False Teachers (3:1-4a)

3 Finally, my brethren, **rejoice** in **the Lord**. To write the **same things** *again* is no trouble to me, and it is a **safeguard** for you.

² <u>Beware</u> of the dogs, beware of the evil workers, beware of the false circumcision; ³ for we are the *true* circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Messiah Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh.

⁴ although *I myself* might have **confidence** even in the **flesh**.

B. His *Splendid* Credentials in Judaism (3:4b-6)

If anyone else has a mind to put <u>confidence</u> in the <u>flesh</u>, *I far more*:

⁵ circumcised the eighth day, of the nation of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin,

a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the Law, a Pharisee;

⁶ as to **zeal**, a **persecutor** of the **church**; as to the **righteousness** which is in the **Law**, found **blameless**.

C. His *Superior* <u>Life</u> in Messiah (3:7-14)

- 1. *Having now*, the "surpassing value" of the <u>Knowledge</u> of the <u>Messiah</u> (3:7-8)
- 2. *Having now*, a <u>Righteousness</u> which is according to <u>Faith</u> (3:9)
- 3. *Having now*, a <u>Messiah–centered life</u> (3:10-12)
- 4. *Pressing forward* to the "prize" of his <u>Upward calling</u> (3:13-14)

⁷ But whatever things were **gain to me**, **those things** I have counted as <u>loss</u> for the **sake of Messiah**. ⁸ More than that, I count **all things** to be **loss in view** of the **surpassing value** of **knowing Messiah Jesus my Lord**.

for whom I have suffered the **loss** of **all things**, and count them but *rubbish* so that I may **gain Messiah**,

⁹ and may be found *in Him*, **not** having a **righteousness** of **my own** derived from *the* Law, but that which is through <u>faith in Messiah</u>,
the **righteousness** which *comes* from God on the basis of <u>faith</u>,

¹⁰ that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death;
¹¹ in order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

¹² Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Messiah Jesus.

but one thing *I* do: forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead,

¹⁴ I press on toward the <u>goal</u> for the <u>prize</u> of the <u>upward call</u> of God in Messiah Jesus.

D. His *Straightforward* Appeal to <u>Walk</u> after <u>His Example</u> (3:15-21)

- 1. **To live** according to the **Standard** that they have **already attained** (3:15-16)
- 2. To walk according to his (Paul's) Example (3:17)
- 3. To avoid those who now walk Contrary to Messiah (3:18-19)
- 4. To embrace the Hope of their future, glorious Transformation (3:20-21)

Let us therefore, as many as are perfect, have this attitude; and if in anything you have a different attitude,
 God will reveal that also to you; ¹⁶ however, let us keep living by that same standard to which we have attained.

¹⁷ Brethren, join in following <u>my example</u>, and observe those who <u>walk</u> according to the *pattern* you have <u>in us</u>.

¹⁸ For **many walk**, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even **weeping**, that they are **enemies** of the **cross of Messiah**,

¹⁹ whose **end** is **destruction**, whose **god** is **their appetite**, and **whose glory** is in their **shame**, who set their **minds** on **earthly things**.

²⁰ For **our citizenship** is **in heaven**, from which also we **eagerly wait** for a **Savior**, the **Lord Jesus the Messiah**;

who will <u>transform</u> the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

Personal Application

So what did **Rabbi Paul** *know* about <u>Jesus</u> that was of "Surpassing Value?"

1. The *Knowledge* of **personal** <u>Redemption</u> and <u>Forgiveness of sins</u> in <u>Messiah</u>

In **Him (Messiah)** we have <u>redemption</u> through **His blood**, the <u>forgiveness</u> of our trespasses, according to the <u>riches</u> of **His** <u>grace</u>...(Ephesians 1:7)

2. The *Knowledge* of a <u>Righteousness</u> by <u>Faith</u> in <u>Messiah</u>

But now *apart* from the Law *the* <u>righteousness</u> of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the **Prophets**,

even the <u>righteousness</u> of God through faith in Jesus the Messiah for <u>all</u> those who **believe**; for there is **no distinction**; (Romans 3:21-22)

3. The *Knowledge* of the Grace of God in Messiah

For the <u>grace</u> of God has *appeared*, bringing salvation to all men,..(Titus 2:11)

For of **His (Messiah's) fullness** we have all received, and **grace** upon **grace**.

For the *Law* was given **through Moses**; **grace** and *truth* were **realized through Jesus the Messiah**. (John 1:16-17)

4. The *Knowledge* of other <u>Salvation Blessings</u> in <u>Messiah</u>

But by **His (God's) doing** you are **in Messiah Jesus**, who became to **us wisdom** from **God**, and <u>righteousness</u> and <u>sanctification</u>, and <u>redemption</u>...

"..but *you* were <u>washed</u>, but *you* were <u>sanctified</u>, but *you* were <u>justified</u> in the name of the Lord Jesus the Messiah and in the Spirit of our God. (I Corinthians 1:30, 6:11) 5. The *Knowledge* of the <u>Deity</u> of the <u>Messiah</u>

For in Him (Messiah) all the fullness of <u>Deity</u> dwells in bodily form,.. (Colossians 2:9)

For **God**, who said, "**Light** shall **shine out** of **darkness**," is the **One** who has **shone in our hearts** to give the **Light** of the **knowledge** of the **glory of God** in the **face of Messiah**.

But **we** have this **treasure** in **earthen vessels**,... (II Corinthians 4:6-7a)

6. The *Knowledge* of God's great <u>Love</u> for him in Messiah

But **God demonstrates His <u>own love</u> toward <u>us</u>, in that while we were yet sinners**, **Messiah <u>died</u> for us**. (Romans 5:8, see also 8:38-39)

7. The *Knowledge* that **he** (**Paul**) was a <u>Son</u> of God, and a <u>Joint-heir</u> with <u>Messiah</u>

... but **you** have received a **spirit of adoption** as **sons** by which we cry out, "**Abba! Father!**"

The **Spirit Himself** testifies with **our spirit** that **we** are **children of God**, and if **children**, **heirs** also, **heirs of God** and **fellow heirs with Messiah,..** (Romans 8:15b-17a)

8. The *Knowledge* of a glorious future <u>Transformation</u> when the <u>Messiah returns</u>

For **our citizenship** is in **heaven**, from which also we eagerly **wait** for **a Savior**, the **Lord Jesus the Messiah**;

who will <u>transform</u> the <u>body</u> of our <u>humble state</u> into *conformity* with the <u>body</u> of <u>His glory</u>, by the exertion of the <u>power</u> that <u>He has</u> even to <u>subject all things</u> to <u>Himself</u>.
