Psalm 104 The <u>Greatness</u> and <u>Wisdom</u> of our God

- I. A "Poetic" Proclamation of the Greatness of God (104:1-4)
 - Bless the LORD, O my soul!
 O LORD my God, You are very great;
 You are *clothed* with splendor and majesty,
 - 2. Covering Yourself with light as with a cloak, Stretching out heaven like a tent curtain.
 - He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters; He makes the clouds His chariot; He walks upon the wings of the wind;
 - 4. He makes the **winds His** *messengers*, **Flaming fire His** *ministers*.
- II. A *Proclamation* of the <u>Power of God</u> (104:5-9)
 - 5. He **established** the **earth** upon its **foundations**, So that it will **not totter** forever and ever.
 - 6. <u>You</u> covered it with the deep as with a garment; The waters were standing above the mountains.
 - At Your *rebuke* they fled, At the sound of Your thunder they hurried away.
 - 8. The **mountains** rose; the **valleys** sank down To the **place** which <u>You</u> *established* for them.
 - 9. <u>You</u> set a *boundary* that they may *not* pass over, So that they will *not* return to cover the earth.
- III. A *Proclamation* of the <u>Provision</u> and <u>Wisdom</u> of God (104:10-28)
 - 10. He sends forth **springs** in the **valleys**; They **flow between** the **mountains**;
 - 11. They **give drink** to **every beast** of the field; The wild donkeys **quench** their **thirst**.
 - 12. Beside them the **birds** of the heavens **dwell;** They lift up their **voices** among the branches.
 - 13. He waters the mountains from His upper chambers; The earth is satisfied with the fruit of His works.

- 14. He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, vegetation for the labor of man, So that he may bring forth food from the earth,
- 15. And wine which makes man's heart glad, So that he may make his face glisten with oil, And food which sustains man's heart.
- 16. The **trees** of **the LORD drink** their **fill**, The cedars of Lebanon which **He planted**,
- 17. Where the **birds** build **their nests**, And the **stork**, whose home is the **fir trees**.
- 18. The **high mountains** are for the **wild goats**; The **cliffs** are a **refuge** for the **rock badgers**.
- 19. He made the moon for the seasons; The sun knows the place of its setting.
- 20. You appoint darkness and it becomes night, In which all the **beasts** of the forest **prowl about**.
- 21. The **young lions** roar after their **prey** And **seek their food** <u>from God</u>.
- 22. When the **sun rises** they **withdraw** And **lie down** in their **dens**.
- 23. **Man** goes forth to **his work** And to **his labor** until evening.
- 24. O LORD, how *many* are <u>Your works</u>! In <u>wisdom</u> You have made them all; The earth is full of Your possessions.
- 25. There is **the sea**, **great** and **broad**, In which are **swarms** without **number**, **Animals** both **small** and **great**.
- 26. There the **ships** move along, And **Leviathan**, which **You** have **formed** to **sport in it**.
- 27. They all **wait for You** To **give them** their **food** in **due season**.
- 28. You give to them they gather it up; You open Your Hand, they are satisfied with good.
- IV. A *Proclamation* of the <u>Sovereignty</u> of God (104:29-30)
 - 29. You hide Your face, they are dismayed; You take away their <u>spirit</u>, they expire And return to their dust.

- 30. You send forth <u>Your Spirit</u>, they <u>are created</u>; And You renew the face of the ground.
- V. A *Proclamation* of <u>Gladness</u> and <u>Praise</u> (104:31-35)
 - 31. Let the glory of the LORD endure forever; Let the LORD be glad in His works;
 - 32. He looks at the earth, and it trembles; He touches the mountains, and they smoke.
 - 33. I will sing to the LORD as long as I live;I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.
 - 34. Let **my meditation** be **pleasing to Him**; As for **me**, I shall **be glad** in **the LORD**.
 - 35. Let sinners be consumed from the earth And let the wicked be no more

Bless the LORD, O my soul Praise the LORD!

Personal Application

In and **evil** and **insane world**, we simply must take time to <u>meditate</u> and "breathe in" →

 \rightarrow The *Greatness* of **our God** (104:1a)

When I consider Your <u>heavens</u>, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained; <u>What is man</u> that You take thought of him, And the son of <u>man</u> that You care for him? (Psalm 8:3-4)

→ The *Splendor* and *Majesty* of God

You are *clothed* with splendor and majesty,..(104:1b)

→ The *Beauty* of God

One thing I have asked from the LORD, that I shall seek: That I may **dwell** in the **house** of the LORD all the days of **my life**, To behold the <u>beauty</u> of the LORD And to **meditate** in **His temple**. (Psalm 27:4)

→ The *Power* of God

At **Your** *rebuke* they the waters) *fled,* At the sound of **Your thunder** they *hurried away*. The **mountains** rose; the **valleys** sank down To the **place** which <u>You</u> established for them. (104:7-8)

→ The *Provision* of God

He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, vegetation for the labor of man, So that he may bring forth food from the earth,..(104:14)

→ The *Wisdom* of God

O LORD, how *many* are *Your works!* In <u>wisdom</u> You have made them all; The earth is full of Your possessions. (104:24)

→ The *Source* and *Sustainer* of Life (God)

They all (animals great and small) wait for You To give them their food in due season...

You <u>take</u> away *their spirit*, they <u>expire</u> and <u>return</u> to their dust. You <u>send</u> forth *Your Spirit*, they are <u>created</u>; And You *renew* the face of the ground. (104:27, 29b-30)

→ The *Goodness* of **God**

I sought the LORD, and He answered me, And *delivered* me from all my fears...

This poor man cried, and the LORD *heard* him And *saved* him out of all his troubles. The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, And *rescues* them. O taste and see that the LORD is <u>good</u>; How blessed is the man who takes *refuge* in Him! (Psalm 34:4, 6-8)

→ The *Deep Things* of God

"THINGS WHICH EYE HAS **NOT SEEN** AND EAR HAS **NOT HEARD**, AND which HAVE **NOT** ENTERED THE **HEART OF MAN**, **ALL** THAT **GOD** HAS **PREPARED** FOR <u>THOSE</u> WHO LOVE **HIM**."

For to us God <u>revealed</u> *them* through the *Spirit;* for the *Spirit* searches all things, even the <u>depths of God</u>. (I Corinthians 2:9-10)

 \rightarrow The *Love* of God (John 3:16)
