Reflecting on America's Greatness this Independence Day

- A. America's *Greatness* comes not from her <u>Independence</u>, but from her "<u>Dependence</u>."
 - 1. Her "Dependence" upon God's gracious <u>Provision</u>

Bless the LORD, O my soul! O LORD my God, You are very great;...

He (the LORD) sends forth springs in the valleys; they flow between the mountains;..

He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, and vegetation for the labor of man,

So that **he** may bring forth <u>food</u> from the **earth**, and **wine** which makes man's **heart glad**, so that he may make *his* **face** glisten with oil, and **food** which **sustains man's heart**...

The eyes of **all look to <u>You</u>**, and **You <u>give</u> them** their **food** in due time. **You <u>open</u> Your hand** and <u>satisfy</u> the desire of **every living thing**. (Psalm 104:1, 10, 14-15, 145:15-16)

2. Her "Dependence" upon God's divine Protection

Unless **the LORD builds** the **house**, they labor **in vain** who build it; unless **the LORD <u>quards</u>** the **city**, the **watchman** keeps awake *in vain*. (Psalm 127:1)

Behold, the **eye** of **the LORD** is on **those** who **fear Him,** on **those** who **hope** for **His lovingkindness**, to **deliver** their **soul** from **death** and to **keep them alive** in **famine**. (Psalm 33:18-19)

There is no **wisdom** and no **understanding** and no **counsel against the LORD**.

The **horse** is **prepared** for the **day of battle**, but **victory** belongs to **the LORD**. (Proverbs 21:30-31)

"In the beginning of the **contest** with **Britain**, when we were **sensible** of **danger**, we had *daily* <u>prayers</u> in this room for <u>Divine protection</u>.

Our <u>prayers</u>, Sir, were **heard**, and they were <u>graciously answered</u>...

do we <u>imagine</u> we <u>no longer need</u> <u>His assistance</u>?"

[Constitutional Convention, Thursday June 28, 1787]

3. Her "Dependence" upon God's guiding Precepts

"You (Israel) shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you...

He humbled you...that He might make you understand that man does not *live* by bread alone, but man *lives* by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD...

Therefore you shall **keep** the **commandments** of **the LORD your God**, to **walk** in **His ways** and to **fear Him.**

(Deuteronomy 8:2a, 3, 6)

"The only **assurance** of our **nation's** <u>safety</u> is to **lay our foundation** in <u>morality</u> and <u>religion</u>." (**Abraham Lincoln**).

At the **Constitutional Convention of 1787, James Madison** proposed the **plan** to *divide* the **central government** into <u>three branches</u>.

He discovered this *model* of government from the **Perfect Governor**, as he read **Isaiah 33:22**;

"For the LORD is our <u>judge</u>, (Judicial Branch)
the LORD is our <u>lawgiver</u>, (Legislative Branch)
the LORD is our <u>king</u>; (Executive Branch)
He will save us."

- B. America's *Greatness* rests in the <u>Righteousness</u> of her People
 - 1. A **People** *guided* by "<u>Rights</u>" believed to be granted them by a divine Creator
- "...We hold **these truths** to be **self-evident**, that **all men** are **created equal**, that they are **endowed by their Creator** with certain **unalienable <u>rights</u>**, that among these are *life*, *liberty* and **the** *pursuit of happiness*..."

 (**Declaration of Independence**, adopted by Congress, July 4 1776)
 - 2. A **People** *governed* by <u>Laws</u> and <u>Ethics</u> that are **based** on <u>Biblical</u> truths and principles

When **Moses** had finished speaking **all these** <u>words</u> to **all Israel**, **He said** to them, "Take to **your heart**all the <u>words</u> which I am *warning* you today,

which you shall **command** your **sons** to <u>observe</u> **carefully**, *even all* the **words** of <u>this law</u>.

For it is **not** an *idle word* for you; indeed it is **your life**. and by **this word** you shall **prolong your days** in the land,.." (Deuteronomy 32:45-47)

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

(II Timothy 3:16-17)

"All the miseries and evils which men suffer from vice, crime, ambition, injustice, oppression, slavery, and war, proceed from their despising or neglecting the <u>precepts</u> contained in <u>the Bible</u>...." (Noah Webster)

3. A **People** *undergirded* by a **basic** <u>Morality</u> that **reflects** the <u>righteousness</u> and <u>goodness</u> of God

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a disgrace to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

Hear the <u>word</u> of the LORD, you rulers of Sodom; give ear to the <u>instruction</u> of our God, you people of Gomorrah...

"Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; remove the evil of your deeds from My sight.

Cease to do evil, learn to do good; seek justice, reprove the ruthless, defend the orphan, plead for the widow...

"If you **consent** and **obey**, you will eat the **best** of the **land**; (Isaiah 1:10, 16-17, 19)

He (the Lord) has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6:8)

"Of all the **dispositions** and **habits** which lead to **political prosperity**, **religion** and **morality** are **indispensable supports** . . .

"And let us indulge with **caution** the supposition that **morality** can be maintained **without religion** . . . **Reason** and **experience** both **forbid us** to expect that **national morality** can **prevail** to the **exclusion** of **religious principle**." (President **George Washington**)

"The **highest glory** of the **American Revolution** was this: it connected in one **indissoluble bond** the *principles* of <u>civil government</u> with the *principles* of <u>Christianity</u>."

(John Quincy Adams 6th US President and son of John Adams)

"Without a humble *imitation* of the **characteristics** of the **Divine Author** of our **blessed** <u>religion</u>, we can **never** hope to be a <u>happy nation</u>."

C. America's *Greatness* began, and continues to be sustained through the <u>Power</u> and <u>Purposes</u> of the <u>Sovereign God</u>

1. Who "raises up" all nations according to His Sovereign Purposes

"Let the **name of God** be **blessed** forever and ever, for **wisdom** and **power** belong to **Him.**

It is **He** who **changes** the **times** and the **epochs**; **He** <u>removes</u> kings and <u>establishes</u> kings; **He** gives **wisdom** to **wise men**and **knowledge** to **men** of **understanding**. (Daniel 2:21-22)

"I have **lived**, Sir, a long time, and the **longer I live**, the more convincing proofs I see of **this truth**-that <u>God Governs</u> the affairs of men.

And if a **sparrow** cannot fall to the ground *without* His notice, is it probable that an **empire** can **rise** *without* <u>His aid</u>?"

An Exhortation to America
