## Bible Study "But I have written very boldly on some points..." (Romans 15:15)

## An *Overview* of some of **Rabbi Paul's "bold points"** written to the **Roman believers**→

→ *Declaring* "boldly" that he was <u>not ashamed</u> of the <u>gospel</u>,

"for it is the **power of God** for <u>salvation</u> to everyone who <u>believes</u>, to the **Jew first** and also to the **Greek.** 

For in it (the **gospel)** the <u>righteousness</u> of God is revealed from <u>faith</u> to <u>faith</u>;" (Romans 1:16-17)

- → Declaring "boldly" that all men (Gentiles and Jews) <u>need salvation</u> and God's <u>righteousness</u>, "for all have <u>sinned</u> and <u>fall short</u> of the glory of God," (Romans 3:23)
- → *Declaring* "boldly" that:

"...now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested

,...even *the* **righteousness of God** through <u>faith</u> in Jesus the Messiah for all those who <u>believe</u>;..." (Romans 3:21-22)

and that: "by the <u>works</u> of the Law <u>no flesh</u> will be <u>justified</u> in His sight;" (Romans 3:20)

and that: "...to the one who **does** <u>not</u> work, but <u>believes</u> in Him who *justifies* the ungodly, his faith is <u>credited</u> as <u>righteousness</u>," (Romans 4:5)

→ Declaring "boldly" that: "…having been justified by faith, we have <u>peace</u> with God through our Lord Jesus the Messiah," (Romans 5:1)

→ *Declaring* "boldly" that:

"...we have been **buried with Him** *through* <u>baptism</u> into *death*, so that as **Messiah** was <u>raised</u> from the *dead*... so *we too* might walk in <u>newness of life</u>." (Romans 6:3)

and that: "...we have been <u>released</u> from the <u>Law</u>, having *died* to that by which we were **bound**,

so that we serve in <u>newness</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> and **not** in **oldness** of the <u>letter (Law)</u> (Romans 7:6) and that: "...all who are being <u>led</u> by the <u>Spirit of God</u>, these are the <u>sons</u> of God." (Romans 8:14)

→ *Declaring* "boldly" that <u>nothing</u>:

".., will be able to **separate us** from the <u>love of God</u>, which is *in Messiah Jesus our Lord*." (Romans 8:39)

→ *Declaring* "**boldly**" of this <u>mystery</u>:

"that a <u>partial hardness</u> has happened to **Israel** until the **fullness** of the **Gentiles** has come in;.." (Romans 11:25)

And that,

"From the **standpoint** of the **<u>gospel</u>** they **(Israel)** are **enemies** for your sake, but from the standpoint of **God's choice** they are <u>**beloved**</u> for the sake of the **fathers**;" (Romans 11:28)

→ *Declaring* "boldly" that believers are:

"..., by the **mercies of God**, to **present** your **(our) bodies** a *living* and *holy* sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your (our) spiritual service of worship."

And that we

"...<u>not</u> be *conformed* to this **world**, but be <u>transformed</u> by the *renewing* of your (our) mind, so that we may prove what the will of God is, that which is <u>good</u> and <u>acceptable</u> and <u>perfect</u>." (Romans 12:1-2)

 $\rightarrow$  *Declaring* "**boldly**" that we:

"...<u>accept one another</u>, just as **Messiah** also <u>accepted us</u> to the **glory of God**." (Romans 15:7)
