# The Book of Romans

## VII. Paul *Dictates* Closing **Personal** <u>Comments</u> and <u>Greetings</u> to the **Roman Believers** (15:13-16:27)

- A. He *Expresses* Personal <u>Comments</u> concerning His Calling and Ministry (15:14-33)
- B. He *Extends* **Personal** <u>Greetings</u> to some Specific Believers there (16:1-16)

### C. He *Ends* the Roman Letter with <u>Final Exhortations</u>, <u>Greetings</u>, and <u>Praise</u> (16:17-27)

1. *Cautioning* them against those who would do <u>Evil</u> and <u>Harm</u> to <u>Believers</u> and the <u>Ministry</u> (16:17-19)

<sup>17</sup> Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause <u>dissensions</u> and <u>hindrances</u> contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them.

<sup>18</sup> For such men are slaves, <u>not</u> of our Lord Messiah but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they <u>deceive</u> the hearts of the unsuspecting.

<sup>19</sup> For the report of your <u>obedience</u> has reached to all; therefore I am rejoicing over you, but I want you to be wise in what is <u>good</u> and *innocent* in what is <u>evil</u>.

2. Confidently affirming their eventual Triumph over Satan (16:20)

<sup>20</sup> The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.

The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you

3. Conveying Greetings from those who were with Paul (16:21-24)

<sup>21</sup> **Timothy** my **fellow worker** greets you, and *so do* **Lucius** and **Jason** and **Sosipater**, my *kinsmen*. <sup>22</sup> I, Tertius, who <u>write</u> this letter, greet you in the Lord.
<sup>23</sup> Gaius, *host* to me and to the whole church, greets you.
Erastus, the *city treasurer* greets you, and Quartus, the brother.

<sup>24</sup> [The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.]

#### 4. *Closing* His Letter with a Proclamation of <u>Praise</u> (16:25-27)

<sup>25</sup> Now to Him who is able to <u>establish you</u> according to my <u>gospel</u> and the <u>preaching</u> of Jesus the Messiah, according to the *revelation* of the <u>mystery</u> which has been kept secret for long ages past,

<sup>26</sup> but <u>now</u> is manifested, and by the <u>Scriptures</u> of the prophets, according to the <u>commandment</u> of the eternal God, has been made known to all the *nations*, *leading* to obedience of *faith*;

<sup>27</sup> to the only wise God, through Jesus the Messiah, be the glory forever. Amen.

# Personal Application Paul's *Closing* <u>Exhortations</u> to the Roman Believers, are <u>Exhortations</u> to <u>Us</u> as well

- 1. **Paul** *Cautions* the **Roman believers**, and <u>us</u>, about *those* who would cause **disunity** and place "**obstacles**" to their **faith** and **ministry**. (16:17-19).
  - a. *Warning* them of those who cause <u>dissensions</u> and <u>hindrances</u> through <u>contrary teaching</u> (16:17)
  - b. *Warning* them of those who are self-serving, and who <u>deceive</u> with their "smooth and flattering <u>speech</u>" (16:18)
  - c. *Warning* them of those who would do "evil" to their commendable testimony of <u>obedience</u> (16:19)
    - 1) A *Testimony* that has **Paul rejoicing** (16:19a)
    - A *Testimony* that requires "wise" choices regarding what is good and innocent, and <u>not</u> evil (16:19b)
- 2. **Paul** *Conveys* to the **Roman believers**, and to <u>us</u>, a *strong* prediction regarding *our* inevitable <u>triumph</u> over <u>Satan</u> (16:20)

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. (16:20)

- 3. As **Rabbi Paul** *Closes* with <u>praise</u>, I believe he establishes again the main <u>theme</u> of his letter to the Roman believers, and to <u>us</u>  $\rightarrow$ 
  - → To be *established* according to the <u>gospel</u> and the <u>preaching</u> of <u>Jesus the Messiah</u> (16:25a),
  - → To be *established* in the <u>revelation</u> of "the *mystery*, which has been kept secret for long ages past (16:25b)," note→
     The *mystery* of God, is God's plan of <u>salvation</u> *through* Jesus the Messiah.
    - a. The *mystery* that is *now* "manifested" (16:26a)
    - b. The *mystery* that has been *now* made **known** to the <u>nations</u> (16:26)
      - 1) through the <u>Scriptures</u> of the prophets (16:26b)
      - 2) according to the "commandment of the eternal God (16:26c),"
      - 3) resulting in their <u>obedience</u> to the <u>faith</u> (16:26d)
    - c. The *mystery*, to which the **Brit Chadasha** (**New Testament**) expands on further in **other** <u>scriptures</u>:

Now to **Him** who is able to <u>establish you</u> according to **my** *gospel* and the *preaching* of <u>Jesus the Messiah</u>, according to the *revelation* of the <u>mystery</u> which has been **kept secret** for long ages past,.. (16:25)

As to this **salvation (in Messiah)**, the <u>prophets</u> who prophesied of the <u>grace</u> that *would come* to you made careful *searches* and *inquiries*, seeking to know what *person* or *time* the **Spirit of Messiah** within them was **indicating** as **He predicted** the <u>sufferings</u> of Messiah and the <u>glories</u> to follow.

It was **revealed** to them that they were <u>not</u> serving themselves, <u>but you</u>, in **these things** which now have been **announced** to **you** through **those** who **preached the** <u>gospel</u> to **you** by the **Holy Spirit sent** from **heaven things** into which **angels** long to look. (I Peter 1:10-12)

--if indeed you have heard of the *stewardship* of God's grace which was given to me (Paul) for you; that by *revelation* there was made known to me the <u>mystery</u>, as I wrote before in brief. By referring to this, when you read you can **understand** my insight into the <u>mystery of Messiah</u>, which in other generations was *not* made known to the sons of men, as it has <u>now</u> been *revealed* to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit;

*to be specific*, that the <u>Gentiles</u> are *fellow heirs* and *fellow members* of the **body**, and *fellow partakers* of the <u>promise</u> in <u>Messiah Jesus</u> through the <u>gospel</u>,...

To **me** (Paul), the very **least** of **all saints**, this **<u>grace</u>** was given, to **<u>preach</u>** to the **Gentiles** the unfathomable *riches* of <u>**Messiah**</u>,

and to **bring to** *light* what is the **administration** of the <u>mystery</u> which for ages has been *hidden* in God who created all things;...

*This was* in accordance with the **eternal** <u>**purpose**</u> which **He carried out** <u>**in Messiah**</u> **Jesus our Lord**,..(Ephesians 3:2-6, 8-9,11)

...I was made a minister according to the *stewardship* from God bestowed on me for your benefit, so that I might fully carry out the *preaching of* the word of God, *that is*, the <u>mystery</u> which has been *hidden* from the *past* ages and generations,

but has now been **manifested to His saints**, to whom **God willed** to **make known** what is the *riches* of the **glory** of this <u>mystery</u> among the **Gentiles**, which is <u>Messiah in you</u>, the **hope of glory**.

We proclaim <u>Him</u>, *admonishing* every man and *teaching* every man with all wisdom, so that we may *present* every man <u>complete</u> in Messiah. (Colossians 1:25-28)

d. The *mystery*, along with other *mysteries*, to which <u>we now</u> have been given <u>stewardship</u>

Let a man **regard us** in this manner, as **servants of Messiah** and <u>**stewards**</u> of the <u>**mysteries**</u> of God. (I Corinthians 4:1)

And even if our **gospel is** *veiled*, it is *veiled* to **those** who are <u>perishing</u>, in whose case the **god of this world** has **blinded the minds** of the <u>unbelieving</u> so that they might **not see** the **light of the <u>gospel</u>** of the glory of Messiah, who is the *image* of God. (II Corinthians 4:3-4)
