- a. Who has fully Vindicated Us through His Son (8:31-34)
 - 31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us?

³² He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

33 Who will bring a charge <u>against</u> God's elect? God is the one who justifies;

³⁴ who is the one who condemns?

Messiah Jesus is **He** who <u>died</u>, yes, rather **who** was <u>raised</u>, **who** is at the *right hand* of God, who also <u>intercedes</u> for us.

b. *Who* has <u>Unconditional Love</u> for Us through <u>His Son</u> (8:35-39)

Who will separate us from the <u>love</u> of Messiah? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

³⁶ Just as it is written,

"FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO <u>DEATH</u> ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."

³⁷ But in **all these things** we overwhelmingly **conquer through Him** who **loved us**.

³⁸ For I am **convinced** that neither **death**, nor **life**, nor **angels**, nor **principalities**, nor things **present**, nor things **to come**, nor **powers**,

³⁹ nor *height*, nor *depth*, nor any other *created thing*, will be able to separate us from the <u>love</u> of God, which is <u>in</u> Messiah Jesus our Lord.

Message Summary Our Blessed Standing as Sons of God

A. We are Ultimately Glorified

²⁹ For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become <u>conformed</u> to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many <u>brethren</u>;

³⁰ and these whom He predestined, He also <u>called</u>; and these whom He called, He also <u>justified</u>; and these whom He justified, He also **glorified**.

B. We are Utterly Vindicated

³² He who did *not* <u>spare</u> His own Son, but <u>delivered Him</u> over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

33 Who will bring a charge <u>against</u> God's elect? God is the one who <u>justifies</u>;

³⁴ who is the one who condemns?

Messiah Jesus is **He** who *died,* yes, rather who was *raised,* who is at the **right hand** of **God**, who also <u>intercedes</u> for us.

C. We are *Unconditionally* Loved

35 Who will separate us from the love of Messiah...?

nor *life*, nor *angels*, nor *principalities*, nor things *present*, nor things *to come*, nor *powers*,

³⁹ nor *height*, nor *depth*, nor any other *created thing*, will be able to **separate us** from the <u>love of God</u>, which is **in Messiah Jesus our Lord**.

Personal Application Resting in God's Unconditional Love

For you (Israel) are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for His own possession out of *all* the peoples who are on the face of the earth.

"The Lord did not set His <u>love</u> on you nor choose you because you were **more** in number than any of the peoples, for you were the **fewest** of all **peoples**,

but because the LORD <u>loved you</u> and kept the <u>oath</u> which He swore to your forefathers,...

Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the *faithful God,* who *keeps* His covenant and His <u>lovingkindness</u> to a thousandth generation with those who *love Him* and *keep His commandments*; (Deuteronomy 7:6-9)

→ But <u>you</u> are A *CHOSEN RACE*, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR *God's OWN POSSESSION*, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of *darkness* into His marvelous *light*;

for you once were **NOT** A PEOPLE, but <u>now</u> you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had **NOT** RECEIVED MERCY, but <u>now</u> you have RECEIVED MERCY. <u>Beloved</u>,... (I Peter 2:9-11a)

How precious is Your <u>lovingkindness</u>, O God! And the **children of men** take *refuge* in the shadow of Your wings. (Psalm 36:7)

"For the **mountains** may be **removed** and the **hills** may **shake**,
But **My** <u>lovingkindness</u> will <u>not</u> be removed from **you**,
And **My covenant** of **peace** will **not** be **shaken**,"
Says the **Lord** who has <u>compassion</u> on **you**."
(Isaiah 54:10)

"My soul has been rejected from peace;
I have forgotten happiness.

So I say, "My strength has perished, And so has my hope from the LORD...

> This I recall to my mind, Therefore I have hope.

The Lord's <u>lovingkindnesses</u> indeed *never* cease,

For His compassions never fail.

They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness." (Lamentations 3:17-18, 21-23)

But **God**, being **rich in mercy**, because of **His great love** with which **He loved us**,

even when we were **dead** in **our transgressions**, made **us** *alive* **together with Messiah** (by *grace* <u>you</u> have been **saved**),

and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Messiah Jesus, (Ephesians 2:4-6)
