## Seven "New" Blessings, to remain *Happy* and *Hopeful* about in the New Year

1. That we are a part of a "New creation" in Messiah

Therefore if anyone is **in Messiah**, *he is* a <u>new creature</u>; the <u>old</u> things passed away; behold, <u>new</u> things have come. (II Corinthians 5:17)

2. That we have received the Blessings of a "New Covenant"

...but our adequacy is from God, who made us adequate as servants of a New Covenant...(II Corinthians 3:6a)

But now **He (Messiah)** has obtained a *more* excellent ministry, by as much as **He** is also the mediator of a *better* <u>covenant</u>, which has been enacted on *better* <u>promises</u>.

(Hebrews 8:6)

3. That we now have a "New" Relationship to God

For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified...

Therefore, **brethren**, since we have **confidence**to enter the **holy place** by the **blood of Jesus**,
by a **new and living way**which He inaugurated for us through **the veil**, that is, **His flesh**,

and since we have a **great priest** over the house of God, let us draw near with a sincere heart in **full assurance of faith**,... (Hebrews 10:14, 19-22a)

But now **we** have been *released* from the **Law**, having *died* to that by which we were **bound**, so that **we serve** in <u>newness</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> and **not** in *oldness* of the <u>letter</u>. (Romans 7:6)

4. That in Messiah we are one "New Man"

For He Himself is our peace,
who made both groups (Jews and Gentiles) into one
and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall,
by abolishing in His flesh the enmity,
which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances,
so that in Himself He might make the two into
one new man, thus establishing peace, and might reconcile
them both in one body to God through the cross,...(Ephesians 2:14-16)

### 5. That the Lord's Lovingkindnesses and Compassions are "New" every morning

This I recall to my mind, therefore I have hope.

The LORD"S lovingkindnesses indeed *never cease*, for His compassions *never fail*.

They are <u>new every morning</u>; *great* is Your faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:21-23)

6. That we have the **Hope** of a **New** heaven and a **New** earth

"For, behold, I *create* <u>new</u> heavens and a <u>new</u> earth; and the **former things** shall **not** be **remembered** or come to mind." (Isaiah 65:17)

But according to **His promise** we are looking for <a href="mailto:new">new</a> heavens and a <a href="mailto:new">new</a> earth. in which <a href="mailto:righteousness">righteousness</a> dwells. (II Peter 3:13)

Then I (John) saw a <u>new</u> heaven and a <u>new</u> earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea.

And I saw the holy city, <u>new Jerusalem</u>, coming down out of heaven from **God**, made ready as a *bride* adorned for her **husband**...

And **He** who sits on the **throne** said, "Behold, **I am** making **all things** <u>new</u>." (Revelation 21:1-2, 5a)

7. That God has blessed us, and given us reasons to sing a "New" Song

**Sing** to Him a **new song**; play **skillfully** with a **shout of joy**. (Psalm 33:3)

**He** put a **new song** in my mouth, a **song** of **praise** to **our God**; (Psalm 40:3a)

**Sing** to the **LORD** a **new song**; **sing** to the **LORD**, all the earth. (Psalm 96:1)

O sing to the LORD a <u>new song</u>, for **He** has done **wonderful things**, (Psalm 98:1)

And they sang a <u>new song</u>, saying, "Worthy are You (the Lamb) to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and *purchased* for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation..."

(Revelation 5:9)

# Personal Application Adat Shalom A New Beginning...A Renewed Vision

## A. Having a *Renewed* <u>Vision</u> concerning our own <u>Spiritual</u> <u>Walk</u>

- 1. By *Committing* ourselves to the <u>study</u> of <u>God's word</u> (II Timothy 3:16-17)
- 2. By *Congregating* with **others** for **worship** and **fellowship** (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- 3. By *Cultivating* a **life** of **prayer** and **meditation** (Ephesians 6:18) (Romans 12:12)
- 4. By *Continuing* the **priority** of "**making** <u>disciples</u> among all **nations**" (**evangelism**) (Matthew 28:18-20)

#### B. Having a *Renewed* Vision for our Congregation

- 1. Re-establishing ourselves in our new place of ministry
  - a. By <u>communicating</u> our *new* location to our **Adat family** and **friends** both near and far
  - b. By <u>circulating</u> the **news** of our *new* location through various <u>media</u> <u>resources</u> (internet, mail-outs, radio spots, Messianic news etc.)
  - c. By <u>connecting</u> personally to the surrounding neighborhood (signs, prayer walks, neighborhood events, flyers)
- 2. **Recommitting** ourselves to our **ministry priorities** 
  - a. Our *general* ministry priorities → <u>evangelism</u> and <u>discipleship</u>
  - b. Our *specific* ministry <u>functions</u>→

Worship Ministry
Teaching/Preaching Ministry
Evangelism and Missions

Children's Ministry
Youth Ministry

Adult Ministries (men's and women's studies)

Oneg Shabbat Ministry Benevolence Ministry

Jewish Resource Ministry (teaching materials, books, speaking engagements etc.)
Live-stream service Ministry
Hospitality and Services Ministry

- 3. Reinforcing our "long range" ministry goals
  - a. The *goal* of maturing as a body of believers in <u>faith</u>, <u>hope</u>, and <u>love</u>
  - b. The *goal* of <u>growing</u> to the point where we need **our own** <u>building</u> facility
  - c. The *goal* of <u>leadership development</u> among us
  - d. The *goal* of eventually "passing the torch" to a younger congregational <u>leader</u> who will carry on the work of the ministry.
  - e. The *goal* of being a <u>model</u> ministry for *future* ministry to the **Jewish** community
- 4. *Renewing* our **commitment** to **remain** "...**steadfast**, **immoveable**, always *abounding* in the **work** of **the Lord**,.." (I Corinthians 15:58)

Now to **Him** who is able to do *far more abundantly beyond* all that we ask or think, according to the <u>power</u> that works within *us*, to **Him** *be* the **glory** in the **church** and in **Jesus the Messiah** to all generations forever and ever. Amen. (Ephesians 3:20-21)
