# Cultivating a Thankful Heart in a Thankless World

### I. The *Crisis* of <u>Unthankfulness</u>

### A. A Sign of Peril for Israel

"When you have eaten and **are satisfied**, you shall <u>bless</u> the LORD your God for the good land He has given to you.

Beware that you do not forget the LORD your God by not keeping His commandments and His ordinances...

otherwise, when you have **eaten** and are **satisfied**, and have built **good houses**...and when your **flocks** and **herds multiply**, and your **silver** and **gold multiply**, and **all** that you have **multiplies**, then **your heart** will become **proud** and you will **forget** the **LORD your God** who **brought you up** out of the land of **Egypt**, out of the house of **slavery**."

All that **generation** (of **Israel**) also were **gathered** to their fathers; and there arose **another generation** after them who did <u>not</u> **know the LORD**, nor yet **the work He** had **done for Israel**.

> Then the sons of **Israel did evil** in the **sight** of the **LORD**... and they <u>forsook</u> the **God of their fathers**,... (Deuteronomy 8:10-14; Judges 2:10-12a)

#### B. A Sign of a Decadent Society

For the <u>wrath</u> of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who <u>suppress the truth</u> in unrighteousness,...

For even though they **knew God**, they did <u>not</u> *honor Him* or <u>give thanks</u>, but they became **futile** in their **speculations**, and their foolish heart **was** *darkened*...

And just as they did **not** see fit to <u>acknowledge God</u> any longer, *God gave them over* to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, strife, deceit, malice...slanderers, <u>haters of God</u>,... (Romans 1:18, 21, 28-30a)

C. A Sign of Corruption in the "Last Days"

This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetousness, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, <u>unthankful</u>, unholy,... (II Timothy 3:1-2)

### II. The *Cultivation* of a **Thankful Heart**

A. Being *Thankful* to God our <u>Creator</u> for His <u>Greatness</u>, His <u>Sovereignty</u>, and His <u>Power</u>

So (King) David *blessed* the LORD in the sight of all the assembly; and David said, "*Blessed* are You, O LORD God of Israel our father, forever and ever.

Yours, O LORD, is the <u>greatness</u> and the <u>power</u> and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens and the earth; Yours is the *dominion*, O LORD, and You exalt Yourself as <u>head over all</u>.

Both **riches** and **honor** *come* from **You**, and **You** <u>rule</u> **over all**, and in **Your hand** is <u>power</u> and might; and it lies in **Your hand** to **make great** and to **strengthen** everyone. Now therefore, **our God**, we <u>thank you</u> and praise Your glorious name. (I Chronicles 29:10-13)

> O come, let us **sing** for **joy** to the **LORD**, Let us shout **joyfully** to the **rock** of our *salvation*. Let us come before **His presence** with <u>thanksgiving</u>, Let us shout **joyfully** to **Him** with **psalms**.

For the LORD is a **great God** and a **great King** above **all gods**, In whose hand are the **depths** of the **earth**, The **peaks** of the **mountains** are **His** also. The **sea** is **His**, for it was **He** who **made it**, And **His hands** <u>formed</u> the **dry land**.

Come, let us **worship** and **bow down**, Let us **kneel** before the **LORD our** <u>Maker</u>. For **He** is **our God**, and **we** are the **people** of *His pasture* and the **sheep** of *His hand*. (Psalm 95:1-7a)

#### B. Being *Thankful* to God—remembering His mighty <u>Deeds</u> and <u>Wonders</u>

O give <u>thanks</u> to the LORD, call upon His name; make known His <u>deeds</u> among the peoples. Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; speak of all His <u>wonders</u>... *Remember* His <u>wonders</u> which He has done, His *marvels* and the *judgments* uttered by His mouth,... (Psalm 105:1-2, 5) **Praise the LORD**! Oh give **thanks** to the **LORD**, for **He is good**; For His **lovingkindness** is everlasting.

Who can speak of the <u>mighty deeds</u> of the LORD, Or can show forth all **His praise**? (Psalm 106:1-2)

# C. Being *Thankful* for **His** <u>Salvation</u>, and the times God has <u>delivered/saved</u> us from difficulty and trials

Willingly I will sacrifice to You I will <u>give thanks</u> to Your name, O LORD, for it is good. For He has <u>delivered me</u> from *all* trouble, and my eye has looked *with satisfaction* upon my enemies. (Psalm 54:6-7)

But I am *afflicted* and in *pain*; may Your <u>salvation</u> O God set me *securely* on high. I will praise the name of God with song and *magnify* Him with <u>thanksgiving.</u> (Psalm 69:29-30)

For this reason also,..we have not ceased to pray for you...

<u>giving thanks</u> to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

For He <u>rescued us</u> from the domain of darkness, and *transferred us* to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have <u>redemption</u>, the forgiveness of sins. (Colossians 1:12-14)

# D. Being *Thankful* for God's <u>Goodness</u>, <u>Lovingkindness</u>, and <u>Faithfulness</u>

Enter into **His gates** with **<u>thanksgiving</u>** and **His courts** with **praise**.

<u>Give thanks</u> to Him, bless His name, For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting and His <u>faithfulness</u> to all generations. (Psalm 100:4-5)

It is good to <u>give thanks</u> to the LORD And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High; To declare Your <u>lovingkindness</u> in the *morning* And Your <u>faithfulness</u> by *night*, (Psalm 92:1-2)

Praise the LORD! Oh <u>give thanks</u> to the LORD, for He is <u>good</u>; for His <u>lovingkindness</u> is everlasting. (Psalm 106:1)

#### O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will <u>give thanks</u> to Your name; For You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect <u>faithfulness</u>. (Isaiah 25:1)

# E. Being *Thankful* to God for the many <u>Blessings</u> we have <u>in Messiah</u>

But we should always <u>give thanks</u> to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has *chosen you* from the beginning for <u>salvation</u> through <u>sanctification</u> by the <u>Spirit</u> and faith in the truth.

It was for this **He called you** through **our gospel**, that **you** may **gain the** <u>glory</u> of our **Lord Jesus the Messiah**. (II Thessalonians 2:13-14)

<u>Blessed</u> be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah, who has <u>blessed us</u> with <u>every spiritual blessing</u> in the heavenly *places in* Messiah, (Ephesians 1:3)

#### F. Being *Thankful* to God for the <u>People of God</u>, whom He has sent to <u>Serve</u> and <u>Encourage</u> the Body of Believers

I <u>thank</u> my God in all my remembrance of you, always offering prayer with joy in my every prayer for you all, in view of your <u>participation</u> in the <u>gospel</u> from the first day until now. (Philippians 1:3-5)

(Fillippians 1.3-5)

We <u>give thanks</u> to God always for <u>all of you</u>, making mention *of you* in our **prayers;** constantly bearing in mind your *work* of <u>faith</u> and *labor* of <u>love</u> and *steadfastness* of <u>hope</u> in our Lord Jesus the Messiah in the presence of our God and Father,...

You also became *imitators* of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit, so that you became an <u>example</u> to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. (I Thessalonians 1:2-3, 6-7)

I <u>thank</u> my God always, making mention of you (Philemon) in my prayers, because I hear of your <u>love</u> and of the <u>faith</u> which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward <u>all the saints</u>;..

For I have come to have much **joy** and **comfort** in **your love**, because **the** *hearts* of the <u>saints</u> have been <u>refreshed</u> *through you*, brother. (Philemon 4-5, 7)
