# The **Destructiveness** of **Anger America** is **Angry**, it's a <u>Sign</u> of the **Times**

But realize this, that in the <u>last days</u> difficult times will come. For *men* will be lovers of self, lovers of money, **boastful**, **arrogant**, **revilers**, **disobedient** to parents, **ungrateful**, **unholy unloving**, **irreconcilable**, malicious gossips, **without self-control**, **brutal**, **haters of good**, **treacherous**, **reckless**, conceited, lovers of **pleasure** rather than **lovers of God**, (II Timothy 3:1-4)

### A. The *Recognition* of a "Righteous" <u>Anger</u>

- 1. God's Anger over sin and unrighteousness (Psalm 7:11) (Romans 1:18)
- 2. Jesus' righteous Anger (Mark 3:5) (John 2:13-16)
- 3. God's people and righteous Anger (Exodus 32:19) (Ephesians 4:26)

#### B. The *Ravages* of <u>Anger</u>

<u>Cease</u> from <u>anger</u> and <u>forsake wrath</u>; Do not fret; *it leads* only to <u>evildoing</u>. For evildoers will be cut off, But those who wait for the LORD, they will inherit the land. (Psalm 37:8-9)

Do **not** be *eager* in your heart to be <u>angry</u>, For <u>anger</u> resides in the bosom of **fools**. (Ecclesiastes 7:9)

An **angry man** stirs up **strife**, And a **hot-tempered man abounds** in **transgression**. (Proverbs 29:22)

*Like* a city that is **broken into** *and* **without walls** Is a **man** who has **no control** over **his spirit**. (Proverbs 25:28)

A man of <u>violence</u> *entices* his neighbor And **leads him** in a way that is <u>not good</u>. (Proverbs 16:29)

Scorners set a city aflame, But wise men turn away anger. (Proverbs 29:8)

#### C. The *Root* of **Unrighteous Anger** $\rightarrow$ <u>Sin</u>

...but for **Cain** and for his offering **He (God)** had no regard. So **Cain** became very <u>angry</u> and his countenance fell.

Then **the LORD** said to Cain, "Why are you <u>angry</u>? And why has your **countenance fallen?** If you <u>do well</u>, will not *your countenance* be **lifted up?** 

And if you do *not* do well, <u>sin</u> is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it."

Cain told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up **against** Abel his brother and **killed him**. (Genesis 4:5-8)

What is the **source** of **quarrels** and **conflicts** among **you?** Is not the **source** your **pleasures** that **wage war** in **your members**?

You lust and do not have; so you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; so you <u>fight</u> and <u>quarrel</u>. You do not have because you do not ask. (James 4:1-2)

#### D. The *Restraint* of Anger - <u>How</u>?

This you know, my beloved brethren. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to <u>anger</u>; for the <u>anger</u> of man does <u>not</u> achieve the righteousness of God. (James 1:19-20)

A <u>gentle answer</u> turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up <u>anger.</u> (Proverbs 15:5)

Do **not** associate with a man given to anger; Or go with a <u>hot-tempered man</u>, Or you will learn his ways And find a snare for yourself. (Proverbs 22:24-25)

BE ANGRY, AND yet DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your <u>anger</u>, and do **not** give the **devil** an opportunity.

He who **steals** must **steal no longer**; but rather he must **labor**, performing with his own hands what is **good**, so that he will have *something* to **share** with one who **has need**.

Let no **unwholesome word** proceed from your **mouth**, but only such *a word* as is **good** for edification to the **need** of the moment, so that it will give **grace** to those who **hear...**  Let all *bitterness* and *wrath* and <u>anger</u> and *clamor* and *slander* be **put away** from you, along with **all** *malice*.

Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Messiah also has forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:26-29, 31-32)

But refuse **foolish** and **ignorant speculations**, knowing that they produce **<u>quarrels</u>**.

Lord's bond-servant must not be <u>quarrelsome</u>, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, (II Timothy 2:23-24)

### Diffusing an *Angry* Nation It begins with the Power of <u>Prayer</u>

"...for the <u>weapons</u> of our warfare are *not* of the flesh, but <u>divinely</u> powerful for the destruction of fortresses." (II Corinthians 10:4)

→*Pray* that God would "pour forth" <u>His Spirit</u>, and bring about a true <u>spiritual</u> <u>revival</u> in America, and throughout the world

'For I will pour out water on the thirsty land And streams on the dry ground; I will *pour out* <u>My Spirit</u> on your offspring And My blessing on your descendants; (Isaiah 44:3)

→*Pray* that many in America, and throughout the world would experience true <u>Peace</u>, not just the temporary absence of hostility, but a real lasting inner <u>Peace</u> that comes from a <u>reconciled</u> relationship with the living God—a <u>Peace</u> that is offered through the message and hope of the gospel of Messiah.

Therefore, having been *justified* by faith, we have <u>peace</u> with God *through* our Lord Jesus the Messiah,..(Romans 5:1)

- →Pray that many in America would be made "alive to God," and return to the *truths* and *principles* of God's word—Pray that our legislators and judges consider the *laws of God* when they establish laws, and make judicial decisions for the governance of our society. (Psalm 19:7-10)
- →Pray that righteousness would <u>prevail</u> over wickedness—that we would <u>overcome</u> evil with good (Romans 12:21).

 $\rightarrow$ *Pray* that the **church** (the **body of believers**) will be <u>faithful</u>, <u>uncompromising</u>,

and <u>courageous</u> in our <u>witness</u> to the world of the **truth** of the <u>gospel</u>, and the need for **all men** to receive <u>salvation</u> and <u>eternal life</u>.

Do all things without *grumbling* or *disputing*; so that you will prove yourselves to be **blameless** and **innocent**, **children of God above reproach** in the midst of a **crooked** and **perverse generation**, among whom you appear as <u>lights</u> in the **world**, holding fast the <u>word of life</u>, so that in the **day of Messiah** I will have reason to **glory** because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain. (Philippians 2:14-16)
