At Adat Shalom, We Celebrate the Coming of the Messiah

A. Whose wondrous Birth was predicted in the Scriptures

Therefore the **Lord Himself** will give you (**King Ahaz**) a **sign**: Behold, a **virgin** will be **with child** and **bear a son**, and she will call His name **Immanuel**. (Isaiah 7:14)

→ Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit...

But when **he** (**Joseph**) had considered this, behold, an **angel** of **the LORD** appeared to him in a **dream**, saying...

She (Mary) will bear a <u>Son</u>; and you shall call <u>His name Jesus</u>, for <u>He will <u>save</u> <u>His people</u> from their <u>sins</u>." Now all this took place to <u>fulfill</u> what was spoken by <u>the Lord</u> through the <u>prophet</u>:</u>

"BEHOLD, THE **VIRGIN** SHALL BE **WITH** <u>CHILD</u> AND SHALL BEAR **A** <u>SON</u>,
AND **THEY** SHALL CALL **HIS NAME** <u>IMMANUEL</u>,"
which translated means, "**GOD WITH US**." (Matthew 1:18, 21-23)

B. Who was Born, as predicted, as Israel's Eternal King and Messiah

For a <u>child</u> will be **born to us**, a <u>son</u> will be <u>given to us</u>;
And the <u>government</u> will rest on <u>His shoulders</u>;
And <u>His name</u> will be called <u>Wonderful Counselor</u>, <u>Mighty God</u>,
<u>Eternal Father</u>, <u>Prince of Peace</u>.

There will be **no end** to the increase of *His* **government** or of **peace**,

On the **throne of David** and over **his kingdom**,

To establish it and to uphold it with **justice** and **righteousness**From then on and **forevermore**.

The **zeal** of the **Lord of hosts** will accomplish this. (Isaiah 9:6-7)

→ And behold, **you (Mary**) will **conceive** in **your womb** and bear a **son**, and you shall **name Him Jesus**.

He will be great and will be called the <u>Son</u> of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father <u>David</u>; and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever.

and **His kingdom** will have **no end**." (Luke 1: 30b-33)

Now after **Jesus** was **born in Bethlehem** of **Judea** in the days of **Herod** the king, **magi** from the **east** arrived in **Jerusalem**, saying,

"Where is <u>He</u> who has been born <u>King</u> of the <u>Jews</u>?
For we saw **His star** in the east and have come to worship **Him**."(Matthew 2:1-2)

The (Samaritan) woman *said to Him (Jesus), "I know that Messiah is coming (He who is called "anointed"); when that One comes, He will declare all things to us."

Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He." (John 4:25-26)

C. Who was **Born** at the **appointed time** to bring **Redemption** and **Salvation** to the **World**

But when the **fullness** of the **time** came, **God sent forth His Son**, **born** of a **woman**, **born under the Law**,
so that **He** might **redeem** those who were **under the Law**, (Galatians 4:4-5a)

But when **he** (**Joseph**) had considered this, behold, an **angel** of **the Lord** appeared to him in a **dream**, saying, "**Joseph, son of David**, do **not** be afraid to take **Mary** as your **wife**; for the **Child** who has been conceived in her is of the **Holy Spirit**.

She will bear **a Son**; and you shall call **His name Jesus**, for **He will save His people** from their **sins**."(Matthew 1:20-21)

And his (**John**) father **Zacharias** was filled with the **Holy Spirit**, and **prophesied**, saying:

"Blessed be the Lord God of Israel,
For He has visited us and accomplished redemption for His people,

And has raised up a *horn* of <u>salvation</u> for us In the **house of** <u>David</u> His servant—

As **He spoke** by the *mouth* of **His holy prophets** from of old— <u>Salvation</u> FROM **OUR ENEMIES**,

And FROM THE **HAND** OF ALL WHO **HATE US**; (Luke 1:67-71)

And there was a man in **Jerusalem** whose name was **Simeon**; and this man was **righteous** and **devout**, looking for the **consolation of Israel**; and the **Holy Spirit** was upon him.

And it had been **revealed** to him by the **Holy Spirit** that he would **not see death** before he had seen the **Lord's Messiah**.

And he came in the **Spirit** into the **temple**; and when the parents brought in the **child Jesus**, to carry out for **Him** the **custom** of the **Law**.

then **he took Him (Jesus)** into **his arms**, and **blessed God**, and said "Now **Lord, You** are *releasing* **Your bond-servant** to **depart in peace**, according to **Your word**;

For my eyes have seen **Your** <u>salvation</u>, Which You have **prepared** in the presence of **all peoples**,

A **LIGHT** OF **REVELATION** TO THE **GENTILES**, And the **glory** of **Your people Israel**." (Luke 2:25-32)

D. Whose Birth gave occasion for Joy and Praise to God

In the same region there were *some* **shepherds** staying out in the fields and keeping watch over their flock by night.

And an **angel of the Lord** suddenly **stood** before them, and the **glory** of **the Lord shone** around them; and they were **terribly** *frightened*.

But the **angel** said to them, "Do **not** be **afraid**; for behold, I bring you **good news** of **great joy** which will be for **all the people**;

for today in the **city of David** there has been **born** for you **a Savior**, who is **Messiah the Lord**. (Luke 2:8-11)

Now after **Jesus** was **born** in **Bethlehem** of **Judea** in the days of **Herod** the king, **magi** from the **east** arrived in **Jerusalem**, saying,

"Where is **He** who has been **born King** of the **Jews?**For we saw *His star* in the **east** and have come to *worship Him*..."

After hearing the **king** (Herod), they went their way; and the **star**, which they had seen in the **east**, went on **before them** until it came and **stood over** the place where the **Child** (**Jesus**) was.

When they saw **the star**, they <u>rejoiced exceedingly</u> with <u>great joy</u>. (Matthew 2:1-2, 9-10)
