In the Last Days there will be *Perilous* Times. What can we <u>Expect</u>?

1. We can expect an increasingly Decadent Society

But know this, that in the *last days* <u>perilous times</u> will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, <u>brutal</u>, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! (II Timothy 3:1-5)

As **He (Jesus)** was sitting on the **Mount of Olives**, the **disciples** came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will **these things** happen, and what *will be* the **sign of Your coming**, and of the **end of the age**?..."

...Because <u>lawlessness</u> is *increased*, most **people's** *love* will *grow cold*. (Matthew 24:3, 12)

2. We can expect an increasing Hostility to the things of God

If you were of the world, the world would *love* its own; but because you are **not** of the **world**, but **I chose you** out of the **world**, because of this the **world** <u>hates you</u>...(John 15:9)

This is the *judgment,* that Light has come into the world, and men <u>love</u> the <u>darkness</u> rather than the <u>Light</u>, for their deeds were evil. For everyone who does evil *hates* the Light,..(John 3:19-20a)

And just as **they (***the unrighteous***)** did **not** see fit to *acknowledge* **God** any longer, **God gave them over** to a *depraved mind*,...

being filled with **all unrighteousness**, **wickedness**,.. *they are* **gossips**, **slanderers**, <u>haters of God</u>, insolent, arrogant, boastful,.. (Romans 1:28-30)

3. We can expect the Persecution of Believers

"Blessed are those who have been <u>persecuted</u> for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. "Blessed are you when *people* insult you and <u>persecute you</u>, and *falsely* say all kinds of evil against you because of Me.

Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great; for in the same way they <u>persecuted</u> the prophets who were before you. (Matthew 5:10-12)

Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Messiah Jesus will be persecuted. (II Timothy 3:12)

For to **you** it has been granted for **Messiah's sake**, not only to **believe in Him**, but also to <u>suffer</u> for **His sake**, (Philippians 1:29)

Beloved, do not be surprised at the *fiery ordeal* among you, which comes upon you for **your testing**, as though some *strange thing* were happening to **you**;

but to the degree that **you** <u>share</u> the <u>sufferings</u> of Messiah, keep on **rejoicing**, so that also at the **revelation** of **His** *glory* **you** may **rejoice** with **exultation**.

If you are <u>reviled</u> for the name of Messiah, you are blessed, because the Spirit of *glory* and of God rests on you. (I Peter 4:12-14)

4. We can expect <u>Apostasy</u> in the <u>Church</u>

As **He (Jesus)** was sitting on the **Mount of Olives**, the **disciples** came to **Him** privately, saying, "Tell us, **when** will **these things** happen, and what *will be* the **sign** of **Your coming**, and of the <u>end</u> of the age?"

> And **Jesus** answered and said to them, "See to it that **no one** <u>misleads you</u>.

For many will come in *My name*, saying, 'I am the Messiah,' and will <u>mislead many</u>...

At that time **many** will <u>fall away</u> and will *betray* one another and *hate* one another. Many <u>false prophets</u> will arise and will <u>mislead many</u>. (Matthew 24:3-5, 10-11)

Let **no one** in any way *deceive you*, for *it* (the <u>day</u> of the Lord) *will not come* unless the <u>apostasy</u> comes first, and the **man of lawlessness** is **revealed**, the **son of destruction** (II Thessalonians 2:3)

...preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

For **the time** will come when they will *not* **endure** <u>sound</u> <u>doctrine</u>; but *wanting* to have their **ears tickled**, they will accumulate for themselves **teachers** in accordance to their **own desires**, and will <u>turn away</u> their ears from the *truth* and will <u>turn aside</u> to *myths*. (II Timothy 4:2-4)

5. *We* can **expect** the *increasing* <u>Judgment</u> of God (upon *both* the **Church** and the **World**)

For *it is* time for judgment to begin with the household of God; and if *it begins* with *us first*, what *will be* the outcome for **those** who **do not obey** the gospel of God? (I Peter 5:17)

For the <u>wrath of God</u> is *revealed* from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who *suppress the truth* in unrighteousness,...

For even though **they** <u>knew</u> God, they did <u>not</u> honor Him as God or *give thanks*, but they became **futile** in their **speculations**, and their **foolish heart** was **darkened**. Professing to be **wise**, they became **fools**,..

Therefore **God** <u>gave them over</u> in the lusts of *their hearts* to <u>impurity</u>, so that *their bodies* would be <u>dishonored</u> among them.

For they exchanged the <u>truth</u> of God for a <u>lie</u>, and worshiped and served the *creature* rather than the *Creator*, who is **blessed forever**. Amen. (Romans 1:18, 21-22, 24-25)

For **nation** will **rise** *against* **nation**, and **kingdom** *against* **kingdom**, and in various places there will be *famines* and *earthquakes*. But all these things are *merely* the <u>beginning</u> of <u>birth pangs</u>...

For **then** there will be a **great** <u>tribulation</u> (judgments), such as has not occurred since the **beginning** of the world until now, nor **ever will**. (Matthew 24:7-8, 21)

6. We can expect the <u>Persecution</u> of <u>Jews and Israel</u>

It will come about in <u>that day</u> that I will make <u>Jerusalem</u> a heavy stone for all the peoples; all who lift it will be severely injured. and all the nations of the earth will be <u>gathered against it</u>. (Zechariah 12:3)

"It will come about in all the land (Israel)," declares the LORD,

"That **two parts** in it will be <u>cut off</u> and <u>perish</u>; but the <u>third</u> will be left in it.

"And I will bring the third part through the fire,

refine them as silver is refined, and test them as gold is tested.
They will call on My name, and I will answer them;
I will say, 'They are My people,'
and they will say, 'The LORD is my God.'" (Zechariah 13:8-9)

"But when you see **Jerusalem** *surrounded* by **armies**, then recognize that **her** *desolation* is **near**.

Then **those** who are in **Judea** must flee to the **mountains**, and **those** who are in the midst of the **city** must **leave**, and **those** who are in the **country** must **not** enter the **city**;

because these are days of **vengeance**, so that **all things** which are *written* will be <u>fulfilled</u>. (Luke 21:20-22)

And when the dragon (Satan) saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he <u>persecuted</u> the <u>woman</u> who gave birth to the male child (Jesus). (Revelation 12:13)

Personal Application We live in **Perilous Times**, so **what** do *we do*?

A. We *continue* to have **Faith in God**

Therefore, **those** also who **<u>suffer</u>** according to the **will of God** shall **<u>entrust their souls</u> to a faithful Creator** in doing what is **right**. (I Peter 4:19)

B. We *continue* to **Function** as a **Community of Believers**

- 1. Devoting ourselves to learning the word of God (Acts 2:42a)
- 2. Devoting ourselves to <u>fellowship</u> and <u>prayer</u> (Acts 2:42b-c)
- 3. Devoting ourselves to meeting the needs of one another (Acts 2:44-45)
- 4. Devoting ourselves to <u>fellowship</u> and the "breaking of bread" with one another in *unity* and *gladness* (Acts 2: 46)
- 5. Devoting ourselves to corporate worship (Acts 2:47a)
- 6. Becoming a corporate <u>witness</u> of the <u>gospel</u> to the community (Acts 2:47b)
- C. We continue to walk as Children of "Light" in a dark World

Do all things without *grumbling* or *disputing*; so that you will **prove yourselves** to be **blameless** and **innocent**, **children of God** above **reproach** in the midst of a **crooked** and **perverse generation**, among whom **you appear** as <u>lights in the world</u>, *holding fast* the <u>word of life</u>,..(Philippians 2:14-16a)
