# Yom Ha-atzma'ut Celebrating the **Miracle** of Israel

### Israel's Continued Preservation

Behold, **He** who <u>keeps Israel</u> will *neither* slumber nor sleep. (Psalm 121:4)

Thus says **the LORD**, who gives the **sun** for light by **day** and the **fixed order** of the **moon** and the **stars** for light by **night**, who stirs up the **sea** so that its waves roar: the **LORD of hosts** is **His name**:

"<u>If</u> this **fixed order** departs from Me," declares **the LORD**, "<u>**then**</u> the **offspring of Israel** also shall <u>**cease**</u> from being a **nation** before **Me forever**." (Jeremiah 31:35-36)

For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this *mystery* so that you will not be wise in your own estimation that a *partial* hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in; and so all Israel will be <u>saved</u>;..(Romans 11:25-26a)

#### Israel's Miraculous Resurrection

The hand of **the LORD** was upon me (**Ezekiel**), and **He** brought me out by the **Spirit of the LORD** and set me down in the middle of the **valley**; and it was **full of** <u>bones</u>.

He caused me to pass among them round about, and behold, *there were* very many on the surface of the valley, and lo, *they were* very dry.
He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones <u>live</u>?
And I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know."...

Then **He** said to me, **"Son of man**, these **bones** are the **whole house of** <u>Israel</u>; behold, they say, 'Our **bones** are *dried up* and our <u>hope</u> has *perished*. We are *completely* <u>cut off.</u>'

Therefore **prophecy** and say to them, 'Thus says the **Lord GOD**, "Behold I will **open your graves** and cause you to <u>come up</u> out of your graves, My people; and I will *bring you* to the <u>land</u> of Israel..

I will put My Spirit within you and you will come to life,

and I will **place you** on your <u>own land</u>. Then you will know that **I, the LORD**, have spoken and **done it,**" declares **the LORD**." (Ezekiel 37:1-3, 11-12, 14)

#### Israel's Future **Reconciliation**

"A **Redeemer** will **come** to <u>Zion</u>, and to those who <u>turn</u> from transgression in Jacob," declares the LORD. (Isaiah 59:20)

"And it will come about in *that day* that I will set about to **destroy** all the **nations** that come against **Jerusalem**.

I will *pour out* on the **house of David** and on the inhabitants of **Jerusalem**, the <u>Spirit</u> of grace and supplication, so that they will look upon *Me* whom they have <u>pierced</u>; and they will *mourn* for Him, as one *mourns* for an only son,... In *that day* there will be great *mourning* in Jerusalem...

"In **that day** a <u>fountain</u> will be opened for the **house of David** and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for *sin* and for *impurity*." (Zechariah 12:9-11a, 13:1)

Now if their (Israel's) *transgression* is riches for the world and their *failure* is riches for the Gentiles, how much more will their <u>fulfillment be</u>!...

For if their (Israel's) rejection is the <u>reconciliation</u> of the world, what will *their* <u>acceptance</u> be but <u>life</u> from the dead? (Romans 11:12, 15)

#### **Israel's Final Restoration & Jubilation**

'For behold, the **days** are coming,' declares **the LORD**, 'when I will <u>restore</u> the **fortunes** of **My people Israel** and **Judah**.'

The LORD says, 'I will also bring them back to the <u>land</u> that I gave to their forefathers and they shall <u>possess it</u>."... (Jeremiah 30:3)

"Shout for joy, O Daughter of Zion! Shout in triumph O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all your heart O daughter of Jerusalem!

The LORD has *taken away* His judgments against you, He has *cleared away* your enemies. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in your midst; you will fear disaster no more..."

"At **that time** I will bring you in, even at **that time** I will **gather you** together, indeed I will give you **renown** and **praise** among **all peoples** of the earth, when I <u>restore your fortunes</u> before your eyes, says **the LORD**. (Zephaniah 3:14-15, 20)

## The **"Rebirth"** of **Israel**... What does it **mean to** *us*?

 The miraculous *Rebirth* of Israel means that the word of God is <u>true</u>, and that the <u>promises</u> made both to Israel, and to *us* are trustworthy. (Genesis 12:1-3) (Joshua 21:45) (Ezekiel 37:1-14) (Romans 11:25-29) (II Peter 1:19-21) (Titus 1:1-2)

Let us **hold fast** the **confession** of **our hope** without **wavering**, for **He** who **promised** is **faithful**; (Hebrews 10:23)

<u>Faithful</u> is **He** who *calls you,* and **He** also will <u>bring it to pass</u>. (I Thessalonians 5:24)

The *Rebirth* of Israel is a "sign" that we are indeed in <u>the last</u> of the "last days". (Deuteronomy 30:1-5) (Micah 4:1-4) (Zephaniah 3:14-20) (Matthew 24:3, 15-35; Luke 21:20-31)

As **He (Jesus)** was sitting on the **Mount of Olives**, the **disciples** came to **Him** privately, saying, "Tell us, *when* will these **things** happen, and what *will be* the <u>sign</u> of **Your coming**, and of the *end* of the age?"...

"Now learn the **parable** from the <u>fig tree</u>: when its branch has already become tender and puts forth its **leaves**, you **know** that **summer is near**;

so, you too, when you see **all these things**, recognize that <u>**He is near**</u>, *right* at **the door**..." (Matthew 24:3, 23-33)

The *Rebirth* of Israel means that we are *nearer* to the time of *tribulation* that was predicted for both the world and for Israel, before the establishment of the Messianic Kingdom. (Jeremiah 30:3-11) (Daniel 9:26-27) (Joel 1:1-2, 2:28-32, 3:1-2, 18-21) (Zechariah 12:11-14, 13:8-9, 14:1-11) (Matthew 24:3, 15-22)

'Alas! for <u>that day</u> is *great*, There is none like it; And it is the time of <u>Jacob's</u> *distress*, But he will be saved from it. (Jeremiah 30: 7)
"Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (*in Israel*) (let the reader understand),

then those who are in **Judea** must flee to the **mountains**...

For **then** there will be a **<u>great tribulation</u>**, such as has not occurred since the **beginning** of the world until **now**, nor ever will. (Matthew 24:15-16, 21)

4. The *Rebirth* of Israel means that we are *nearer* to a <u>spiritual</u> <u>revival</u> among the Jewish people predicted in the scriptures. (Deuteronomy 30:6-8) (Jeremiah 31:31-34) (Zechariah 12:8-14, 13:1) (Isaiah 59:16-21) (Romans 11:25-26) (Revelation 7:4-8)

For I will *take you* from the **nations**, *gather you* from all the **lands** and *bring you* into your <u>own land</u>...

Moreover, I will give you a **new heart** and put a **new spirit** within you; and I will **remove** the **heart of** *stone* from your **flesh** and give you a **heart of** *flesh*.

I will put **My** <u>Spirit</u> *within* **you** and cause you to **walk** in **My** *statutes*, and you will be careful to **observe My** *ordinances*. (Ezekiel 36:24, 26-27)

5. The *Rebirth* of Israel should be exciting to *all* believers, for it means that <u>the return</u> of Jesus the Messiah is <u>closer</u> than when we first believed. (Isaiah 59:20) (Zechariah 12:10, 14:4-5) (Matthew 24:3, 15-16, 29-35) (Luke 21:20-31)

"But immediately after the tribulation of *those days* THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED, AND THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT, AND THE STARS WILL *FALL* from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

And then the **sign** of the <u>Son of Man</u> will **appear** in the **sky**, and then all the **tribes** of the **earth** will *mourn*, and they will see the <u>Son of Man</u> <u>COMING</u> ON THE *CLOUDS* OF THE **SKY** with **power** and **great glory**. (Matthew 24:29-30)
